On the night of November 16th., 1917, I was with Sapper Lemelin. We were going to the Sheemaker's shop, and I was leading the way in the dark. When crossing the trestle bridge, and almost to the far side, I heard something fall, or roll, into the Canal behind me. I immediately turned round and shouted, "Fred! Fred!", but there was no reply or no further sound. I then called out for assistance and a man ran over to the bridge. Together we climbed down to the edge of the water and succeeded in finding the body and bringing same to the bank. I recognized the body as Sapper A. Lemelin. There were ~~no~~ wounds on the head and life appeared to be extinct. ~~He~~ Other men were attracted by my cries, and I sent one of them for the Medical Officer.

At about 8.15 P.M., on the night of November 16th, 1917, I was standing in the doorway of my hut when I heard cries for assistance from the direction of the trestle bridge nearby. I immediately ran over and met Sapper Navion on the Bridge. Together we descended to the water's edge and pulled out the body, which I recognized as Sapper A. Lemelin. There were ~~no~~ ~~He~~ wounds on the head and he appeared dead. I tried to revive him, but was unsuccessful.

On the 16th I was acting as Orderly Sergeant of the day. At about 8.20 p.m. Sapper Navion reported to me that Sapper Lemelin had fallen off the trestle bridge and ^{been} killed. I immediately went to the scene of the accident and examined the body which I found on the bank. There were ~~two~~ wounds on the head, and life was extinct. ~~It~~ It appeared as if he had fallen off the bridge in the extreme darkness; struck his head on a pile of loose stones, which were laying on the bank near the water, and then rolled into the water. I inquired if the Medical Officer had been summoned, and was told that he had been sent for immediately the body was found.

At about 8.25 P.M. on the night of Nov.16th, 1917, a soldier reported to me that a man had been drowned in the Canal which runs through the Camp. I immediately went to the scene of the accident and examined the body, which was then laying on the bank. Death was due to severe injuries to the head, which were evidently caused by striking the hard bank, and before the body fell into the water.

That the death of Sapper Lemelin was accidental, and that no blame can be attached to any person or persons.
