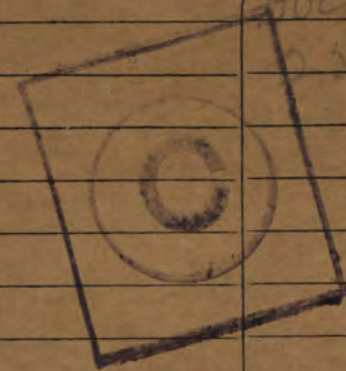

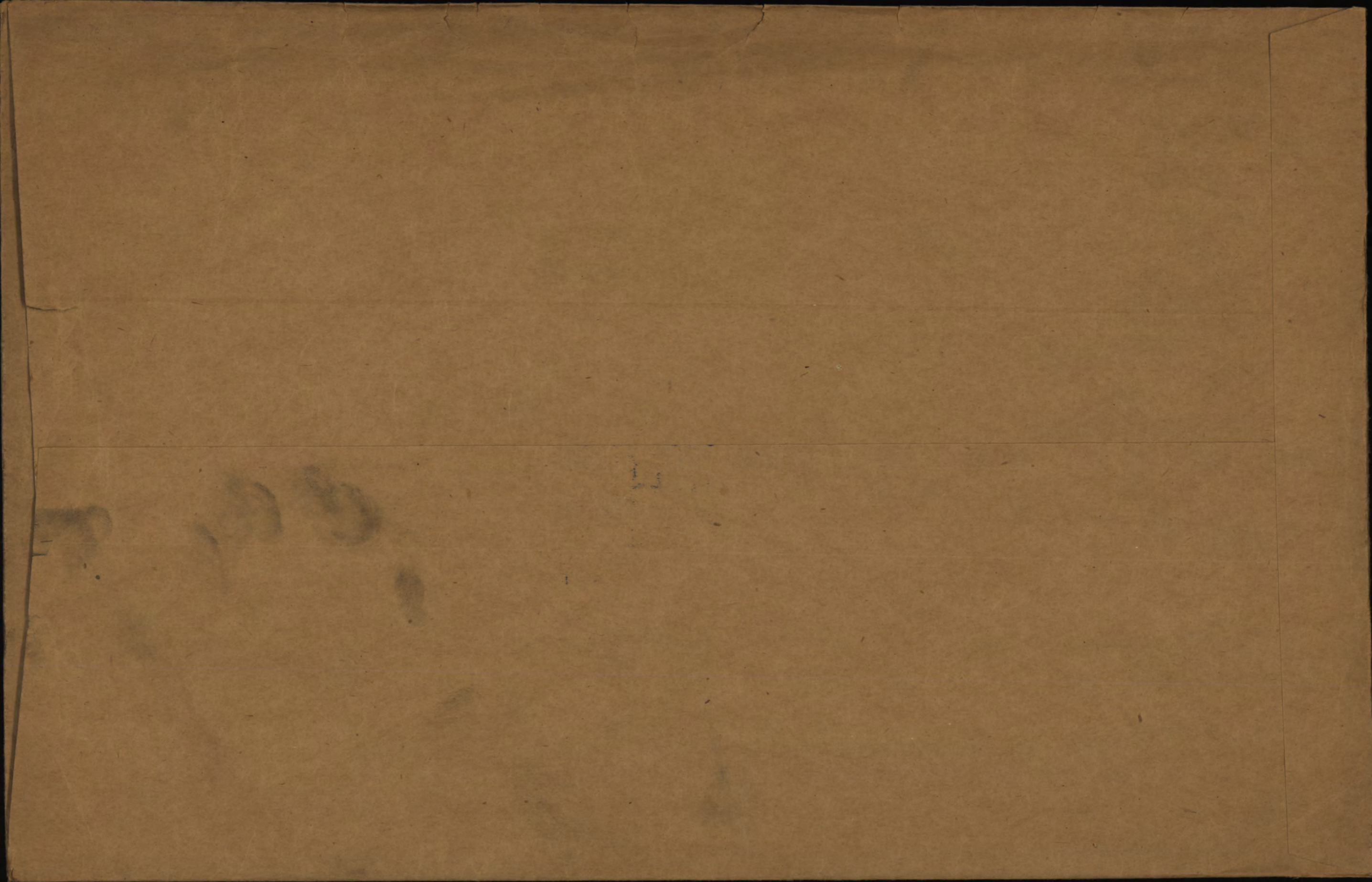

FONTAINE, Armand, was taken on the strength of this Unit on the 26th day of July 1918, and was granted conditional leave of absence as a Farmer from 24-8-18 to 2-12-18. While on this leave he died on October 7th;—1918, as per Certificate of Death quoted herewith.

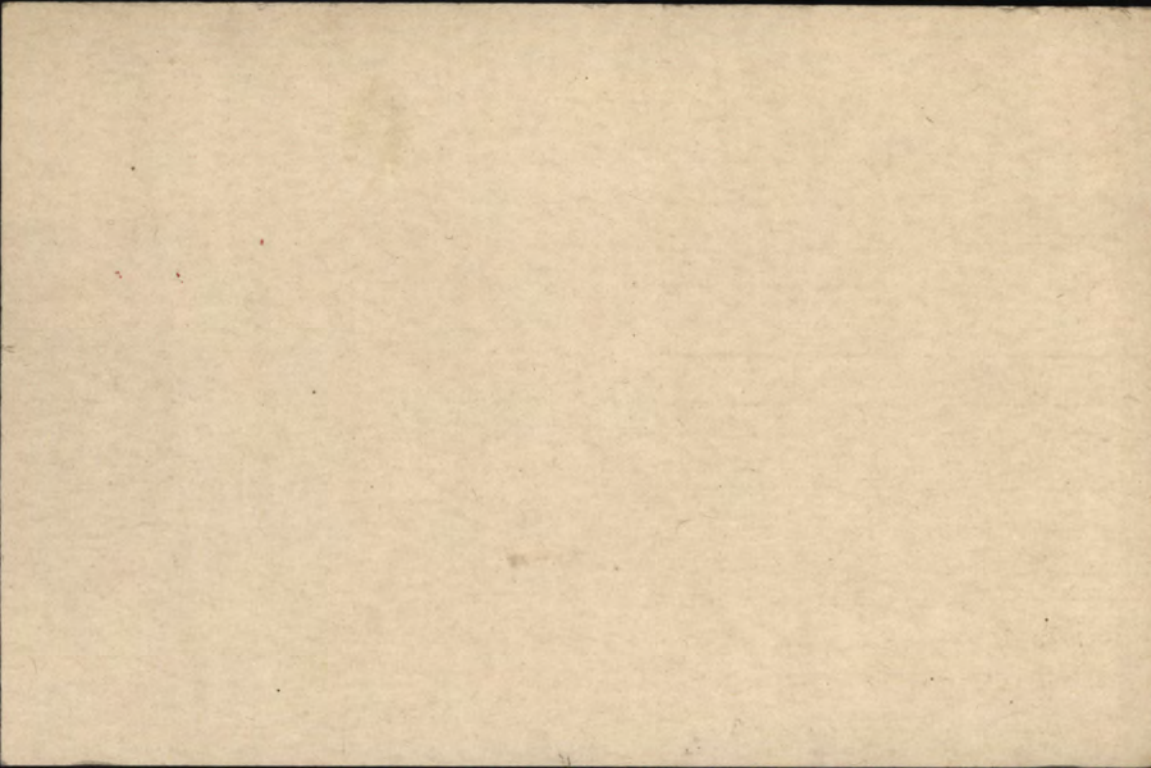
