EXAMEN RADIOLOGIQUE mod. has frequent night sweats. Moderate edema is present. His sight has become very defective. He complains constantly of motes passing before his eyes.

MARCHE DE LA MALADIE Radiograph shows no calculi, perhaps nephritis is of bacterial origin. Patient's general health is rapidly declining and we recommend him for Board at Home with diagnosis of chronic Nephritis.
