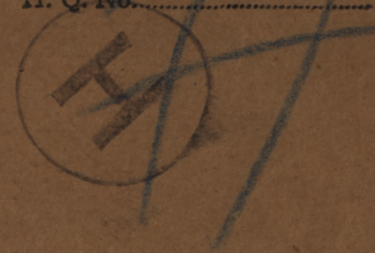
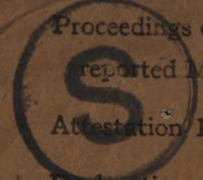

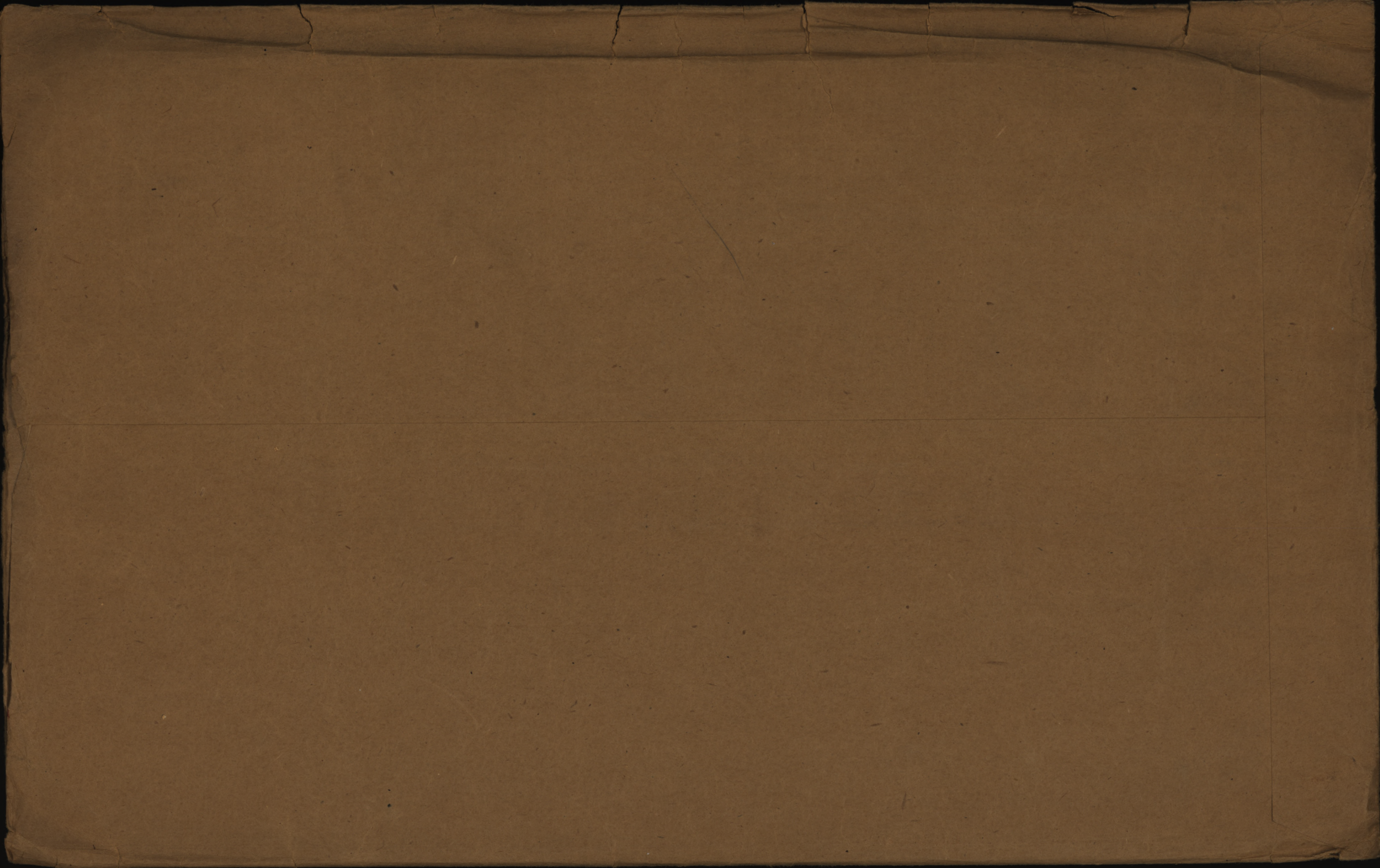

Disease Influenza?

Some 3 days ago pt reported complaining of constipation which had lasted 3 days. Several doses of medicine were given and pt had several bowel movements yesterday. He has had no headache, sore throat, pains in leg or back. His only complaint was gastric discomfort and slight nausea.

PT is not as a rule constipated but when he is he finds it is hard to move bowels with purgatives.

Exam: - PT slightly flushed - temp & pulse raised. Tongue coated throat a little dry.

Abdomen: - negative. Chest shows a slightly less resonant percussion note on left side post by infra - below middle of scapula, a few rales heard base. But no pleural effusion or chest.

Treat: - fluids: pt to be under observation.
