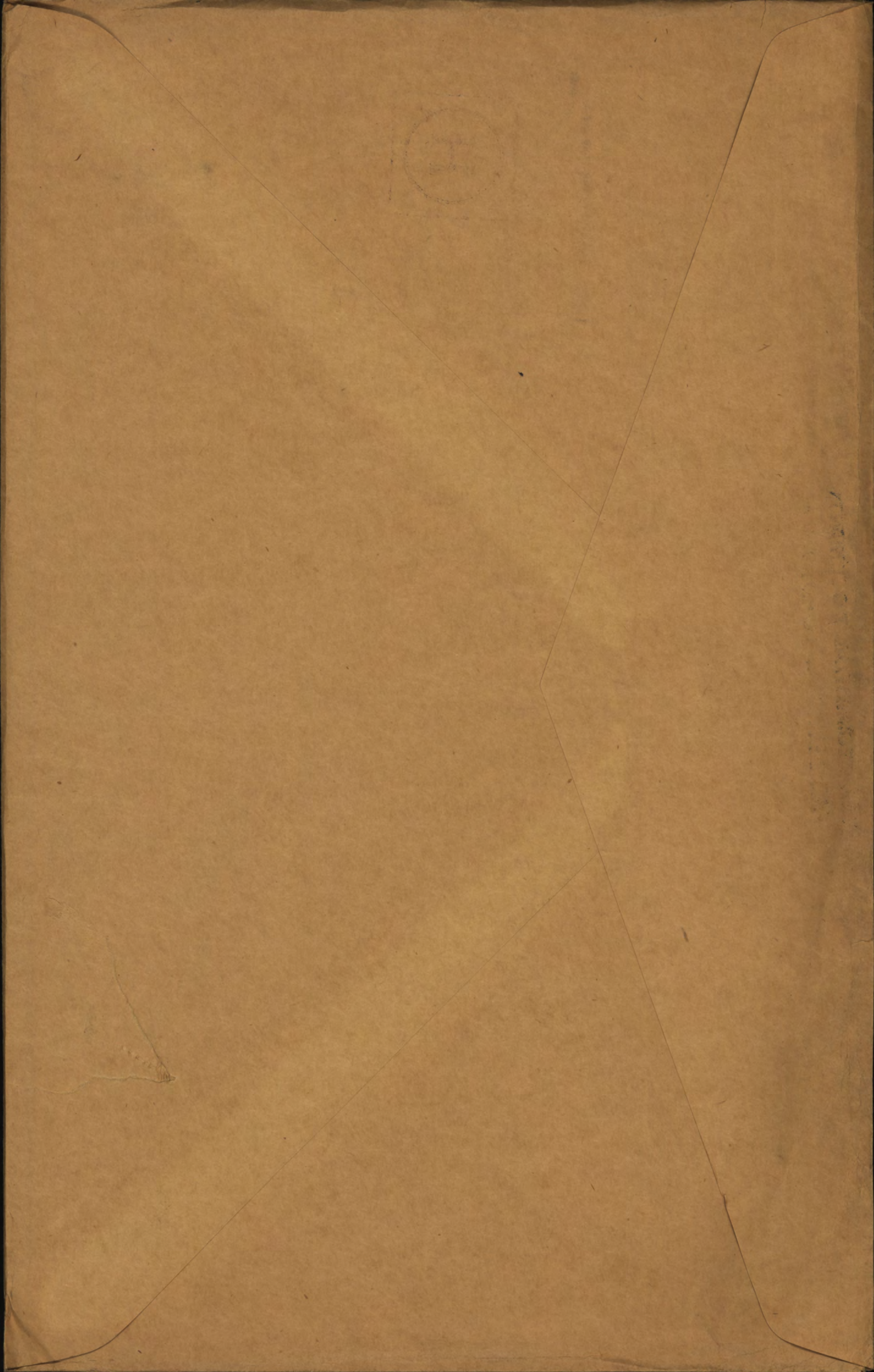

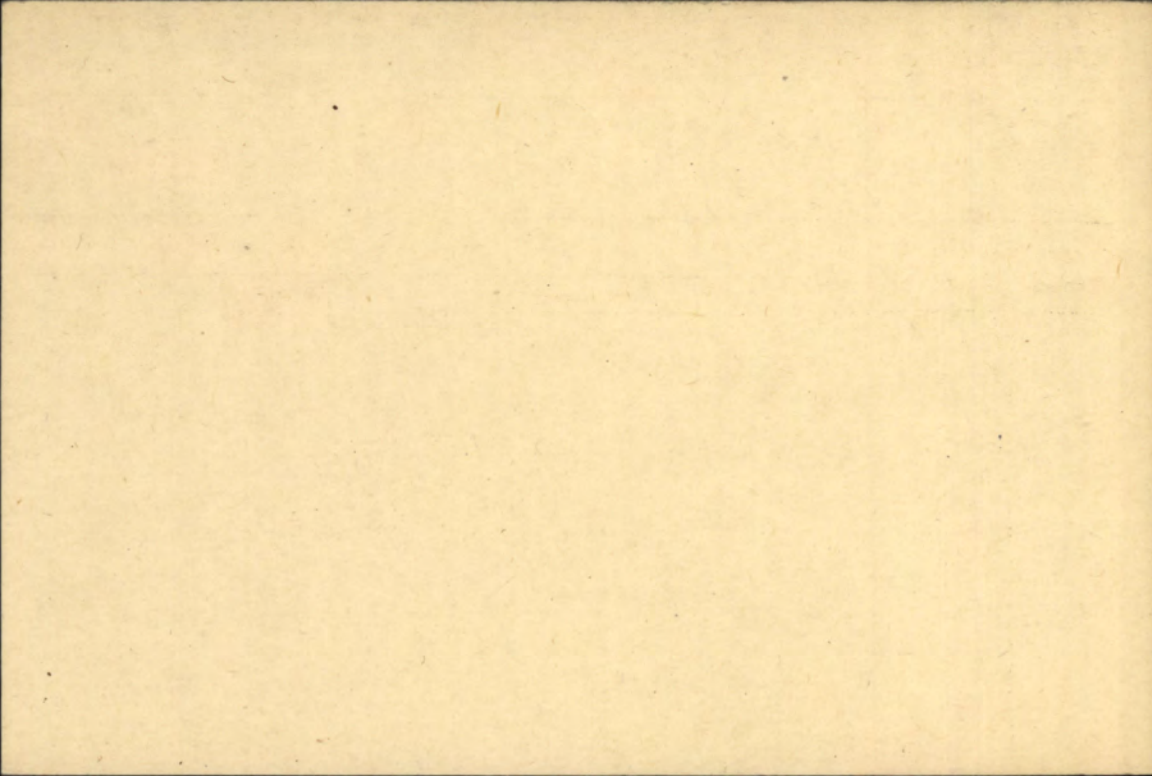

Complaint.

Soreness in right knee joint and swelling around same. Says the knee cap becomes dislocated while walking or stepping on a small stone or pebble. On examination. There is only a difference of one quarter of an inch in the circumference of the joint just above the knee cap. There is no pain on pressure except on inward pressure of the inner surface of tibia + femur surfaces together. There is slight soreness on the interior - anterior surface of tibia.

Magnesium Sulphate Solution one half ounces to the pint and 10 min of Carbolic acid. Applied hot and kept hot.

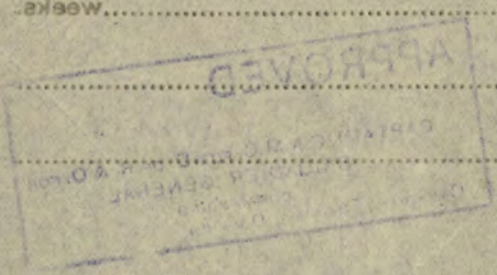

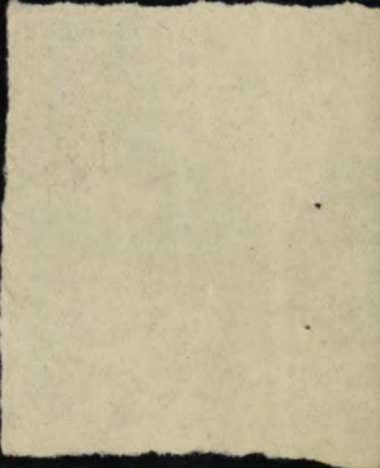

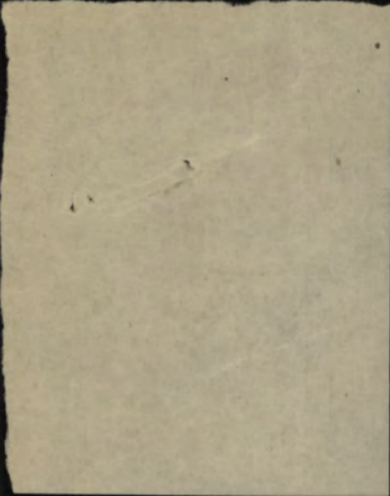
