 On inspiration costal spaces obliterated in right upper front.
 Percussion: Impairment in left upper front (high pitched rales) while note in left axilla is slightly impaired. On auscultation breath sounds in right side are harsh and well heard in upper part and lower portion accompanied by a loud leathery friction which is heard from 3rd C.S. to C.M. On left side, breath sounds diminished over anterior aspect and a few fine sharp superficial crackles can be heard on the upper front and axilla. Both V.F. and V.R. are rather diminished over the left side.
 Behind: On percussion there is well defined impaired resonance at left apex extending down to 5th dorsal spine. While the lower border on left side does not change with deep respiration, on right side there is impaired resonance from 6th spine to base over which area note is flat. Breath sounds over the left apex are of distant blowing breathing character with no moisture. Over the dull area at right base Breath sounds faint without much change in V. R. and V.F.

FAMILY HISTORY March 15/19. Patient has been making an uneventful recovery (Tuberculosis, mental or nervous diseases.) with gradual improvement in colour, nutrition, expression, and fluid has gradually disappeared, but to-day shows some drowsiness, appreciates surroundings but is inattentive to questions.

March 16.18. Listless expression. Takes little nourishment. Drowsiness increased. No signs suggestive of
