On the advice of Capt Pangle the eye was treated with atropine drops An x ray photo was taken of the neck. Patient stated that after being wounded he had himself removed a large sharp piece of shrapnel from the neck wound.

Haemorrhage from neck wound. Wound opened up. The thyroid cartilage was found fractured & a small piece of it was seen in the wound track. "Haemorrhage probably from the thyroid gland" haemorrhage had been brisk but was controlled by plugging

Further haemorrhage. controlled by plugging. The back goes down & fractured haemorrhage proven. The haemorrhage - means - came from deep from probably vertebral veins

Patient had another sharp haemorrhage & the neck was then after being opened up & the thyroid back of the thyroid axis artery was found to be torn & to be the source of haemorrhage. This was tied & the wound packed with gauze.

There was no further haemorrhage. But patient developed a (?) septic shock pneumonia or lung abscess & gradually went down hill
