



This soldier was married with permission on 22 July, 1942, to Edith Fischer described as a widow. Her first husband, Samuel Fischer, was said to have been killed in action in 1916.

- Dependents' Allowance was suspended 1 Mar 43 when the wife failed to submit proof of her first husband's death.
- Subsequent investigation by the Dependents' Allowance Board revealed that she had married one Samuel Fulchuk in 1920 and they separated in 1930. Fulchuk's present address is: 31 Lingan Road, Sydney, N.S.
 - The wife has admitted to the investigator of the Board that she was married to Samuel Fulchuk but was separated from him 1930 and that she has not seen or heard from him since 1936, less than 7 years prior to the date she married this soldier.
 - 5. Certain letters written by this soldier to his wife establish that both parties knew that they were not legally married but conspired to misrepresent their status to the Dependents' Allowance Board in order to obtain an allowance for this woman as a wife. The weight of evidence seems to indicate that the woman was more or less persuaded to co-operate in the scheme by the soldier who saw to it that he obtained as nearly as possible full benefit of this allowance for himself. The wife claims that he sometimes used threats to expose her as a bigamist if she did not give him the allowance.
 - 6. It is considered that this soldier has committed a fraud in obtaining an allowance for his alleged wife, and accomplished this by making the following false statements:
 - (a) He stated to Major F.F.M. Brown, No. 9 Coy. V.G. of C., on or about 11 Aug 42 that his alleged wife's first husband was killed in action while serving in France with the Imperial Army in 1916. This statement was made in connection with his application for Dependents' Allowance and an explanation of inability to produce proof of death of the said first husband.
 - (b) He made a statutory declaration dated 13 May 44 in which he states that his wife's first husband deserted her over 18 years ago and that since that time his whereabouts were unknown either to him or his wife and prior to marriage efforts were made to establish the whereabouts of his wife's first husband.
