**CONDITION ON ADMISSION AND PROGRESS OF CASE** Enlisted Oct. 23rd 1914. Apparently healthy until June 1916 when patient noticed "weakness" of back and "no strength" with no other complaints. Was sent out of line for "loss of strength" and was sent to hospital for observation for 3 weeks. Returned to duty and although there was no definite complaint until Aug. 1918 except weakness. In Aug. 1918 was "blown up" by a shell and was buried. Was not injured but reported sick "feeling all in" and was sent to Bologne. Since then has lost weight rapidly, rapidly becoming weak, passing much water and always thirsty. Patient thinks that for one year his thirst and polyuria has been in existence. In Canterbury Hospital was placed on egg diet and vegetables, but no starvation. In Moore Barracks when starvation was practised for 2 days. Then placed on meat and vegetable diet on 3rd day being given stew. Apparently while in Moore Barracks had not lost any weight and was feeling fairly well. Taken to Kirkdale and went aboard Ship "Araguay" in Feb, 1919 and in spite of warning to attendants was given Biscuits, Peas, Meat and while on ship, weakness and loss of weight became marked daily and headaches appeared which became worse daily, and drowsy feeling and difficulty with vision.

**Admitted 15.2.19. Ste Anne de Bellevue Military Hospital.**  
**Physical Examination on admission:-** White male of about 35 years of age.

**FAMILY HISTORY** drowsy, listless, expression, face markedly flushed, some (Tuberculosis, mental or nervous diseases.) apparent dyspnoea. Marked Acetone odor. Answers questions unintelligibly and is very disinterested but a definite history can be obtained although in a very disconnected manner. Pupils equal and active. Mouth parched, dry. Fairly well developed, marked

**TREATMENT** loss of sub cutaneous fat. **Urinalysis:-** Marked reduction of (Especially any specific or special form.) Fehling and reaction for Acetone and diacetic. Patient apparently on verge of Diabetic Coma. Venesection of 400 cc blood and Intravenous administration of Saline 1000 cc every six hours. Feb. 16.19. Brighter expression and takes more interest in surroundings. Still marked Acetone odour. Saline still continues.

**CONDITION ON DISCHARGE** Feb. 17.19. No evidence of <sup>any</sup> pending coma today. (and disposal made of case.) Saline still continues. Total Sugar output 176 gms in 24 hours.

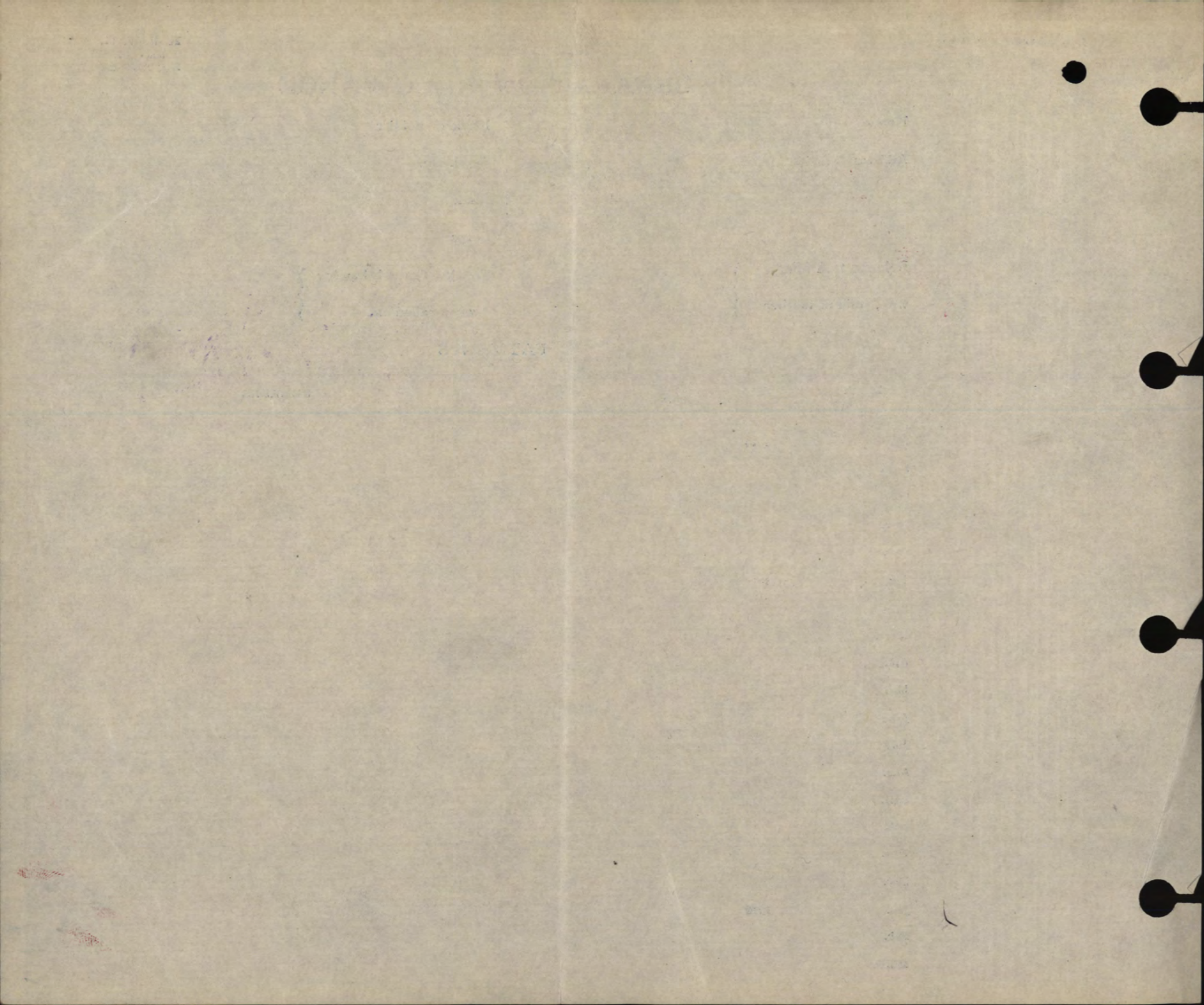

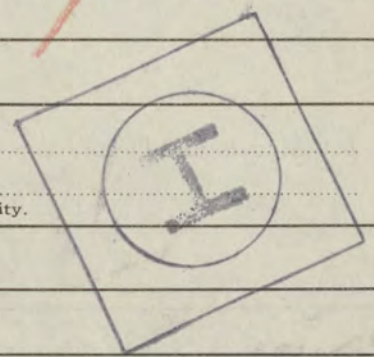
