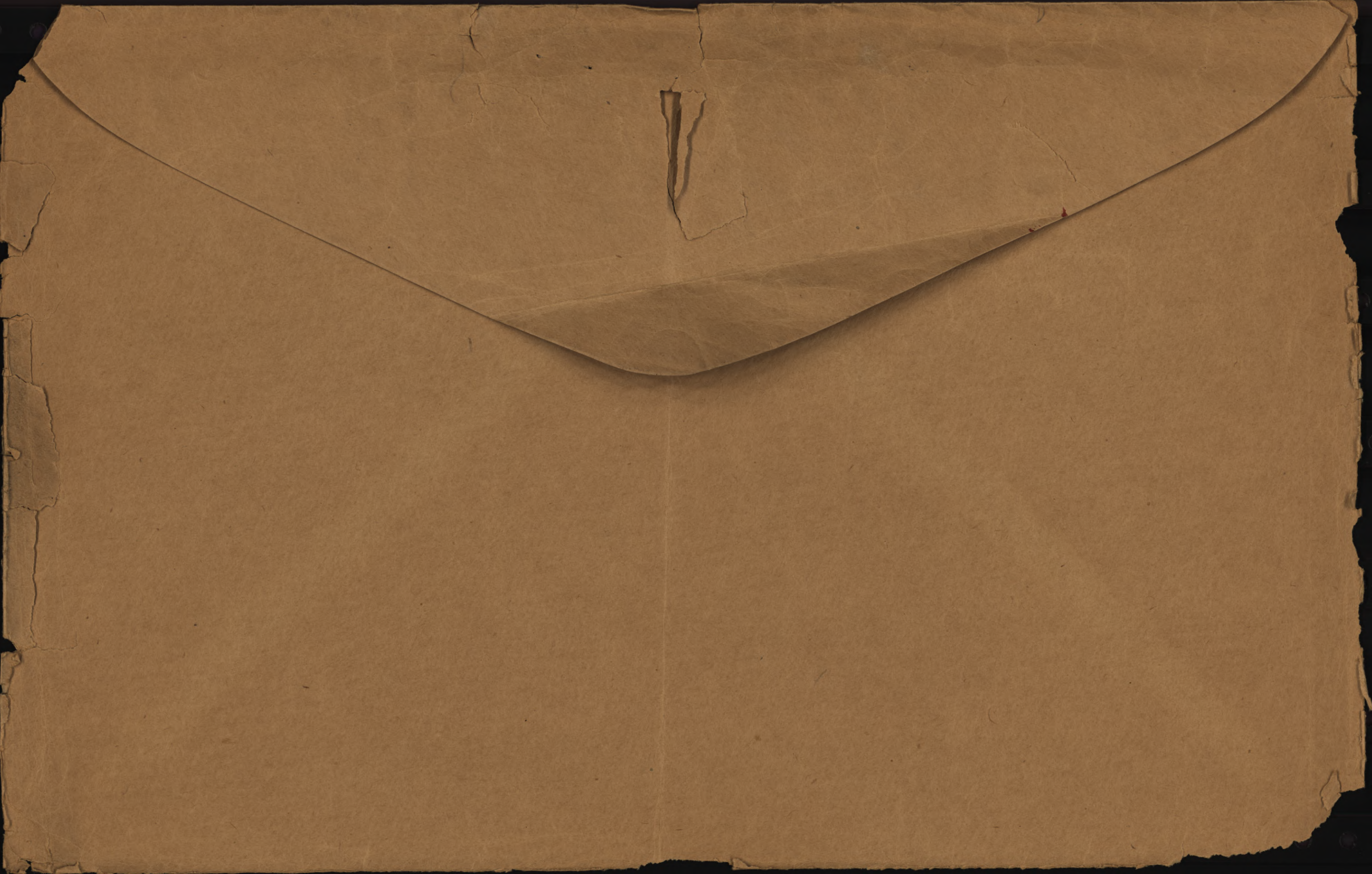

The right pleura was adherent to diaphragm and chest wall, and much thickened.

Many small caseating foci were found amongst the plebifid masses of fibrous tissue. Left apex was also scarred.

There was some congestion of the meningeal vessels, which would account for the intense headache and mental condition of the patient.

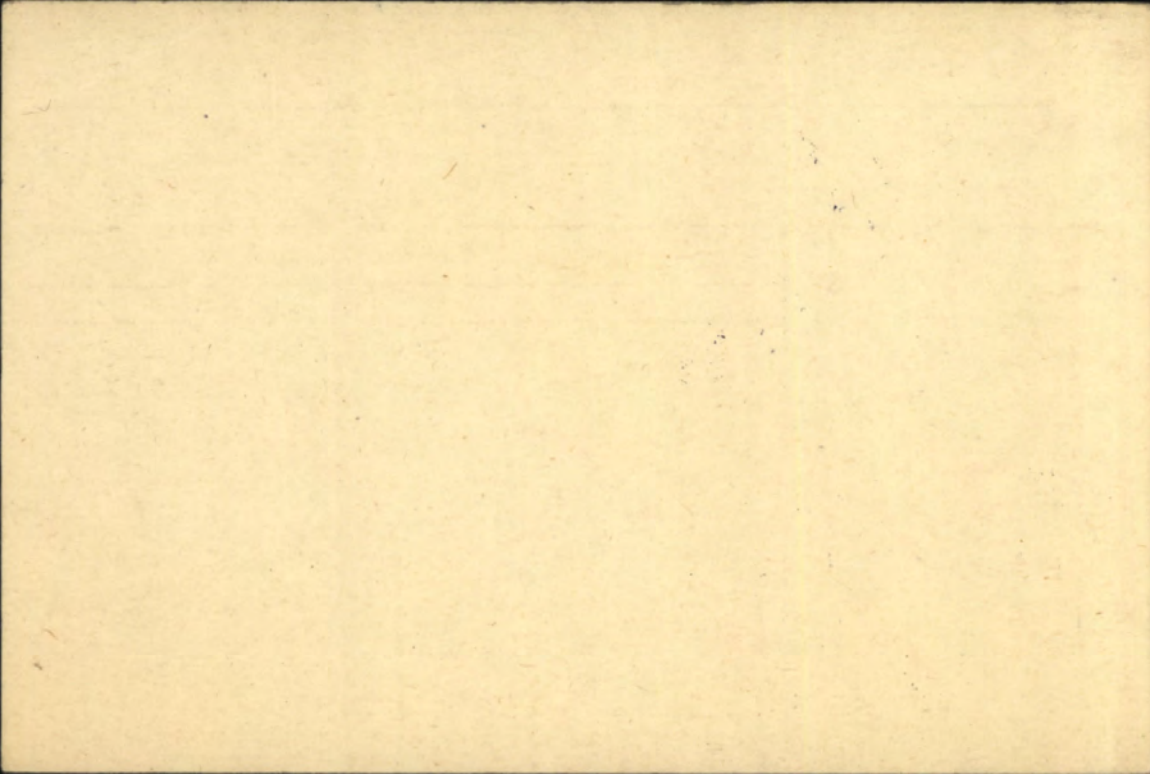

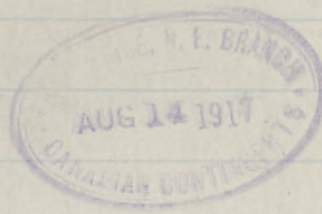
