

having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to

1st Witness:

Captain C. V. Doyon, Chaplain, 22nd (F. C.) Bn states: On March 10th 1915, I proceeded with Captain Beaubien, 22nd (F.C.) Bn and Lieutenant Lefebvre. 22nd (F.C.) Bn to the Coroner's Office at St. Johns, P.Q., where we received the body of the deceased Pte Boulanger in civilian clothes: his right arm was broken, his head fractured and his face crushed and flattened.

From information received, I judged that the deceased had spent the preceding evening at the house of Rose Alma Gauthier, a friend of the deceased in St. Johns. I went there and the uniform and the military accoutrements of the deceased were recovered.

The said Rose Alma Gauthier admitted that the deceased had changed his military clothes for civilian clothes at her house on the night of March 9th and that he left the house about 9.15p.m. probably to board the Montreal train.

We interviewed the man who removed the body of the deceased from the C.P.R. tracks, near the station C.P.R. Station, St Johns, P.Q. He stated that the body when recovered in the early hours of March 10th, 1915 was cold and rigid, indicating that death had taken place some hours before.
