on being admitted to Duches Military Hospital. Lips dry and cracked. Small spots on upper chest, lower dorsal vertebrae & over posterior trunk, none on legs, or arms. Spots appear to be of long standing. Pt has pain on percussion over spinal processes & occipital vertebrae also in examining chest on percussion cause him pain & he utters the least motion or movement cause him pain on a footstep beside the bed causes him pain also. Patient irrational but can answer only certain questions, memory very poor almost a blank. Can open mouth & put out tongue when told to do so. Hearing evidently normal. Condition of eyes referred to specialist. Pt nervous & has slight twitchings. No odour of urine from breath. Discontinence of urine & faeces. No swelling of arms, legs, feet or hands. Pupils dilated. 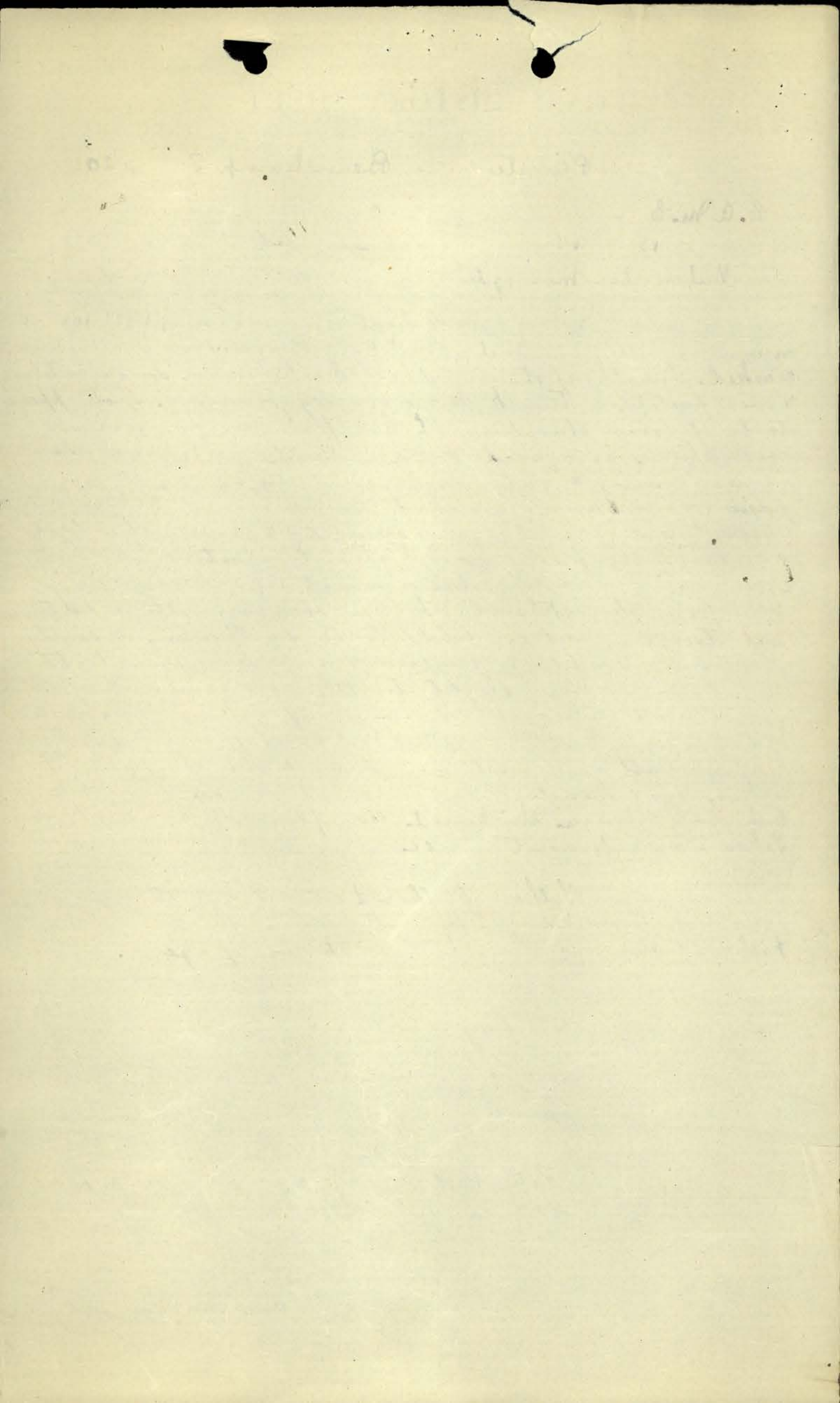

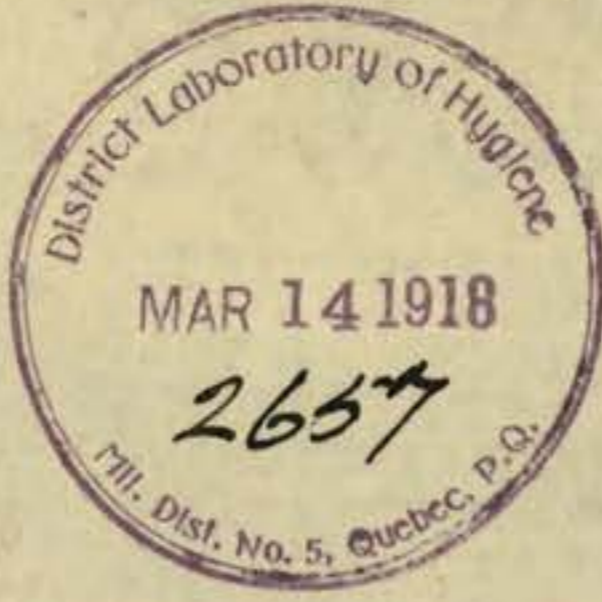
