The Board having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to examine the above named man and find that he was admitted to the C.C.G.P., Base Hospital for nephritis on March 20/17. His case form the 1st was evidently severe and his condition does not seem to yield to treatment. We find that he is gradually getting worse with respiratory difficulties, Oedema and ascites, and at the present time little hopes for his recovery can be entertained. He is totally disabled until Oct. 1st 1917, and further treatment in Base Hospital is indicated.



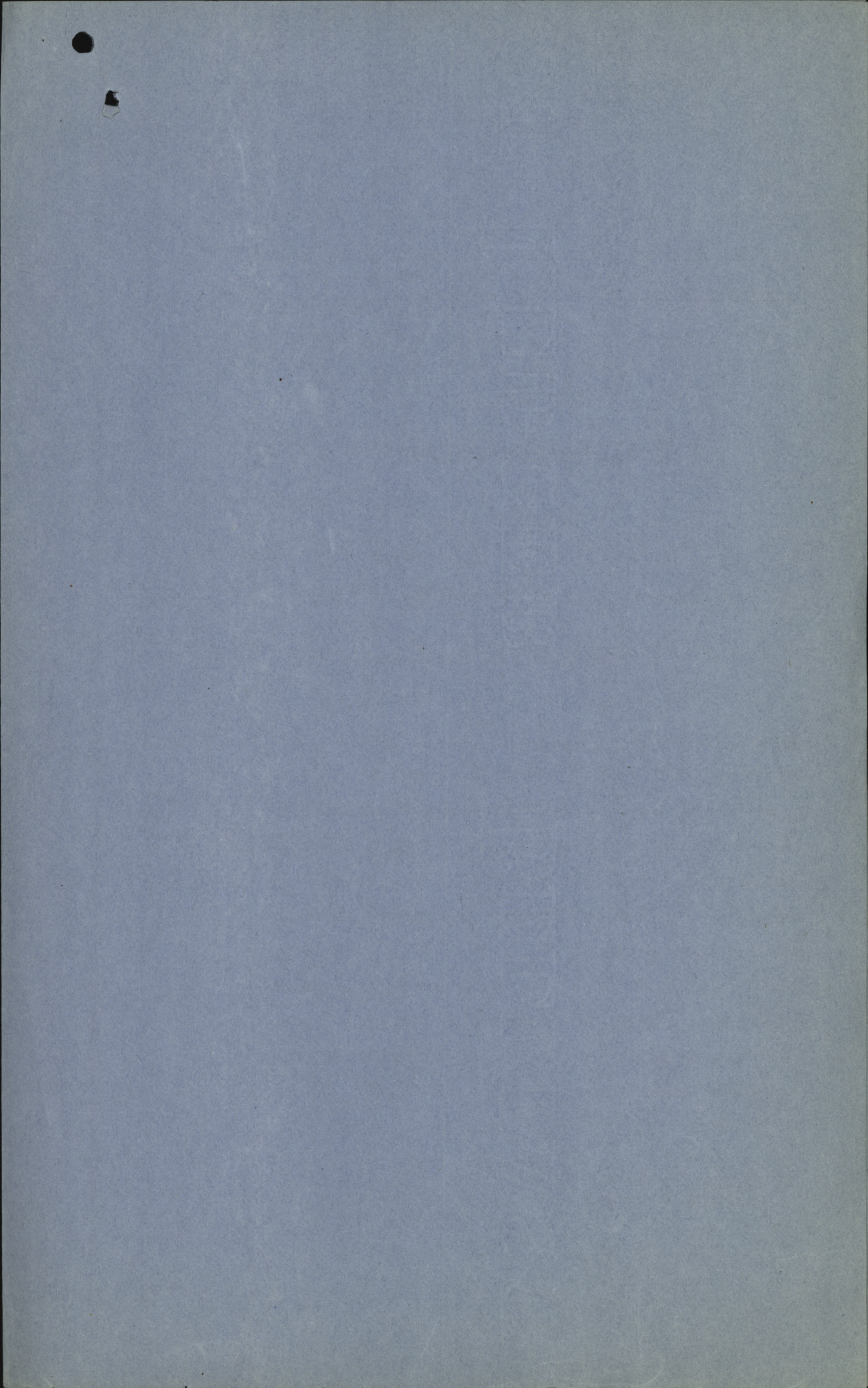
The Board having assembled pursuant to order, proceed to inquire into cause of death of the above named man, who died September 10th at 5.50 a. m. He was an inmate of the C. C. G. P. Base Hospital since the 22nd March, 1917. This man has been suffering from chronic interstitial nephritis since his admission to hospital. This Board is unable to determine the onset of this man's illness, but the history obtained was that he had an attack of diphtheria which began the first day of January, 1917, and he was in poor health ever since. The date of his enlistment is February 12, 1917. The diagnosis, as made by Major Leggett, A. M. C., Medical Officer attached to the above named hospital, was chronic interstitial nephritis, in which opinion this Board concurs.
