The Board having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to examine Pte Joseph Aube and find him in an unconscious condition, as the result of a gun-shot wound of the head. The bullet entered the right cheek half an inch lateral to the alar prominence of the nose passed thro all structures in a direct line backwards until it struck the occiput. It is the opinion of the board that this man is in a very critical condition and may die at any moment.
