He was given treatment and his condition improved, and on June 18th.1917, he was discharged to Clearing Station for transfer to Special Service Company as fit for Home Service, Class G-3. He was re-admitted to the Grey Nun's Convalescent Home from the Montreal General Hospital on June 30th.1917 suffering from a relapse of Pyelitis and was given treatment. On July 6th.1917 he was given a furlough until August 10th.1917. From August 10th. to September 25th.1917 he was under treatment, and on this latter date he was brought forward on M.F.B. 227 to be discharged as medically unfit. The Standing Medical Board on September 26th.1917 recommended that he be kept under further observation for one month. 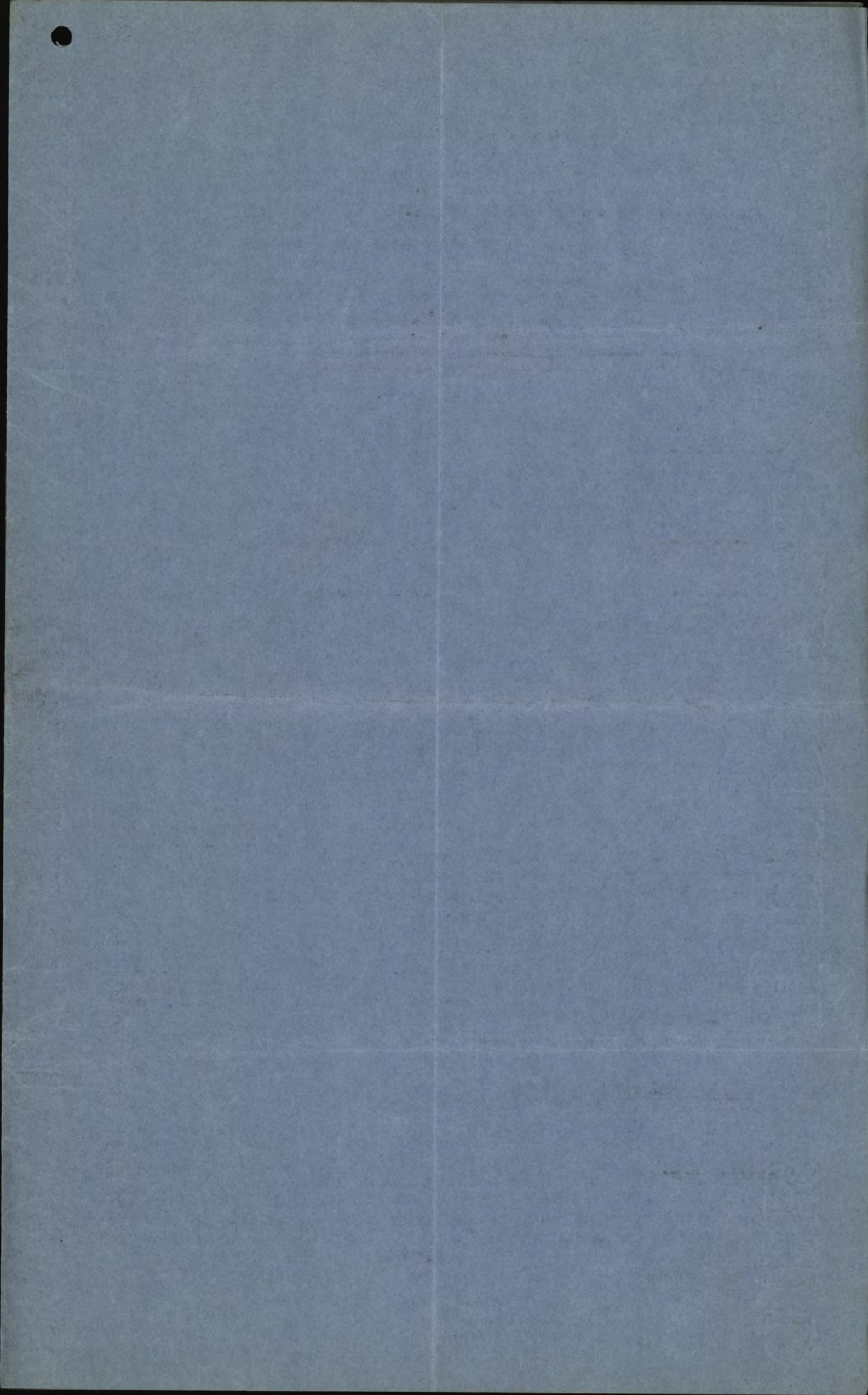
