3.4.19: Smears - No malarial parasites found. Redcells appear normal.  
4.4.19: Bile Culture. Negative.  
15.4.19: Haemoglobin 80-85% Red Blood Cells 4,150,000. Leucocytes 4,000; Smears - No obvious abnormality.  
1.5.19: Culture: Negative. Leucocytes 5,000.  
1.5.19: Slightly enlarged hila. Very doubtful tuberculosis.  
18.5.19: No tubercle bacilli found.  
19.5.19: Wasserman Reaction - Negative.  
23.5.19: G.U. Examination: Mucous pus found in the urethra. Cystoscope passes freely to the posterior urethra. The base of the bladder shows acute congestion (Trigonitis). Ureters are both normal and the urine from both kidneys normal. Examination as a common urine shows acid S.G. 1030, no albumin, no pus. Urine is very deeply pigmented and strongly suggestive of the presence of bile. Filtre paper test with fuming nitric shows a distinct color content. There is no evidence of renal infection. The pus found in the urine from a non-catheter specimen is accounted for by the chronic urethritis. There is no evidence of stricture involvement. We cannot explain the temperature from any G.U. condition.  
April 26, 1919: Col. Browne: Repeated examinations of smears for Malaria

FAMILY HISTORY negative.

(Tuberculosis, mental or nervous diseases.) Thorax, normal proportions, sub-costal angle 70°.  
Expansion abdominal chiefly but equal on both sides.  
On percussion - there appears to be a very slight impairment over left upper front, but no adventitious sounds are heard, nor is there any change in vocal fremitus or vocal resonance.

## TREATMENT

(Especially any specific or special form.) Breath sounds at both apices are very harsh.  
Behind: Very slight impairment at left apex and breath sounds are rather more distant. No adventitious sounds can be heard. Vocal fremitus not increased but quality is changed as compared with right side.

2. 4. 1919: Complaints - Vomiting and general malaise.

History: Patient was admitted to hospital on above date to the Orthopaedic service. Transferred to Medicine for observation and treatment. He gives a history of an attack of vomiting and diarrhoea nearly four months ago. Sent to hospital for two weeks, felt well until the present attack which began about two weeks ago. Attack came on one half hour after his dinner - he vomited undigested food - had several attacks of vomiting during next 24 hours. Admitted to Drummond hospital, Montreal, 11.3.19. Examination revealed heart and lungs normal. Abdomen somewhat distended, slight tenderness in epigastrium, no rigidity.

May 20.19: <sup>111</sup> Col. Browne: Spleen still palpable. Tongue slightly coated.  
Patient feels better. No enlarged lymph nodes.  
Heart - Relative cardiac dulness at nipple line. No enlargement to right. Sounds clear. On percussion, note impaired at left apex. No adventitious sounds, and otherwise negative in front. Behind: Negative.  
Abdomen: Moderately distended. Flanks clear. No evidence of fluid. Knee Jerks present. No Babinski. Pupils equal and active.

For past 3 or 4 days patient has complained of pain in the abdomen.  
Repeated examinations of abdomen failed to show any signs of fluid though there was generalized tenderness.

June 10.19: Pain definitely worse and spasmodic in character, localized at costal margin. Examination at right base shows friction rub behind.  
No signs of fluid in pleura. There is evidently a diaphragmatic pleurisy

11.6.19: Flanks clear. Definite pleuratic rub over left lower lobe.  
At left base coarse moist superficial crepitations may be heard.  
No fluid present.

Fluorescopic examination this date corroborates the absence of fluid in the chest.

FAMILY HISTORY

(Tuberculosis, mental or nervous diseases.) 18.6.19: Two finger breadth's impaired resonance at left base with few superficial rales (Col. Finley).

21.6.19: One hand's breadth impairment at left base. Traube space partially obliterated (Fluid).

TREATMENT

(Especially any specific or special form.) July 22.19: Definite friction over whole precordium. Suggestive of pericardial. No relation to respiratory act, being present both before, during and after act.

Apical beat more impulsive on inspiration than on expiration

16.9.19: Patient continues to run an intermittent temperature from 102 in evening to 97-98 in morning. His only complaint is a feeling of weakness in stomach - Considerable degree of

emaciation - tongue slightly coated - mucous membrane rather pale - lymph nodes not palpable. Pulse 92, regular, small volume, low tension, vessel wall not felt.  
Heart: Point of maximum intensity seen and felt 5th space

Date \_\_\_\_\_ Medical Officer i/c case. -Over-

8 c.m. from mid sternal line. Relative Cardiac dulness <sup>141</sup> 2 1/2 / 6 1/2  
Sounds: Apex clear at base A2 and P2 moderately plus.

Lungs: Expansion is equal. ~~Well~~ marked friction is heard at axilla. Also over Traube space. Breath sounds elsewhere are harsh, while a few moist sounds may be brought out on deep breathing on either side of the sternum in the second space.

Posteriorly: No impairment of percussion, no evidence of fluid. Few pleuratic crepitations at the left base.

Abdomen: Soft, no evidence of fluid, spleen still palpable.

23.9.19: Sputum: No tubercle bacilli found.

29.9.19: Patient, as usual, complains of weakness and flatulence tongue still coated. Friction rub left side still heard but rather indistinct.

21.10.19: Sputum: No tubercle bacilli found.

3.11.19: Patient still running the same intermittent temperature. Still complains of weakness of stomach and pain in epigastric region. On the least touch in this area patient winces. Friction rub in left axilla has disappeared.  
Abdomen: is soft, spleen still palpable.  
Sputum still negative

Treatment: Rest, nourishing food, tonics, etc.

Condition on Discharge: Patient is still very weak, and eats very little. He complains of tenderness in epigastric region and looseness of his bowels. His temperature is still intermittent, generally over 102 in the evening falling to normal every morning.

6.11.19: Recommend his discharge to a Sanatorium.
