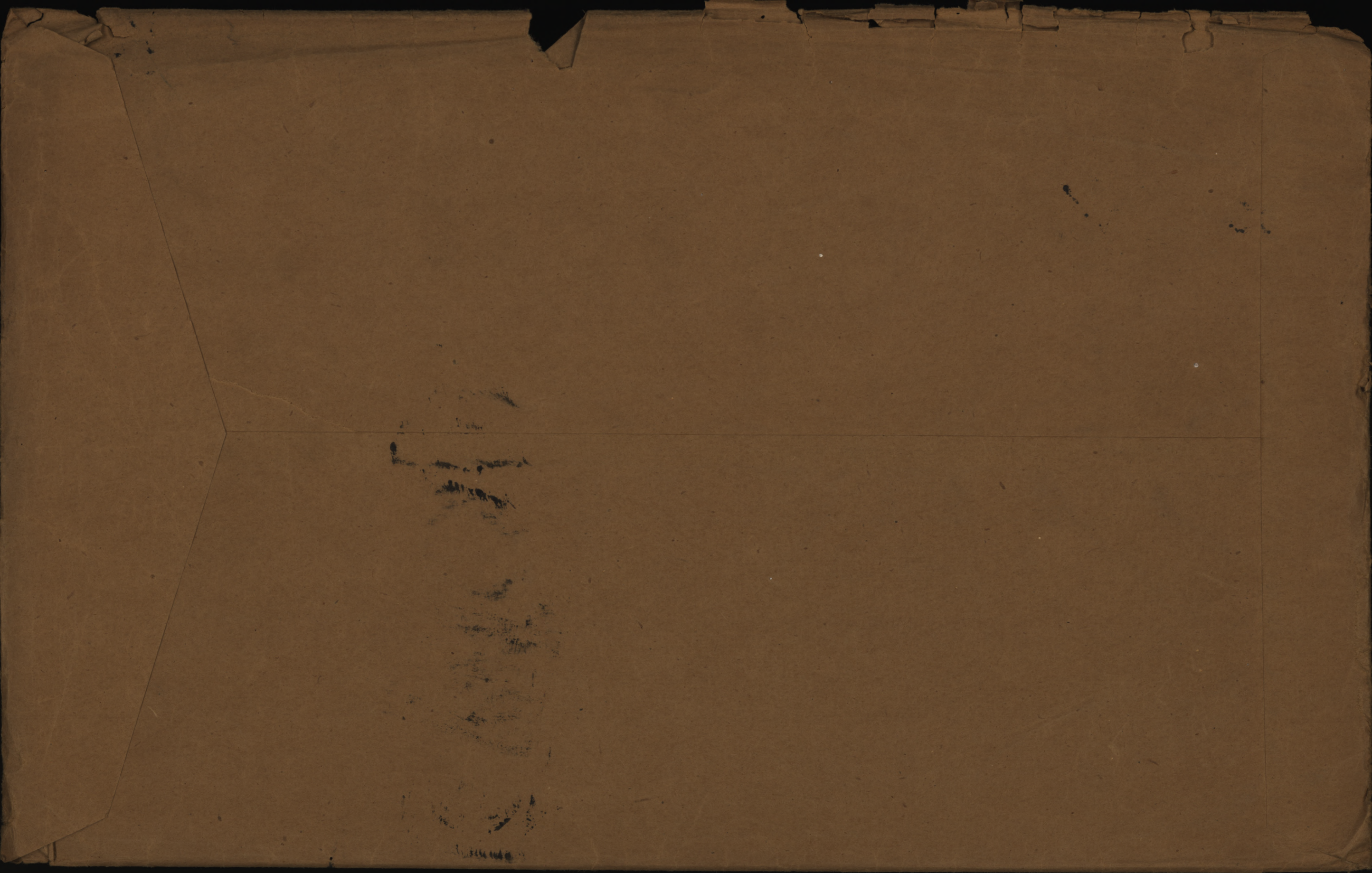

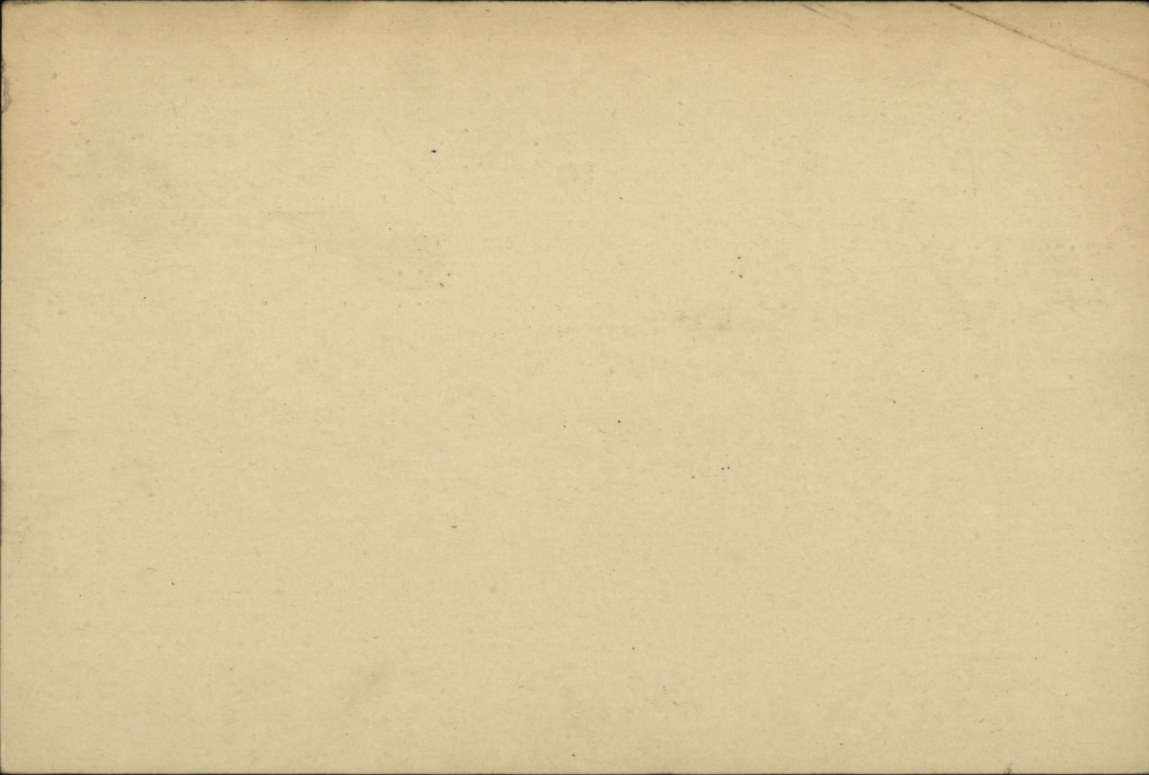

I beg to submit the attached copy of correspondence received by the Officer in charge, Ypres Sub Office, Canadian War Graves Detachment from Samuel Merrill, Esq., 45 Bellevue Avenue, Cambridge, Mass. U.S.A., concerning the correct identity of the marginally named deceased Canadian Soldier.

It would appear from the Director of Military Estates letter No. 649-S-19189 dated 24th April 1918 that the particulars No. 343939, Gnr. Merrill, W. have been verified and accepted as being correct for No. 343949 Gnr. Stanley, A.A.

Would you please advise therefore whether this change has been made in the man's records and whether a correction was sent to the D.G.G.R. & E. London.

The Father made a request to the Quartermaster General's Department, Washington for permission to have his Son's remains re-buried in an American Cemetery at Paris but is now content to have the body remain in Ypres Prison Cemetery, Sheet 28. 1.7.b.05.45. providing these correct particulars can be registered.

I am forwarding copies of this correspondence to the D.G.G.R. & E. and Principal Secretary, Imperial War Graves Commission, Winchester House, London and will await your early reply as to what action has been taken, please.

Sir:

My son WAINWRIGHT MERRILL a citizen of the United States and a resident of Cambridge, Massachusetts, enlisted in November 1916 in the Canadian Artillery under the name ARTHUR A. STANLEY. He was killed in Ypres, November 6, 1917, his age being 19 years. He was serving at the time as a Gunner in the 6th Canadian Siege Battery, his regimental number being 343939.

The said Wainwright Merrill (Arthur A. Stanley) is buried in the Ypres Reservoir North Cemetery, his grave being No. 91 in Row 1 Plot 1. His grave is marked with a wooden cross bearing the inscription:

Memory
of

Gnr. A.A. STANLEY 343939

6th Canadian Siege Bty.

Killed
in
Action

Nov. 6th
1917.

(There is a bullet hole
in the cross below the
inscription.)

I have considered making a request that I be allowed to have his body removed to an American Cemetery in France, but having visited his grave I have concluded that it would be much better to let his body remain where it lies, provided that a correct inscription showing his true name and nationality shall be placed on the permanent marker to be set up at the grave.

The inscription which I would ask to have inscribed on the headstone is:-

(Harvard College 1919).

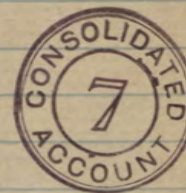

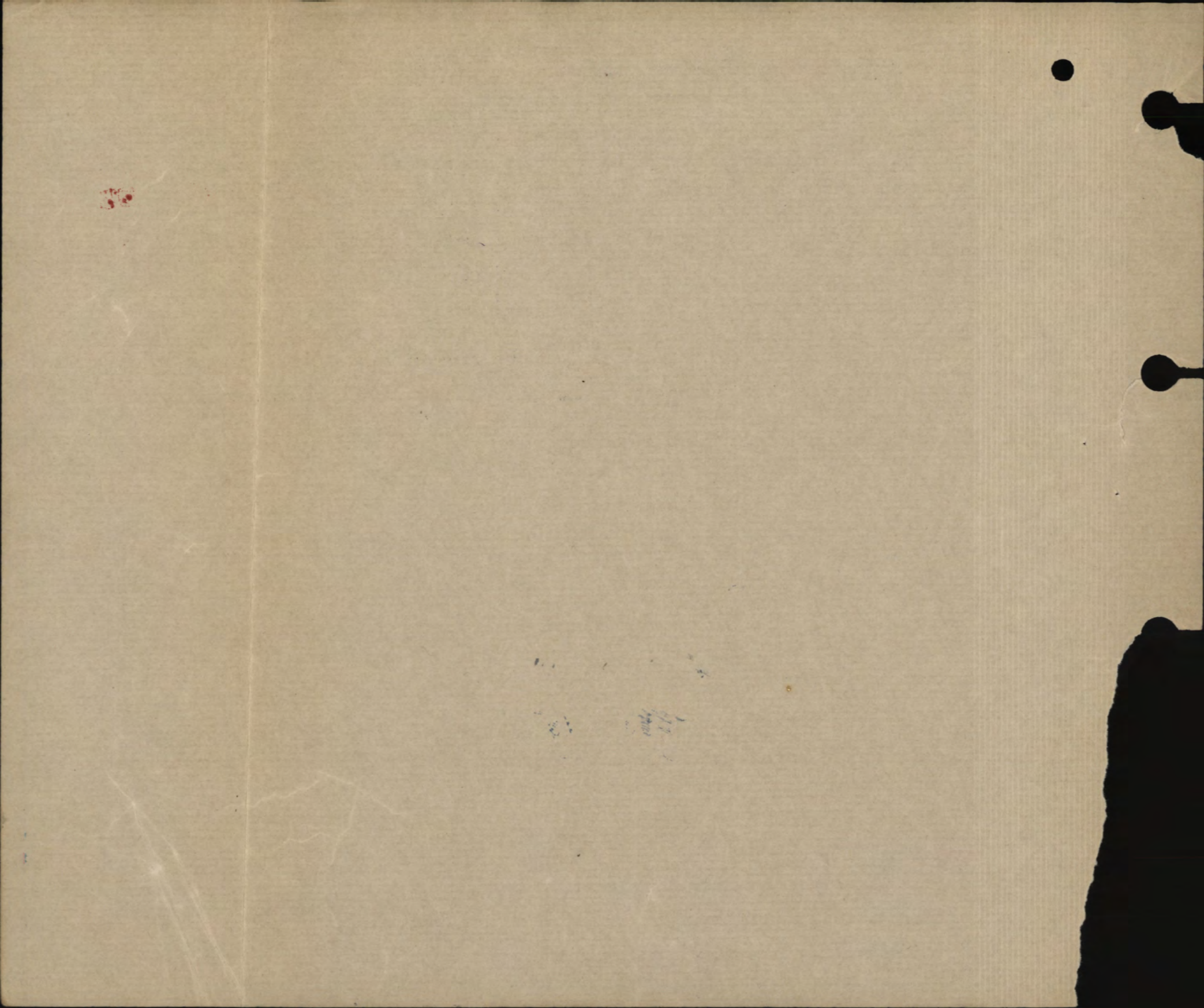

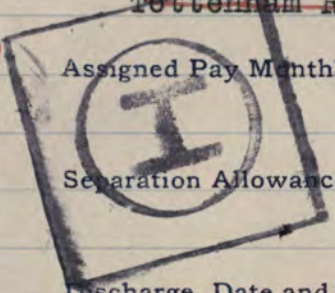
