

1. This soldier's death occurred Overseas 8 Aug. 44 on Active Service.
2. He died intestate. He was born in Yugoslavia and enlisted before he attained the age of 21 years. He enlisted in Winnipeg and his father states in the declaration form P.64 that he lived in the Province of Manitoba from 1936 to 1941. The father's present domicile is Montreal. If the deceased's domicile is to be considered the Province of Quebec, and there being no brothers and sisters in accordance with the declaration, the estate devolves equally between his two parents.
3. The father in his statutory declaration, however, states that he has no knowledge whether his former wife is alive or not; that she remained in Yugoslavia and never came to Canada; that they had been separated since 1925 and a legal divorce obtained in 1933; and that, according to the decree, the custody of the son was given to him; that he had not heard from his former wife since 1925. No copy of the decree was furnished in that the father stated that he had lost it.
4. The father's one-half share of the total estate consisting of an L.P.C. credit of \$67.45, was paid to him in July, 1945 with the advice that the mother's one-half share had to be retained here pending receipt of certificate of her death.
5. Therefore, pending receipt of such certificate or location and proof of identity of the mother, her one-half share in this estate is Bona Vacantia. - \$33.72
6. It should be added that the father may apply for the amount of the War Service Gratuity, and it being doubtful that he can qualify as a dependent, the gratuity amount may be credited to the Service estate. The amount of it is presently unknown.

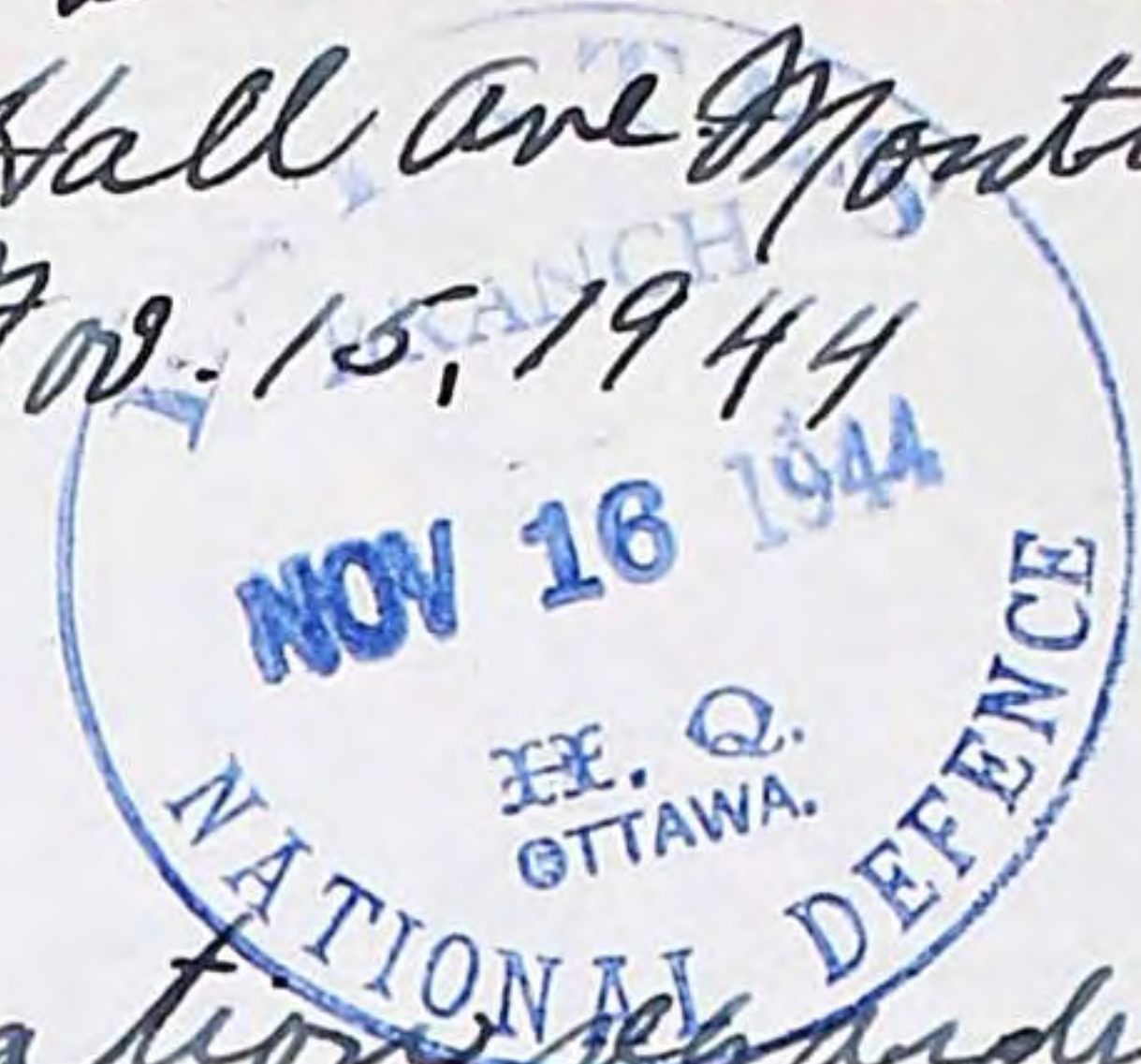

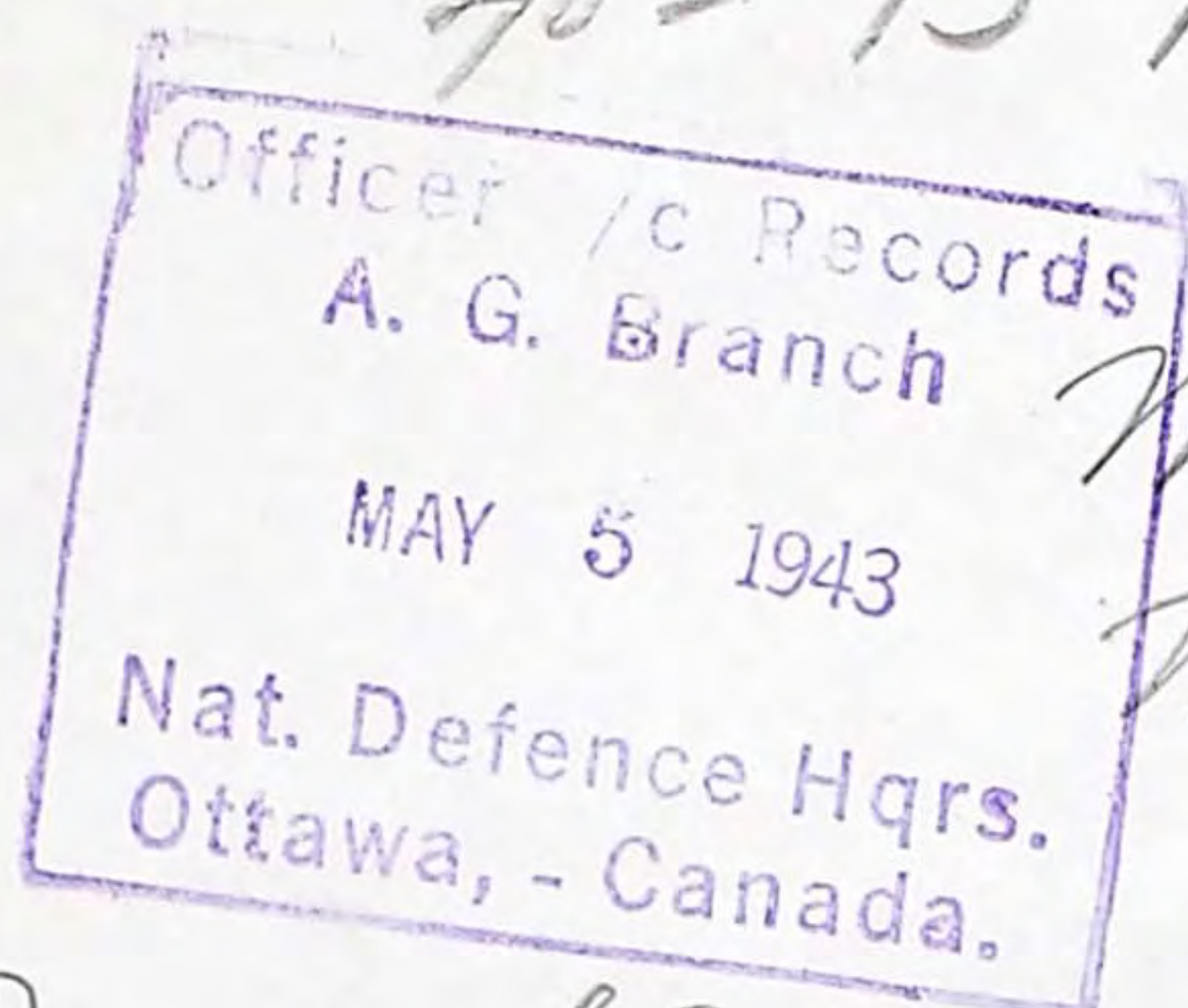
