

#177177 Pte Albert Waller, 87th Battalion C.E.F. was admitted to the Montreal General Hospital on Nov. 10th 1915 with Gonorrhoe and Arthritis, whilst in the Hospital he had Pneumonia and recovered. He was reported on M.F.B. 227 as unfit and sent to the Grey Nuns Convalescent Home on Jan. 20th 1916. He was readmitted ~~from~~ to the Montreal General Hospital from the Grey Nuns Convalescent Home on Jan. 30th 1916, with Meningeal symptoms, and shortly after there was diagnosed otitis Media suppurative in the left ear. Operation was not considered advisable. The middle ear disease extended and reached the blood stream and he died of blood poisoning directly due to the middle ear disease on Feb'y 27th, 1916.

#177177 Pte A.Waller of the 87th, Battalion C. E. F. was admitted to the Grey Nuns Convalescent Home Jan 20th, 1916 from the Montreal General Hospital, convalescent from Pneumonia and complaining of General rheumatic pains. On Jan. 28th, he was reported sick with a reddened throat, left tonsil swollen and ear discharging, this was diagnosed as Left otitis media, he was immediately put to bed and given Acid Boric and Glycerine gargle and ear gently syringed with Boric solution. He was transferred to the Montreal General Hospital Jan 30th, 1916, having symptoms of Meningismus and otitis media.

The Court having heard the evidence find, that 177177 Pte Albert Waller, 87th, Battalion C. E. F. and attached to the Composite Regiment, died at the Montreal General Hospital Feby 27th, 1916 of Blood poisoning directly due to the middle ear disease.


