Wound was closed by figure 8 sutures in peritoneum. Continuous catgut in muscle sheaths and interrupted silk worm gut in skin.

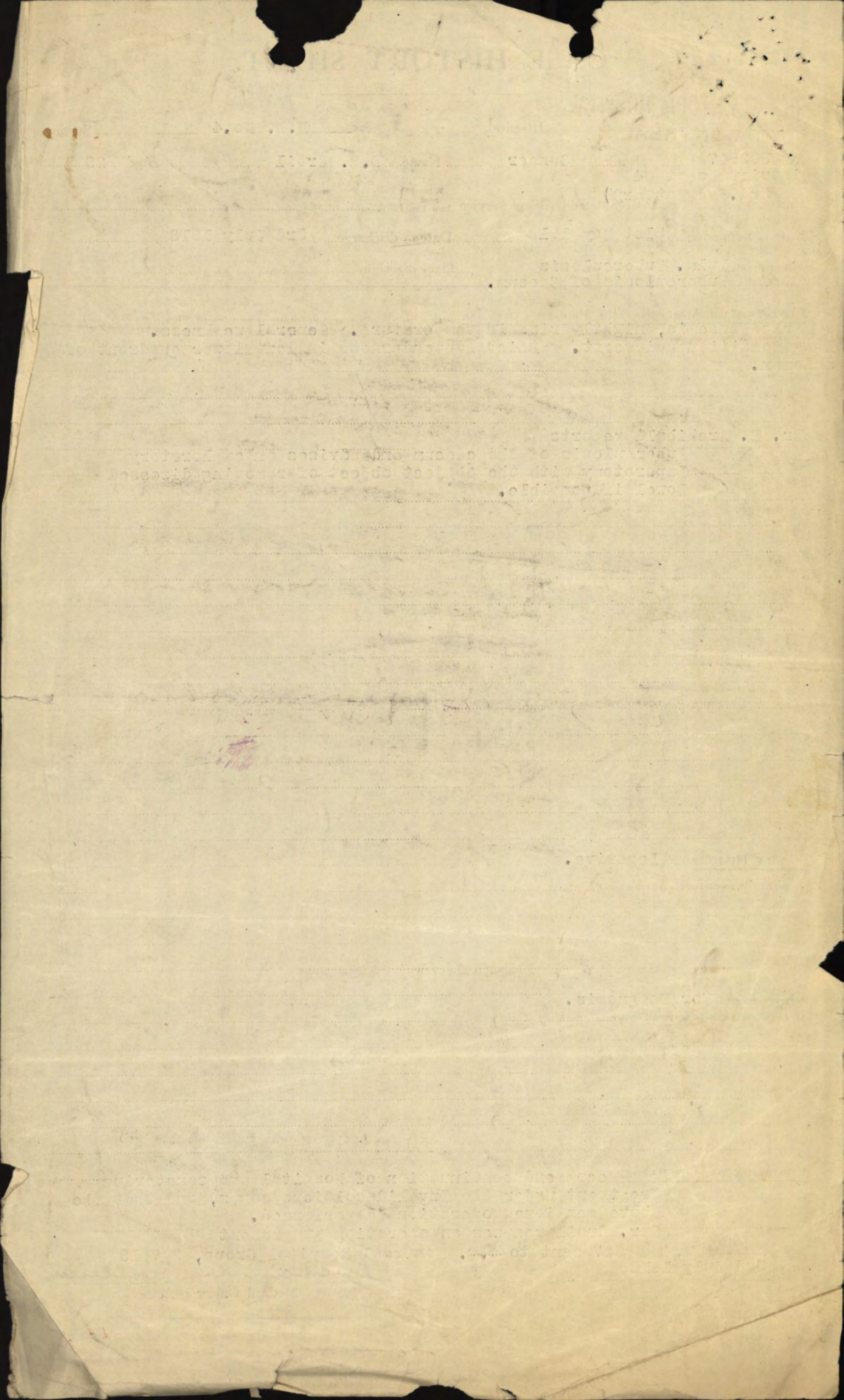


