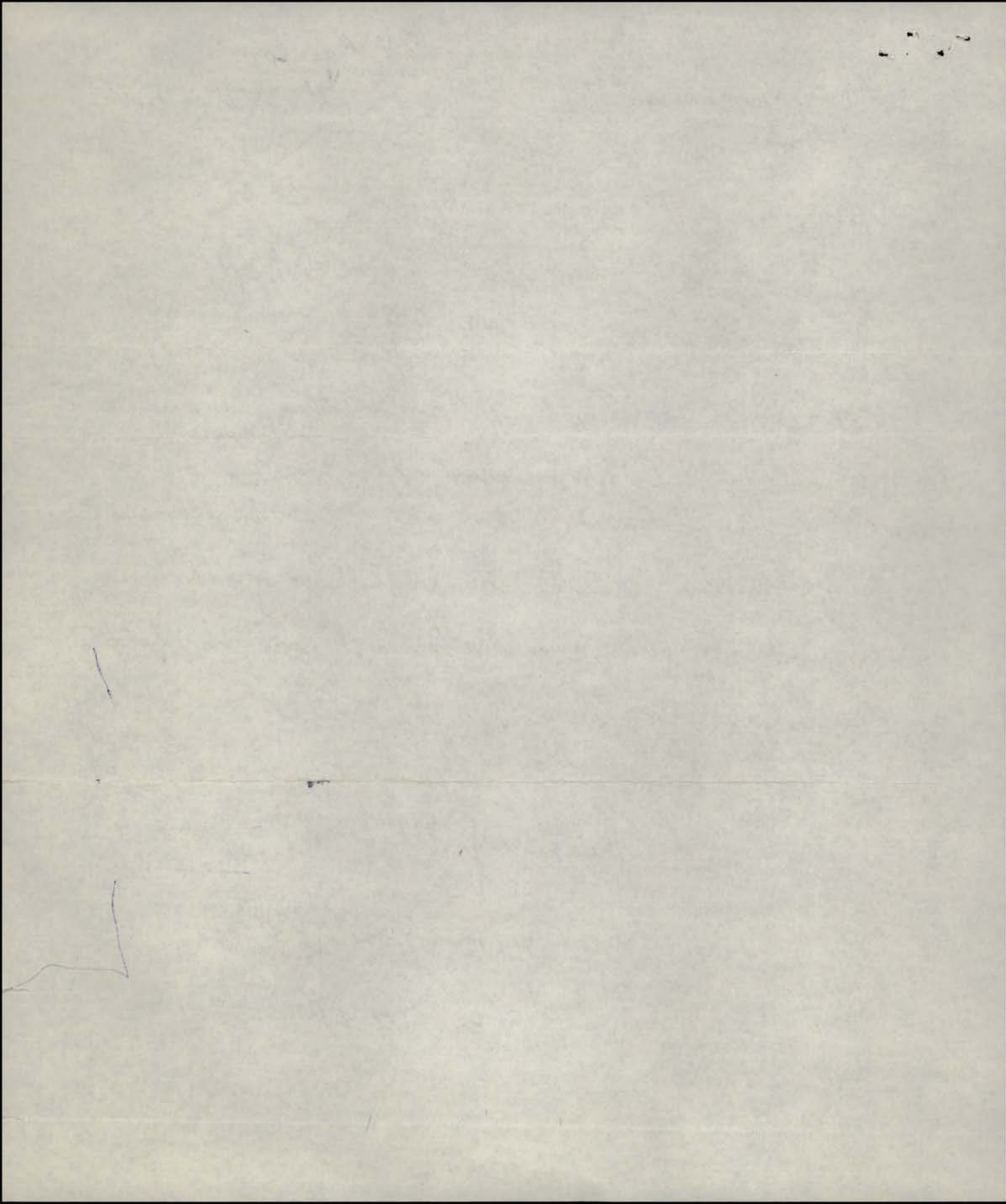


Dear Sir:

In reply to your recent enquiry concerning the above-named deceased Canadian soldier, kindly note that the remains of L/Corporal Bradford lie in plot 1, row F, grave 20, Aubigny Communal Cemetery, Aubigny-en-Artois, France.

Aubigny-en-Artois is a village and commune situated on the river Scarpe, in the Department of the Pas-de-Calais, 13 miles West of Arras on the road to St. Pol. It has a station on the railway line joining these towns. The Communal Cemetery lies South of the village, and the Extension is behind it.

Once the cemetery has been reached there should be no difficulty in locating the grave as it is marked with a permanent individual headstone bearing the decedent's name and regimental particulars.

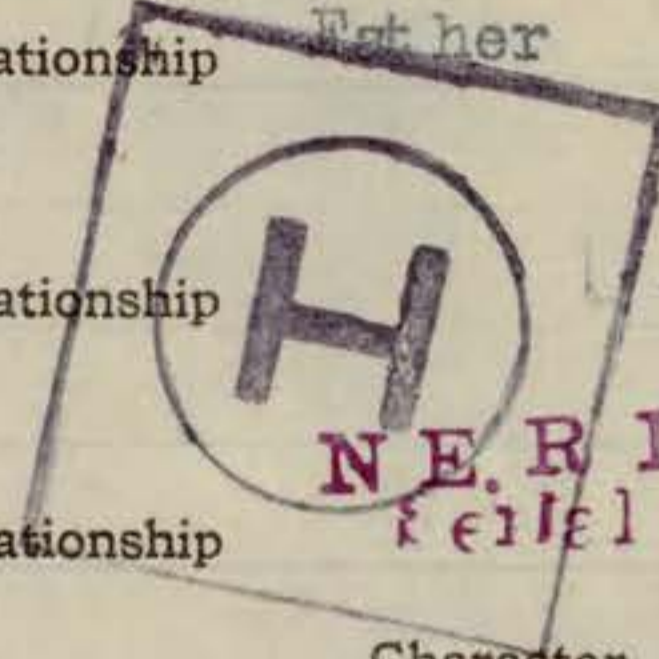

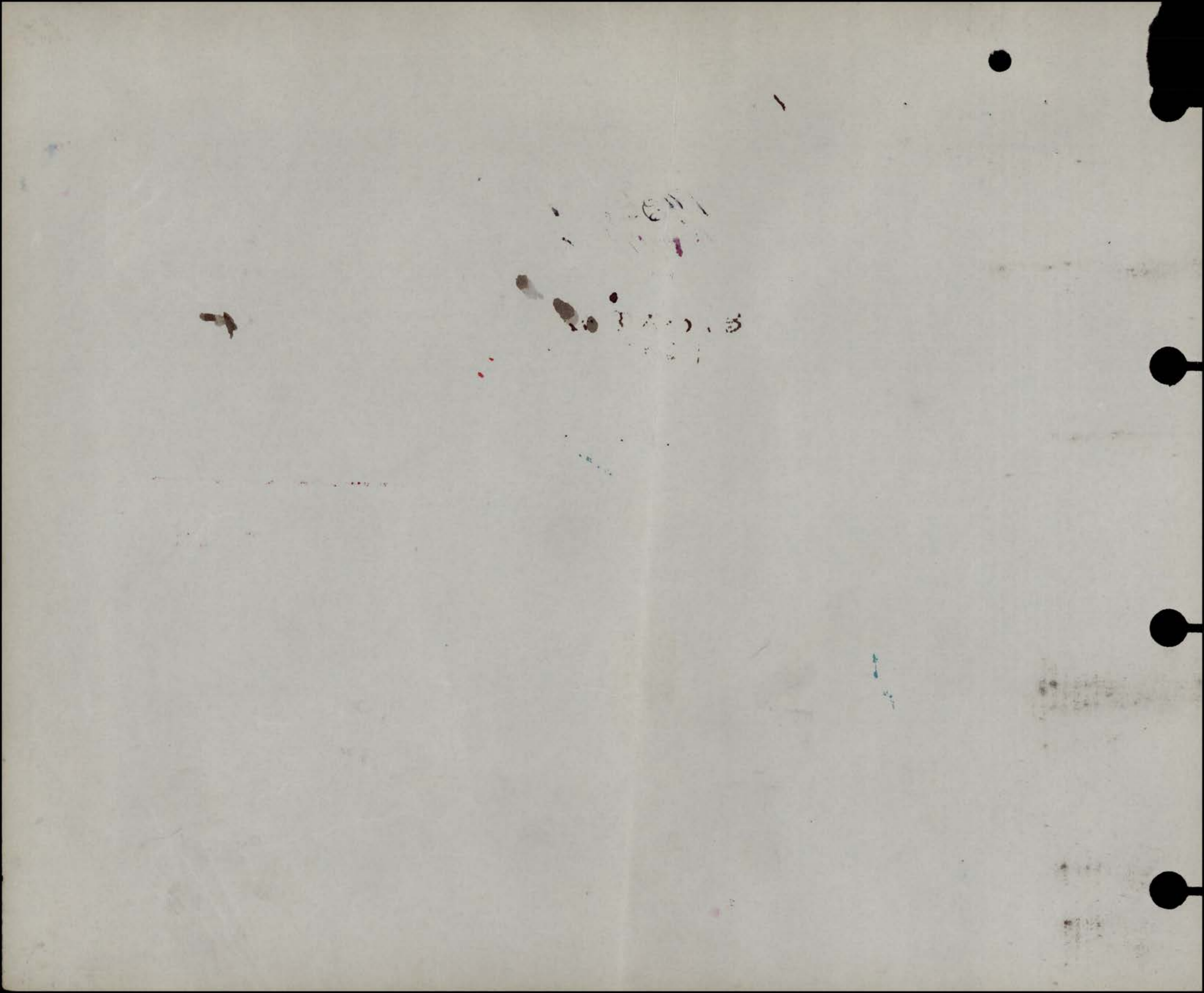
