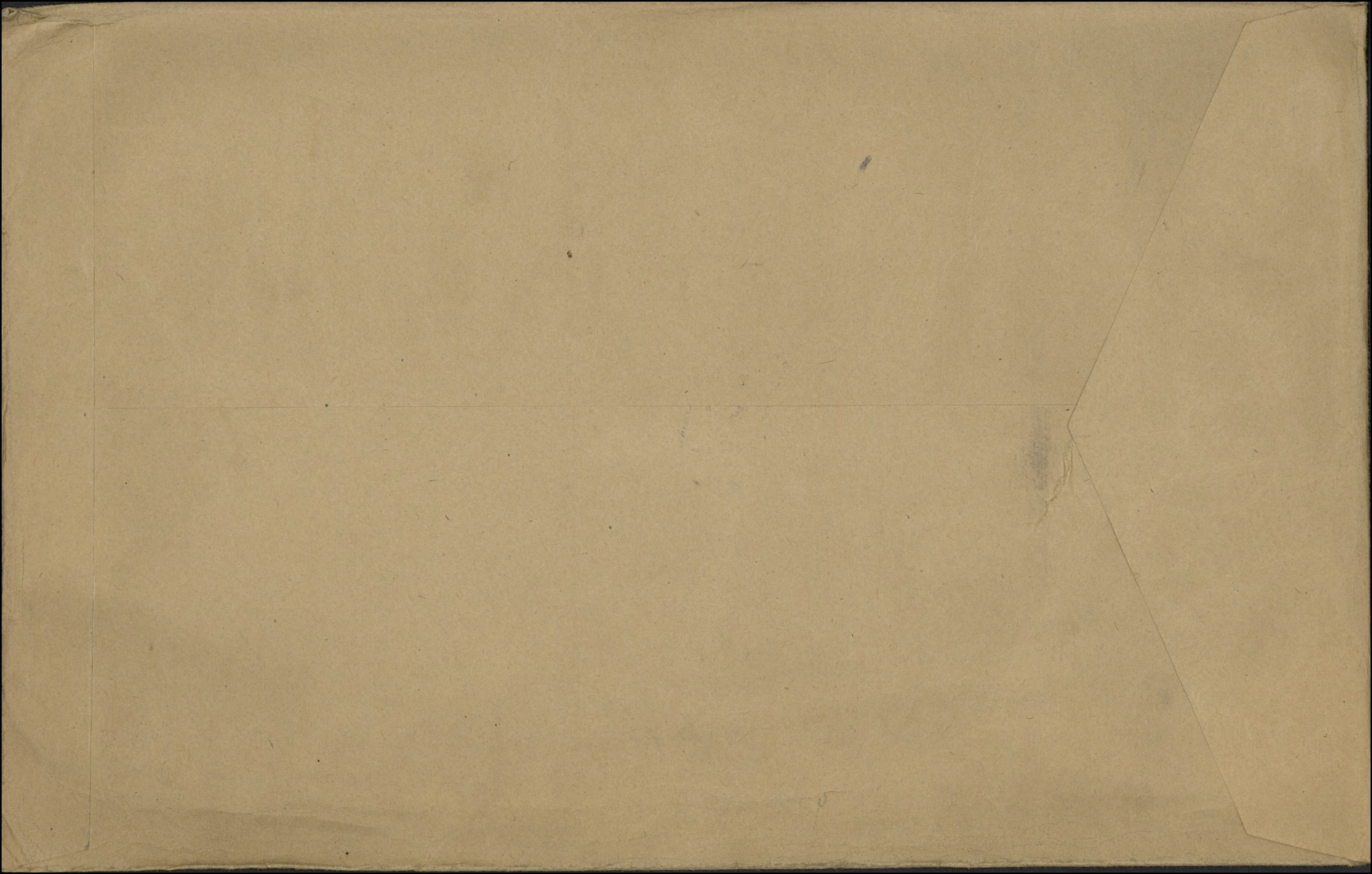

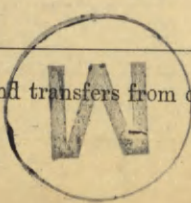
18/10/16. Patient is a French Canadian and has previously had good health. He was employed as a sniper with his unit. Previous to his illness the trenches were very wet.

On September 18th 1916, he complained of Paralysis and lack of feeling in the right hand. On October 16th 1916 he was examined by Colonel Galloway, who recommended him for transfer to England, to the Special Hospital in London for cases of Neurosis, where Dr Mott might see him.

Present condition:- Paralysis of right hand and lack of sensation in that member. The area of Anaesthesia is of the "gloo" variety. With the exception of requiring dental attention he is otherwise quite healthy.


