Information has just been received from overseas that the remains of your son, D.82925 Private Carl Melvin Fried, have now been carefully exhumed from the original place of interment and reverently reburied in grave 23, row D, plot 9, of Cassino Military Cemetery, Cassino, Italy. Marked map is enclosed. This is a recognized military burial ground and will receive care and maintenance in perpetuity.

The grave will have been temporarily marked with a wooden marker in the form of the Star of David which will be replaced in due course by a permanent headstone suitably inscribed. While it cannot now be stated when this work of permanent commemoration will begin, before any action is taken you will be communicated with and an opportunity will be given you to submit a short personal inscription of your own choice for engraving on the headstone. I was not aware that Pte Fried, C.M., was with this Unit on 23 May 44, and I can offer no information as to the circumstances under which he became involved in the battle of 23 May 44.

I had his body wrapped in blankets and conveyed to the Unit cemetery. I can offer no information in respect to his return to this Unit, or his part in the battle on 23 May 44.

First Witness:- B 54795 Pte CHURCH Z W, having been duly sworn states:-

I am B 54795 Pte Church, Z W, 48th Highlanders of Canada, at present serving on the staff of 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp. On 17 May 44 I was detailed to escort D 82925 Pte Fried, an S.U.S. of this camp to 1 Cdn Gen Hosp for admittance. Also accompanying me was a Pte. Shepard who had been discharged from 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp and was proceeding for admittance to 1 Cdn Gen Hosp. I was carrying documents of both men.

When I arrived at 1 Cdn Gen Hosp, I took both men to A & D room. I handed documents of Pte Fried to desk clerk who, after consulting the M.O. of the day, informed me that as Pte Fried was for X-Ray, I would have to return him to 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp and return at 0900 hrs the following morning. Pte Fried overheard this conversation as he was standing directly behind me and leaning on his cane.

I then handed Pte Shepherd's documents to the desk clerk and after explaining that Pte Shepherd was not an S.U.S. but had been released that day, I turned around to find that Pte Fried had disappeared. I immediately went to the truck which was transporting us and asked Pte Peters who was travelling with us for the ride, if Pte Fried had returned to the truck. He answered "No, the last time I saw him was when he entered the A & D room with you."

In the meantime Pte James, who was the driver of the truck had returned from the latrine and in company with Pte James and Pte Peters, we immediately started a search of the Hospital and Hospital grounds. We found no trace of Pte Fried but we found his cane out in the yard of the Hospital. Pte Peters remembered hearing someone shout to a vehicle that was leaving the hospital grounds, "Where are you off to?", the reply was "Naples". We came to the conclusion that Pte Fried had got on this truck. I went into the A & D room in the Hospital and phoned 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp and told the Orderly Room Clerk what had happened. We immediately left the Hospital and went to L. of C. Provost Coy in Avellino and gave them a full description of Pte Fried and what had happened. Capt Ogilvie, the D.A.P.M., was present in the L. of C. Provost Coy office, was asked if we could proceed on road to Naples to try and find Pte Fried. We travelled approximately 15 miles and decided the chase was useless so returned to 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp. I reported to the A/RSM of this camp exactly what had happened.

Q. 1. Were you the only escort detailed to escort Pte Fried to the Hospital?

A. 1. Yes, Sir.

Q. 2. At approximately what time did you arrive at the Hospital?

A. 2. At approximately 1630 hrs, Sir.

Q. 3. Who were present when you entered the A & D room at the Hospital?

A. 3. There was a clerk at the desk and numerous other people waiting in the A & D room or passing in and out.

Q. 4. Were you long explaining and turning over the documents of Pte Shepherd?

A. 4. Approximately 3 or 4 minutes, Sir.

Q. 5. To what extent did you search the Hospital and grounds?

A. 5. We spent 10 or 15 minutes searching immediate grounds and ground floor of the Hospital and asked several people if they had seen a man with a slight limp. We gave up the search and I went and phoned 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp.

Second Witness:- F 85609 Pte CUNNINGHAM, R H, having been duly sworn, states:-

I am F 85609 Pte Cunningham, R H, a member of the Cdn Provost Corps, on staff of 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp. At approximately 1700 hrs on 17 May 44, whilst employed as clerk in Unit Orderly Room, I received a phone call from Pte Church stating he was at No. 1 Cdn Gen Hospital and that Pte Fried had escaped from his custody and asked me to report the fact to A/RSM Ferris, which I did at once.

Third Witness:- A 28018 Pte PETERS, C, having been duly sworn, states:-

I am A 28018 Pte Peters, C., R.C.A.S.C. on strength of 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp. On 17 May 44 I travelled with a vehicle proceeding from 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp to 1 Cdn General Hospital. I was not on duty as it was my day off and I went for the ride.

Pte. Church, who was escorting two soldiers to 1 Cdn General Hospital, on arrival there went into A and D room with the two men. About ten minutes after entering A and D room Pte. Church came out to lorry where I was and asked me if I had seen Pte. Fried. I said "No". The last I saw of him was when he went into A and D room with you". Pte Church went back in A and D room and then around to main entrance to the building and returned to Vehicle saying he couldn't see him. Pte Church, Pte James and myself proceeded to search the staff tent lines and roads within hospital grounds. We called Fried's name repeatedly but received no answer. After about 15 minutes we returned to lorry and Pte Church went into A and D room and phoned 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp. We got into truck and went direct to L of C Provost Coy office and notified them about the incident. We then drove out the highway towards Naples several miles but could find no trace of Pte Fried. We returned to 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp.


Q. 1. Why was the search conducted on road between Avellino and Naples?

A. 1. Whilst at hospital I heard someone asking if there were any more going on a truck that was there and ready to leave for Naples. We thought perhaps Fried may have got on this lorry.

Fourth Witness:- M-30849 Pte James, E.L., having been duly sworn, states:-

I am M-30849 Pte James, E. L. on staff of 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp. On 17 May 44 I was driving the vehicle which was transporting S.U.S. Pte Fried and escort and another man to 1 Cdn General Hospital. Pte Peters, the unit cook, was riding with me as a passenger. On returning to vehicle from hospital latrines I found Pte Church telling Pte Peters that Pte Fried had escaped. The three of us conducted a search of the hospital grounds and vicinity. Being unable to find Fried we proceeded directly to L. of C. Provost Coy in Avellino. We then continued the search on highway towards Naples for several miles, and being unable to find any trace of the escaped man we returned to 7 Cdn Field Punishment Camp.

Fifth Witness:- C 41960 Cpl (A/RSM) POOLEY C J, having been duly sworn, states:-


- Q. 1. Is it customary to send out a prisoner with one escort?
A. 1. No. In this case Pte Fried, after certification by an M.O. was being sent for an X-Ray of his ankle. The prisoner appeared to be an invalid and could not get around without the aid of a cane. In view of this fact I considered one escort as ample. In all cases where the prisoner is physically fit, two escorts are provided.


The Court having reviewed the evidence, reports:-


The court reports;

1. That Pte Fried by feigning an injured leg, necessitated the use of a cane to make his escape from the custody of Pte Church.
2. That Pte Church, under the circumstances, took all precautions that could be expected.
3. The court suggests that in no instance one escort only be detailed to conduct prisoners outside bounds of 7 Cdn Fd Punishment Camp.


