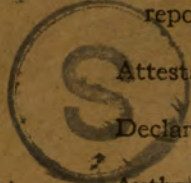

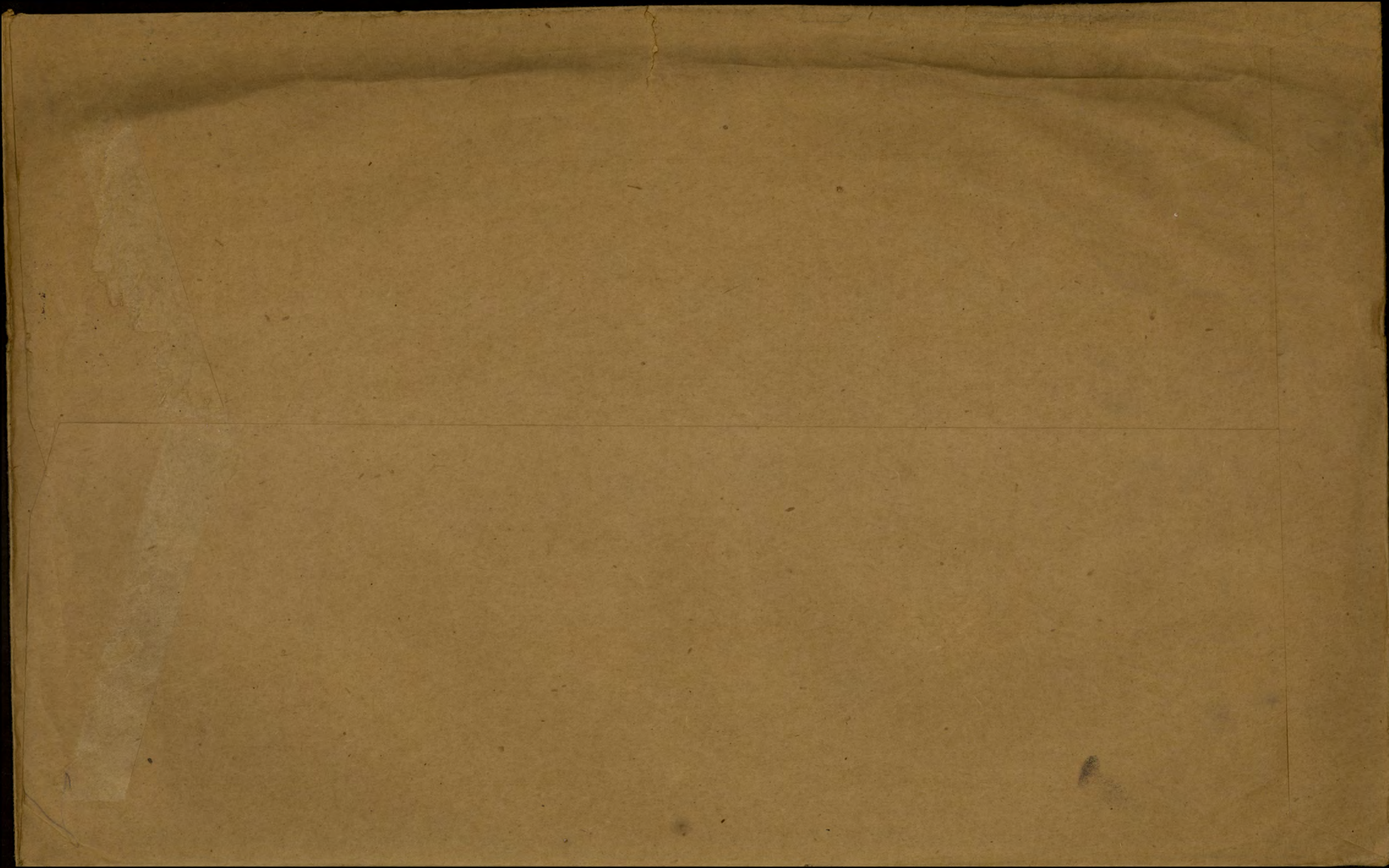



leave at the time of his death.



On or about the 20th. day of Oct, 1918, I was  
called to 300, MacKay St. Montreal, P.Q. to visit  
James Winchell Graham. I found him suffering from  
Influenza with tendency to develop pneumonia.

I advised his removal to a Hospital as it was  
impossible for him to get proper care at his residence.





3rd. Witness.

Capt. I.M. Rabinovitch, C.A.M.C., M.O. Gredadier Guards Emergency Hospital, Montreal, P.Q. being duly sworn, gives evidence as follows:-

On 23rd. day of October, 1918. #3084333 Pte. Graham. James Winchell, was admitted to this Hospital as a civilian patient and subsequently found to be a soldier on Conditional Leave of Absence from the 1st. Depot Battalion, 1st. Quebec Regiment.

He was found to be suffering from Influenza and Broncho-pneumonia. His condition became worse, developing into Toxaemia and he died on 29-10-18 of Pneumonia and Toxaemia.

FINDING

The Court, having considered the evidence brought before them, — find — that #3084333 Pte. Graham. James Winchell, 1st. Depot Bn., 1st. Que. Regt. died of Pneumonia & Toxaemia on the 29-10-18 while on Conditional Leave of Absence, and that the disease was contracted during an epidemic of Influenza and toxic pneumonia through no fault of his own.
