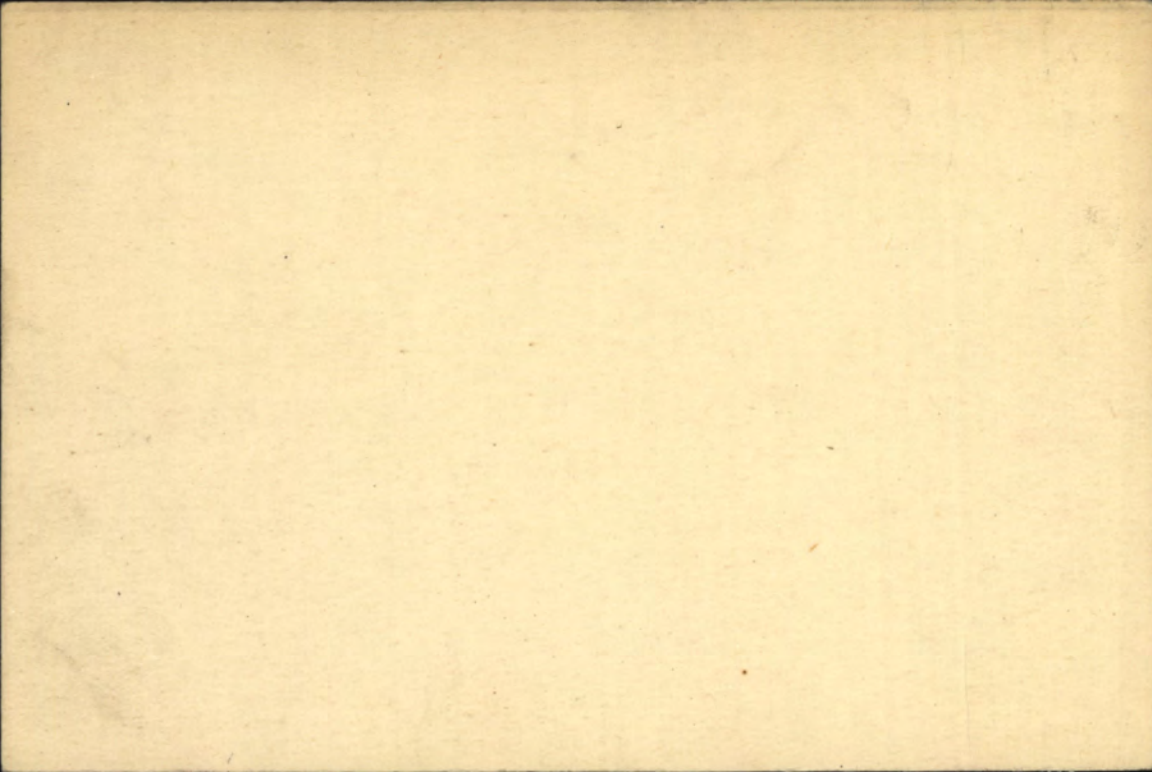

sober. He was quite different to his usual self.
I never thought he would injure himself in any
way. He had a letter about a week previously
which he told me was from his girl. He seemed

to be thinking rather during the last month.

We reported to the C.O.

Fredk. Wm Taylor Police Sergeant stationed at Mortimer on his oath saith just after 11 a.m. Sunday 12th inst I heard by telephone from Upton Camp & went to Overton Pond Upton in company with Major Hines. We saw the body in the water about 6 yards from the bank. I towed the body to the bank with a long branch & with assistance got it out. It was lying with its face upturned legs right down & the hands down by the side. It was very much decomposed & the water was about

5 to 6 feet deep where it was. The body may have drifted to this spot. I searched it & found 7/8 in cash, his identity disc, a French testament, some photographs, a note book & letter written in French which I've had translated. We had received notice from the military on the 16th April that he was absent
