I assisted in bringing the body to the Quay. He was dressed in military service uniform. He had a cut on his forehead. The body was lying on the bed of the river, the tide being very low.

On 29th October, 1918, about 12.00, I was in the Town of Etaples, and was informed by a French woman that a body had been found in the river near the E.F.C. Stores. I proceeded to the office of the A.P.M., who instructed me to go to the mortuary to identify the body if possible. I viewed the body found in the river, and identified it as No. 755160 Pte. TREMBLEY J. (52nd Bn. C.E.F.) Canadian Labour Pool.

I last saw this man alive at about 1945 on 28-10-18 in an Estaminet in the vicinity of the water front.

The only mark I saw on his body was a cut on the forehead, which he had received in an accident about two weeks previous.
