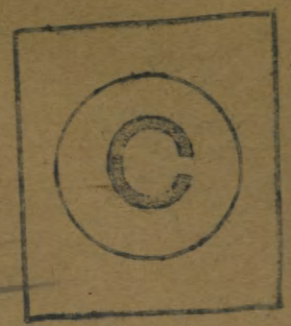

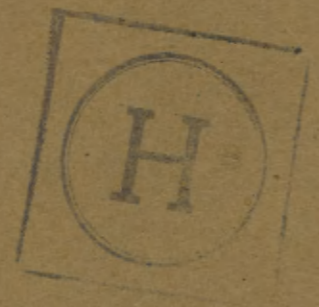

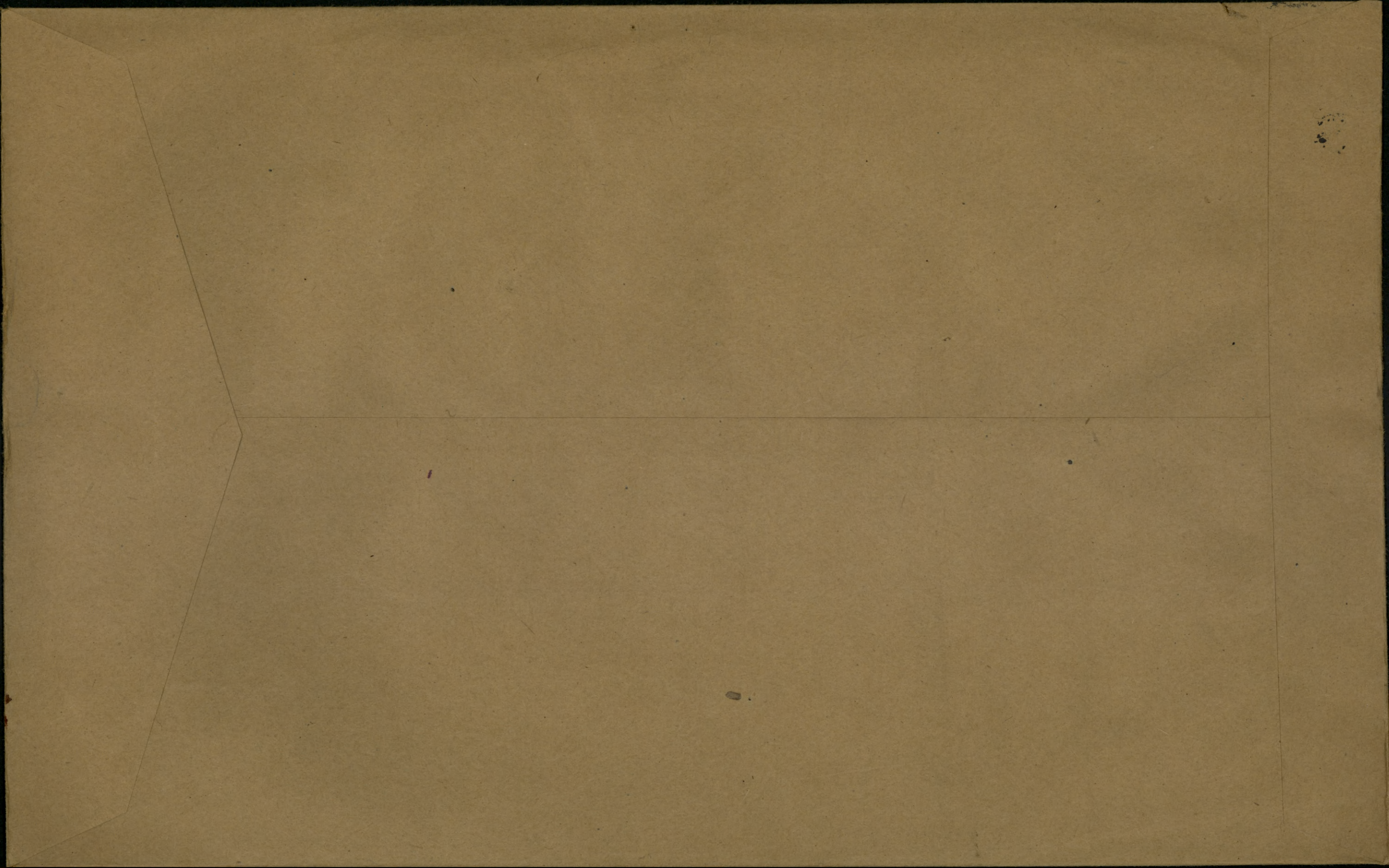

This man arrested and taken at St.Louis Camp took sick the same night and was transferred to Military Hospital Levis.No documents were made out the man being too sick for it.

This man is therefore struck off strength on account of decease with effect from the 19-10-18.

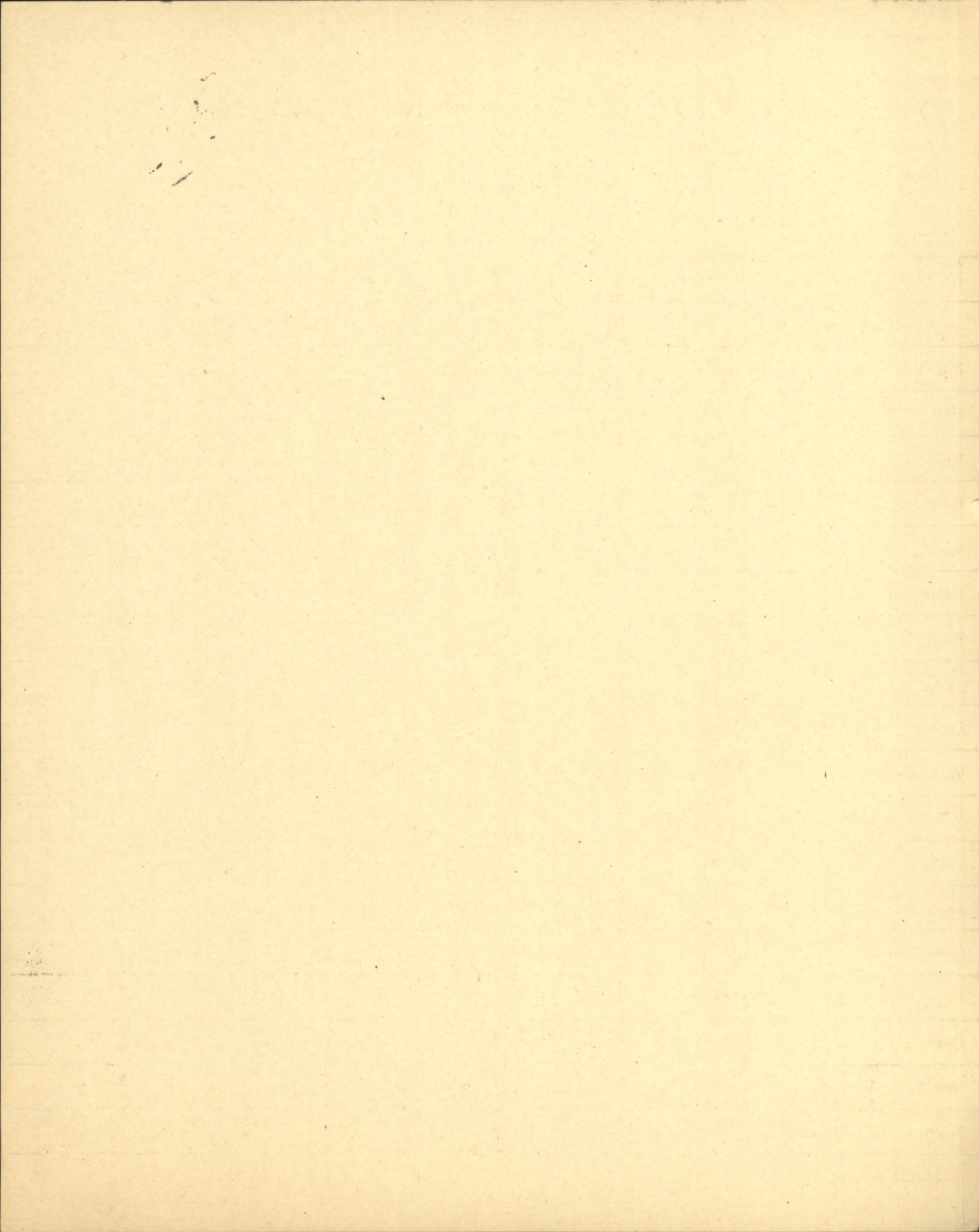
