he was seized with a sudden pain in appendiceal region, sent to Sholden Lodge Hospital, treated for acute recurrent attacks of abd. pain from 3-8-16 - 9-10-16 Transferred to Shorncliffe Military Hospital. Temp. 99 Vomited 5 or 6 times for three weeks. He was put on Leanhearts diet with marked improvement. He was sent Home for Convalescence. Gained 13 lbs in five weeks.

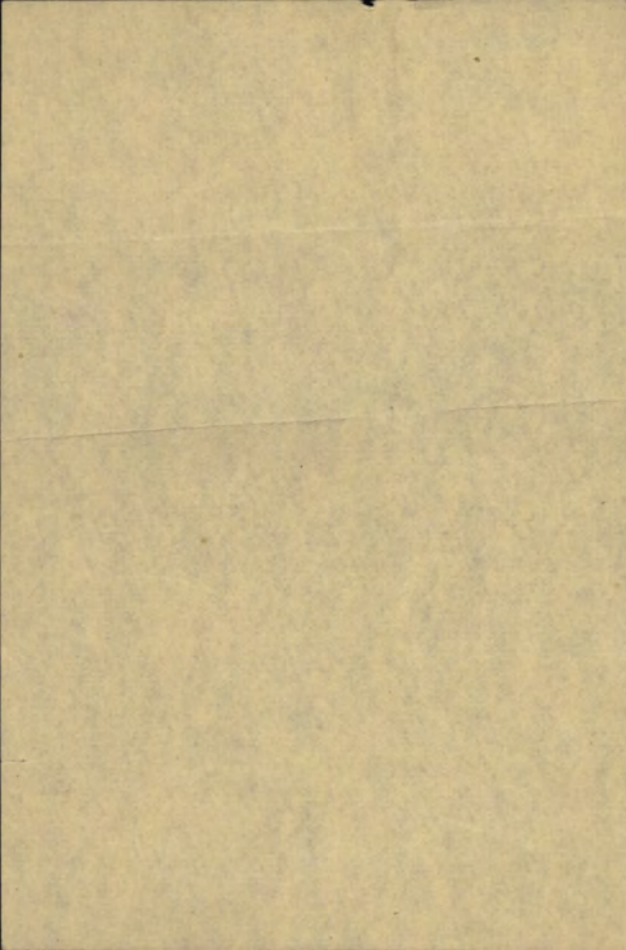
