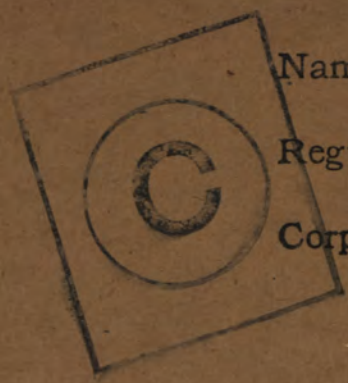

1. He was admitted to Hospital from St. Johns, P.Q. on September 29th 1918, suffering from a severe Influenza. His condition while serious was never any time critical until the morning of the 5th inst. He became suddenly worse just prior to his death at 2 a.m. 5-10-18.
2. His physical examination on admission showed injected throat, cough, Epistaxis, numerous rales over both chests. On the 4th of October he developed signs of consolidation of both lungs.
3. Autopsy findings show a mass of consolidation of both lungs, varying in degree from red to grey hepatization. The character of the Pneumonia being more definitely lobar than bronchial. Cause of death being massive Pneumonia.



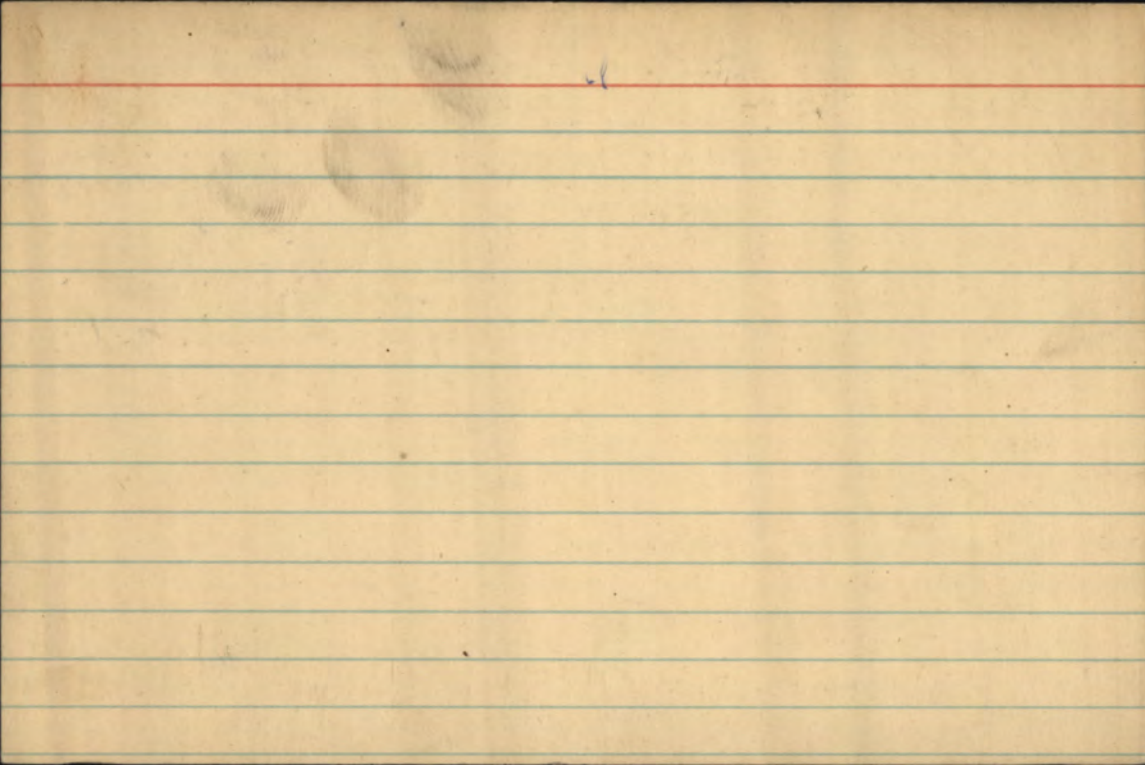
