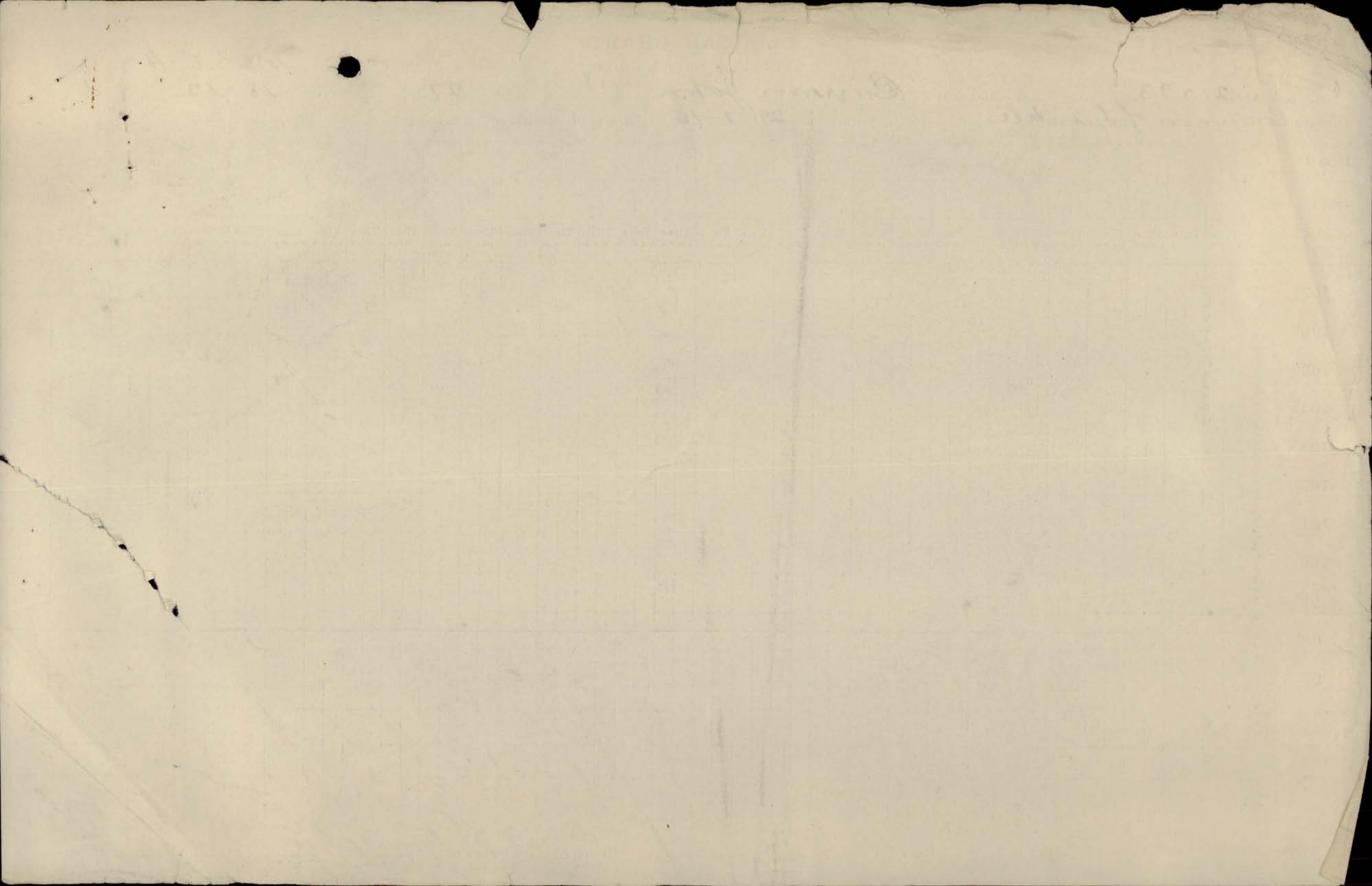

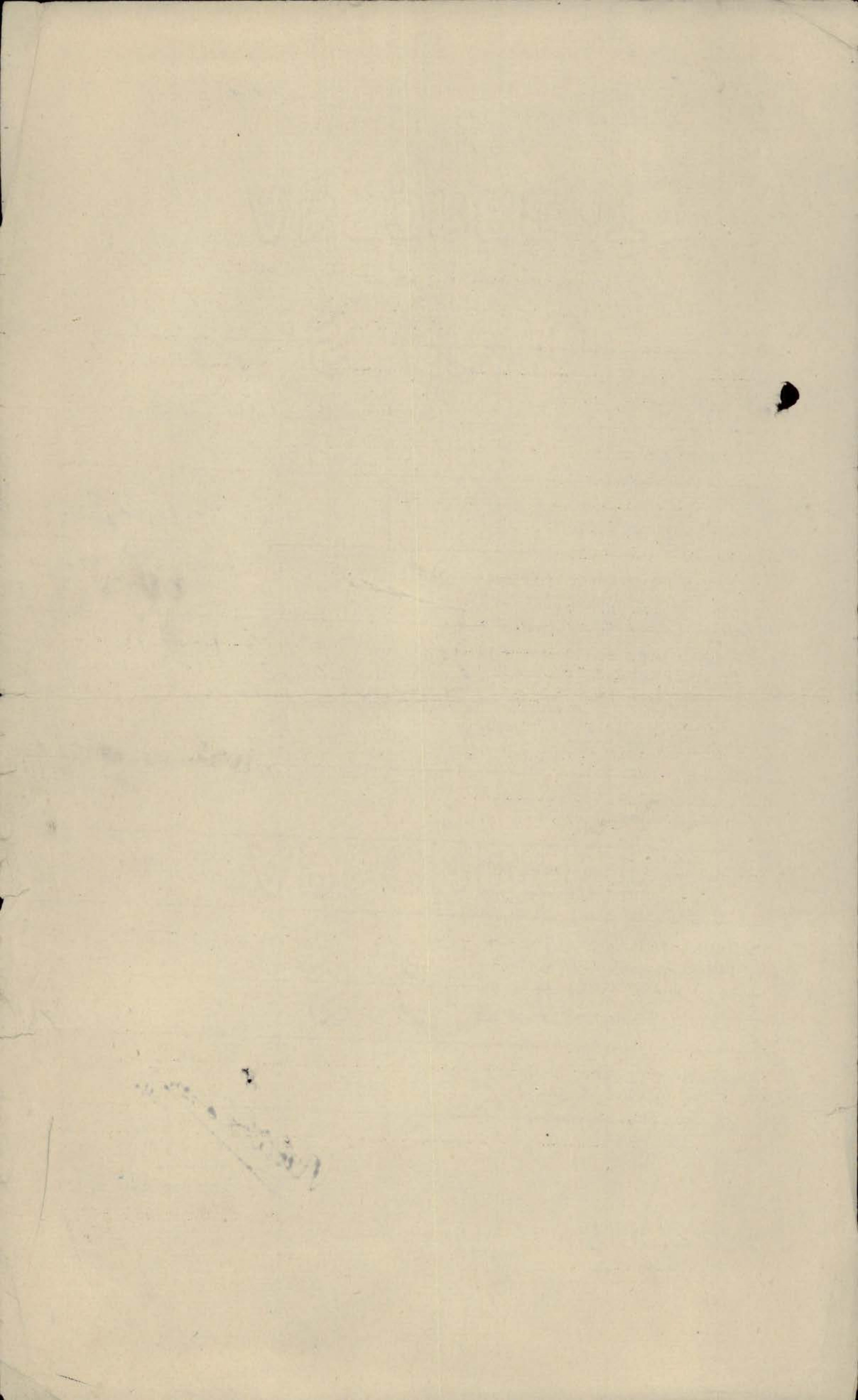

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE OF NO. 512399, Driver C.E. Hettrick.

While returning from Petite Vimy last night, at approximately 11.45 P.M., and when passing Fort George, Pte. Carrol, "D" Company, 116th Battalion, stepped out from behind a gun which was on the move, not more than ten feet in front of my car. I immediately applied all brakes, but failed to stop in time to prevent my car hitting him, though I stopped within one car length.

I conveyed Pte. Carrol to Aubigny, to the 42nd C.C.S. where he was examined by the M.O. and found not to be seriously hurt. At the time of the accident, I was travelling about 12 miles per hour. I am certain of this, as I had just stopped one hundred yards from the spot of accident to light my lamps.

I conveyed Pte Carroll to Aubigny to the 42nd C.C. S. where he was examined by the M.O. and found not to be seriously hurt. At the time of the accident I was travelling about 12 miles per hour. I am certain of this as I had just stopped one hundred yards from the spot of accident to light my lamps.

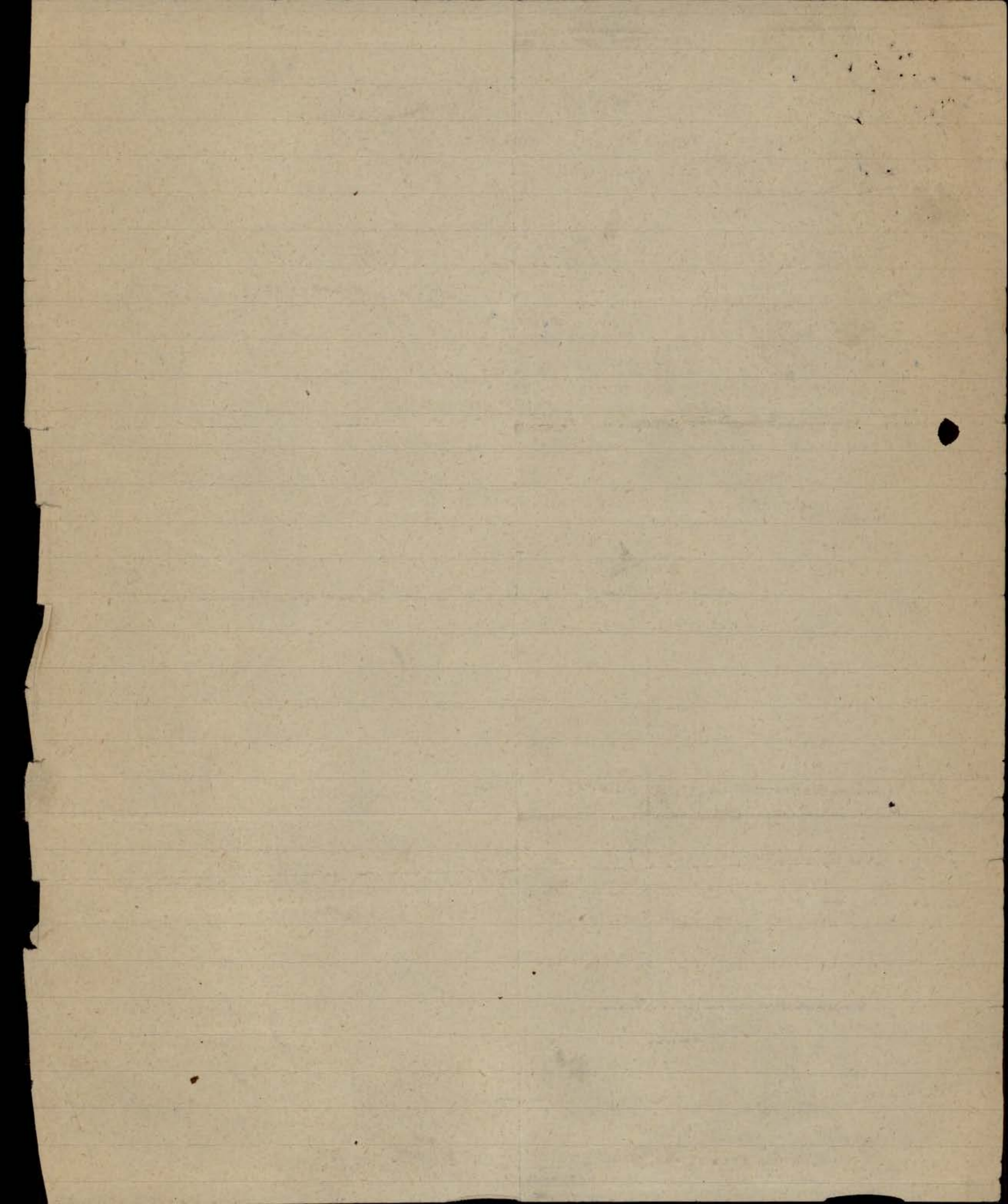
