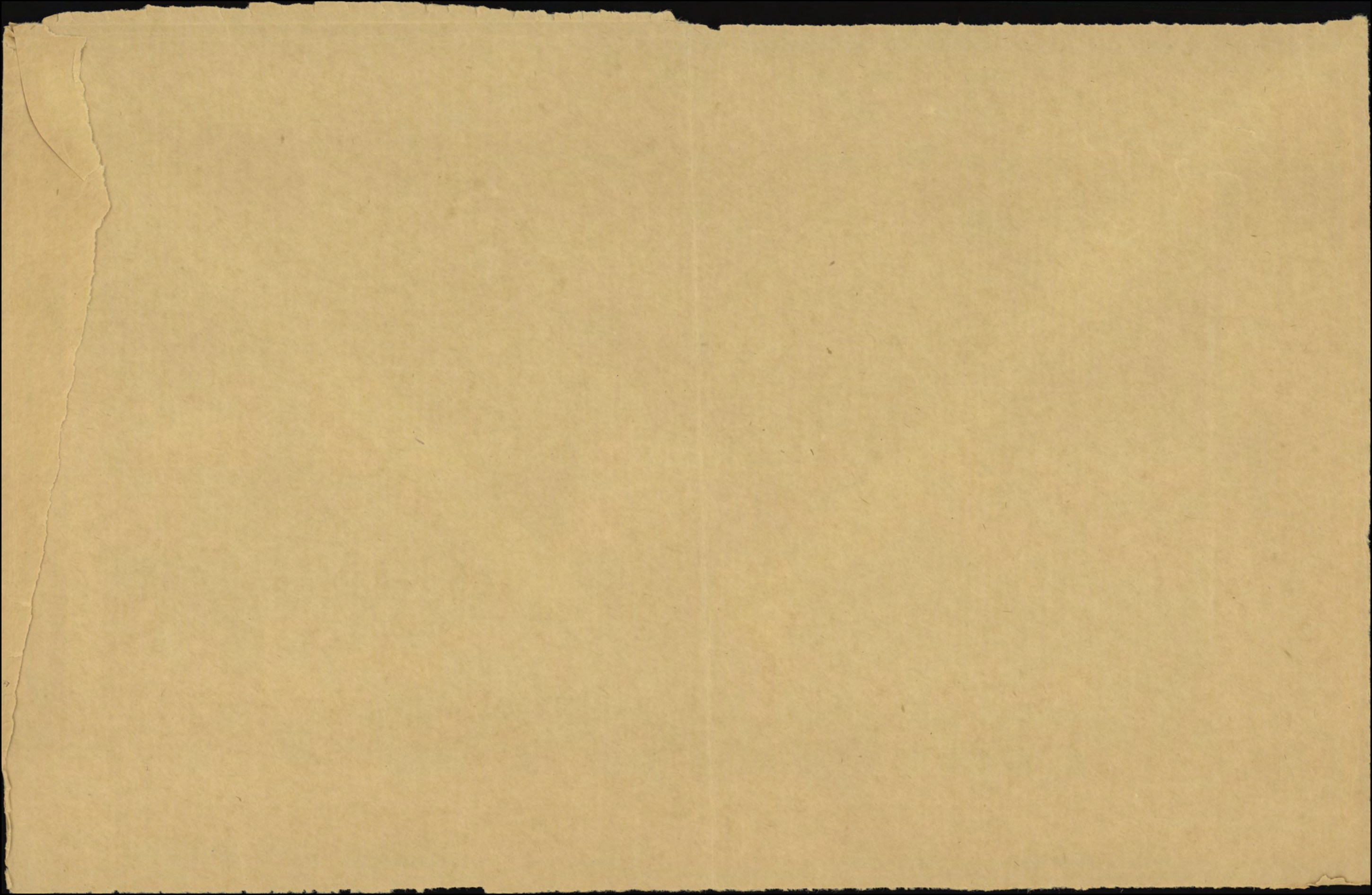

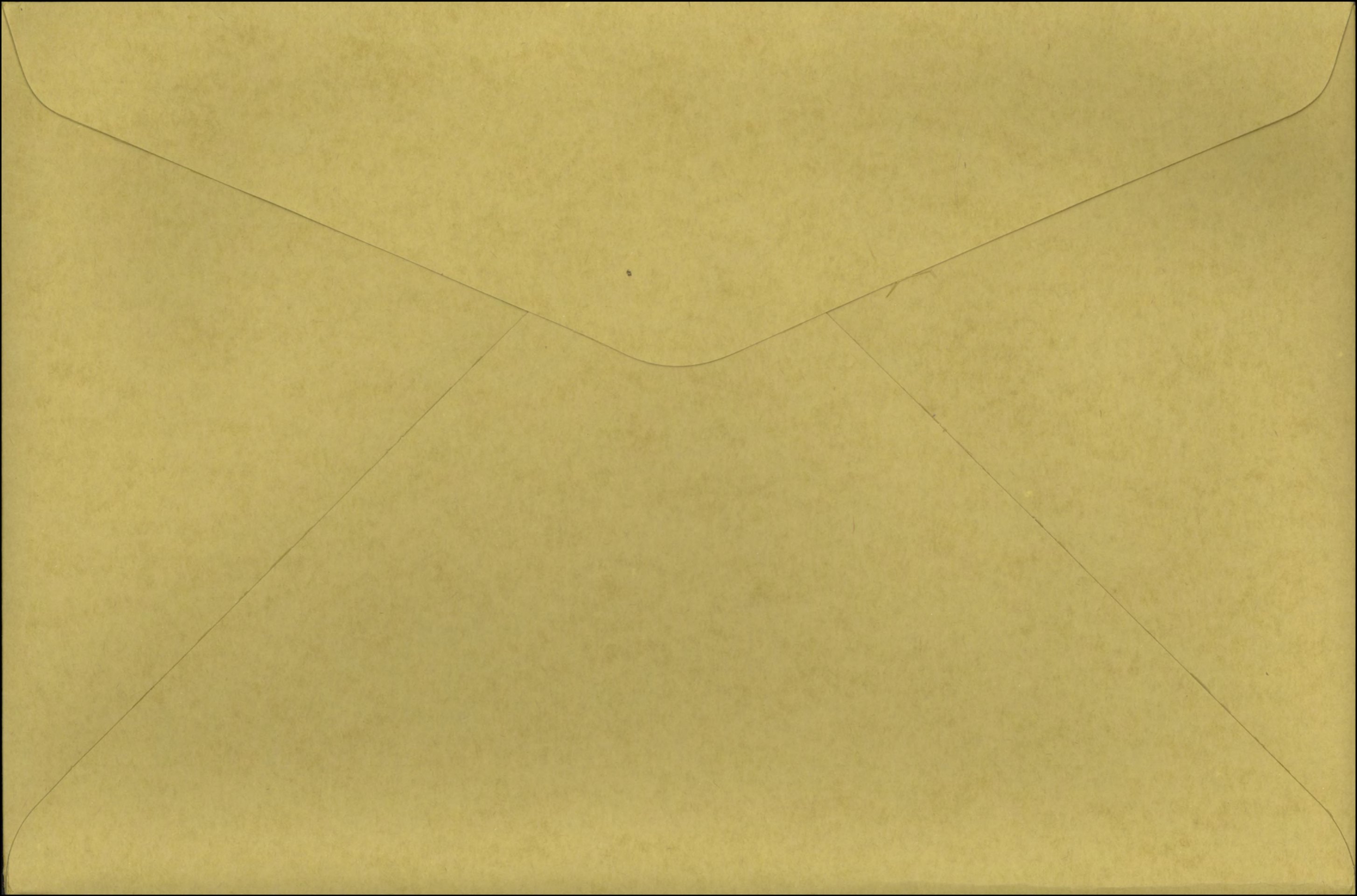

CONDITION ON ADMISSION AND PROGRESS OF CASE. Weight on enlistment 135. Never sick prior to enlistment.

Enlisted Aug. 29th 1914. To England October 1914. To France Feb 1915. Never sick until blown up by shell March 1918. Evacuated to England in April 1918. D.A.H. to Colchester, special Heart Hospital.

Cough, expectoration, dyspnoea.  
Transferred to Busby Park 1.5.1918. Graduated exercises tolerated poorly  
Boarded B2 D.A.H. and sent to Convalescent Depot. Transferred to C.A.M.C and feeling poorly was sent to Lenham TBC Hospital to work. Found ward work too confining and asked to work outside. Had cough and general weakness at this time. In Nov. 1918 cough became very severe and has cough at present time.

Admitted as suspected TBC: Sputum always negative TBC. X-Ray report showed - "Both apices light fairly well except for <sup>an</sup> area in right. Diaphragm: Equal and normal. Upper Bronchial trunks right side more pronounced than left. Enlargement of lymph nodes noticeable at right hila. Both lungs light clearly below."

Invalided to Canada and admitted to Ste Anne de Bellevue 7.4.1919. Complains of sharp stabbing pain under right shoulder blade on deep breath and continuous dull aching pain right lower axilla. No appetite, dyspnoea on exertion. No night sweats at present. Morning and evening

FAMILY HISTORY cough with yellowish expectoration.

(Tuberculosis, mental or nervous diseases.) Inspection: Right supra clavicular area deeper than left and feels poorly on deep inspiration. Expansion chest equal and ample.

Chest:Lungs, Anterior percussion and vocal resonance unimpaired, vocal

TREATMENT fremitus decreased upper left front. Inspiratory wheeze throughout entire front with fine crepitations right apex.

(Especially any specific or special form.) Posterior: No impairment percussion or vocal resonance and vocal fremitus unchanged. Fine crepitations right suprascapular area and inspiratory squeaks in both supra scapular area. Inspiratory wheeze throughout whole chest - post.

Heart: Apex 5th space diffuse. Relative Cardiac Dulness begins 4th rib extends to nipple line. No adventitious sounds.

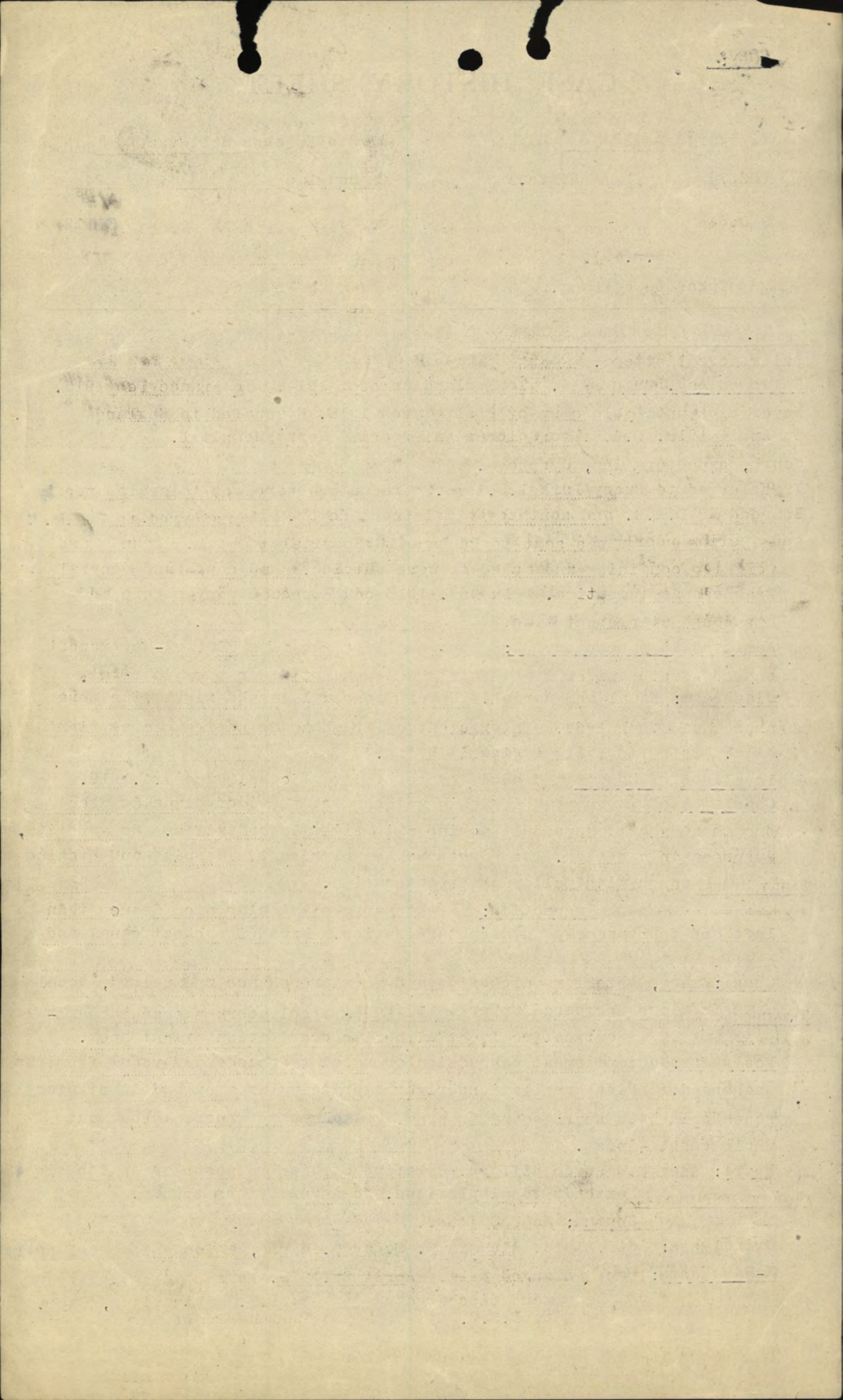

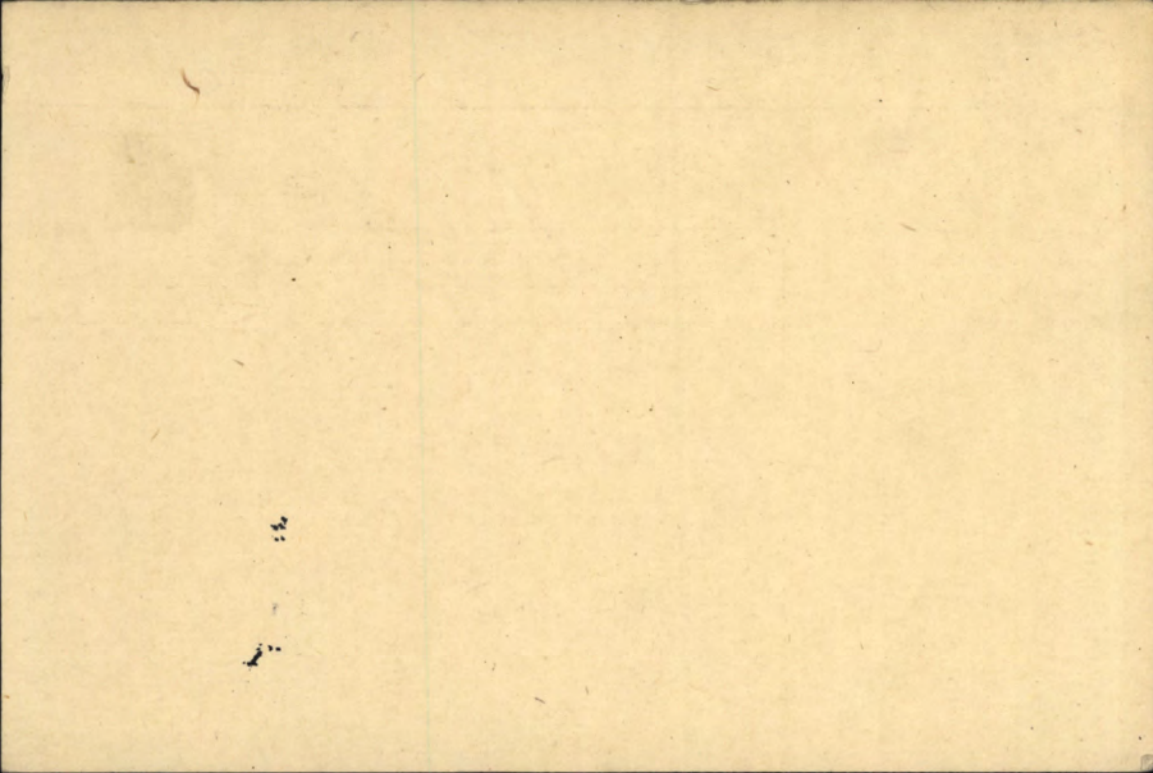

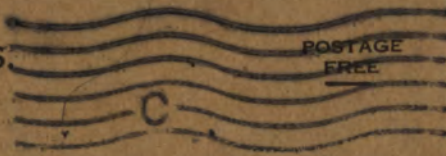
