





It is with regret that I again refer to the loss of your husband, Pilot Officer Charles Francis Hart, but you will wish to know of advice received from our Overseas Headquarters which states that your husband has now been re-interred in the Rheinberg British Military Cemetery, and his resting place is Grave No. 1 to 7, Row C, Plot VI. He is buried collectively with six other members of his crew. This cemetery is located eleven miles northwest of Duisburg, Germany.

This is a permanent British Military Cemetery located in Germany, and will be turned over shortly to the Imperial War Graves Commission (of which Canada is a member), who are responsible for the reverent and perpetual care of the resting places of all our Fallen. The cemeteries will be beautified by landscaping and the planting of shrubs and flowers, and a headstone will be erected at each grave. Unhappily, there are great numbers of these headstones to be erected and it will quite naturally take considerable time. It is not necessary to write to the Imperial War Graves Commission, as you will be contacted by them before the stone is prepared.

May I again offer to you and the members of your family my deepest sympathy in the loss of your gallant husband.



2. The Aircrew: - As an explosion occurred on impact, only parts of bodies were found which were collected by Fliegerhorst KREFELD and brought for burial to NEUSS Town Cemetery. Graves 23, 24, and 25 in the Cemetery of NEUSS were marked "Unknown British Flyer, Date of Death 29-8-1941". Cemetery Records give the place of crash as KAARST.

3. Exhumation: - Exhumation was carried out on April 18th, 1947 by 40 G.C.U. in the presence of S/L D.R.H. Rue. Exhumation did not result in identification of any of the crew members, but in each coffin was more than one body and it is therefore suggested to register these multiple graves for the seven members of this crew.



I devise and bequeath to my Trustees the residue and remainder of my property, real and personal, moveable or immoveable, or property acquired by me, or to represent the same, and of whatsoever the same may consist, and I direct that the "Trust Property" to my Trustees hereinafter named, to have and to hold for the following purposes:

- (a) To pay to my said wife



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
remarriage, whichever shall first occur, the net income to be derived from the Trust Property, in such weekly, monthly or other instalments as my said wife may find convenient or desirable.

(b) I expressly direct, in the event of the net income payable to my wife from my Estate not being sufficient to meet her reasonable requirements, or should my said wife be called upon to meet any unusual or unexpected expenditures, which cannot be conveniently taken care of by her out of the revenue payable to her that my Executors and Trustees shall in their absolute discretion, draw upon and pay from the capital of my Estate such sums as may be necessary to assist her in meeting such special or unusual expenses, but in exercising such discretion I desire that my Executors and Trustees shall bear in mind the desirability of conserving capital to the greatest extent possible.

(c) Upon the death of my said wife, or her remarriage, whichever shall first occur, or in the event of my wife predeceasing me, then upon my death, I hereby will and direct my Trustees and Executors to divide the Trust Property as it then exists into as many equal shares as there are children of mine in the first degree her surviving, or represented by descendants as hereinafter provided.

TWELFTH.

In the event of any son or daughter of mine dying before the survivor of my said wife or myself leaving issue alive at the death of such survivor, such issue shall collectively and by roots take the place and share of their predeceased parent but should any of my sons and daughters so die without leaving issue living at the death of the survivor of my said wife or myself,



the share of such son or daughter shall accrue and belong equally to the shares of my surviving sons and daughters and the issue of any predeceased son or daughter in equal shares by roots.

THIRTEENTH. My Executors and Trustees shall pay one half part of the capital of the shares of each of my children in the first degree (or of their issue in the case provided in paragraph twelfth hereof) to every such child as each attains the age of thirty years and the remaining half to every such child as each attains the age of forty years and they shall receive personally the revenue from their respective shares between the ages of twenty-one and forty years subject to the right of my Executors and Trustees at any time before each child attains the age of majority to make use of the revenue and the capital of each one's share for his or her education, maintenance and support. The decision of my Executors and Trustees in all such matters shall be final.

I direct that the application of any income to the support, maintenance or education of any beneficiary under this my will during the minority of such beneficiary may be made by my Executors and Trustees in such manner as they may deem best and disbursements for such expenses may be paid directly by my said Executors and Trustees or through payments to the beneficiary directly or to the tutor or guardian, or to the person with whom such beneficiary may reside and the receipt of any such person shall be a full discharge to my Executors and Trustees for all moneys with they may deem best so to apply to the support, maintenance or education of such beneficiary.

My said Executors and Trustees shall during such beneficiary's minority expend such beneficiary's income in whatever way they think best for his or her support and education and shall use only such part of the income as my Executors and Trustees shall deem proper and accumulate and add to the principal any unused income but with power later to use such accumulation as income if considered advisable.

If at any time during the period that the capital of any bequest herein created remains in the hands of my Executors and Trustees, the said capital shall not produce a sufficient net income for the purpose for which the bequest has been created, I authorize my Executors and Trustees in the exercise of their sole discretion to apply enough of the principal to accomplish the purpose of the bequest to the end that each trust shall be of the greatest possible benefit to its beneficiary, but in exercising their discretion my Executors and Trustees shall always bear in mind the advisability of conserving capital as long as possible.

In the event of a son of mine dying before receiving the whole of the capital of his share leaving a widow him surviving from whom he is not legally separated at the time of his death, then such widow during her lifetime so long as she shall not re-marry shall have and receive the income from that portion of the share which remains undistributed. Upon the death or remarriage of the said widow or if he shall leave no widow entitled thereto the said son's undistributed share shall be paid to his issue in equal shares by roots and if there be no such issue the undistributed share shall be added to the shares of my other children and divided accordingly.

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I declare that the provisions I have made in favour of my said wife are conditional upon her transferring to my Executors and Trustees the proceeds of all or any policies of insurance on my life in her favour and renouncing in favour of my Executors and Trustees all dower, or other matrimonial rights or claims in or upon the property, real or personal, owned by me at the time of my death and that in making this provision I feel that it is for the greater protection of my wife and in her best interests that her Estate should remain intact and that in the administration thereof my wife should be assisted by two experienced co-executors and co-trustees.

FOURTEENTH. Upon the death of my wife or her remarriage, whichever shall first occur, or in the event of my wife predeceasing me, there being, in either case, no children of mine in the first degree (or their issue as provided for in paragraph twelfth hereof) me or her surviving, my Executors and Trustees shall divide the said Trust Property, as it then exists, into two equal shares and shall pay one of the said shares to each of my brothers, Wilbur James Hart and Thornley William Hart, as soon as practicable after my death. In the event that either or both of my brothers have predeceased me, leaving issue him or them surviving, such issue shall collectively and by roots take the place and share of their predeceased father; but should either brother so die without issue living at my death, the share of such brother shall accrue and belong to my surviving brother or his issue as the case may be.

FIFTEENTH. I declare that all the foregoing bequests are made on condition that the property bequeathed and the revenue thereof shall be exempt from seizure

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for any debts of the legatees, the said bequests being intended for their alimentary support, and that the share or rights of any legatee in capital or in revenue shall not be capable of being assigned or anticipated in any way.

All bequests herein shall be the private property of the beneficiary, male or female, respectively, and shall be excluded from any community of property arising through marriage, and the share of any female legatee shall be and remain her private and separate property free from marital control and not be liable for the debts of her husband; and she shall receive the revenue upon her own receipt and expend the same without the authorization of her husband.

SIXTEENTH. My Executors and Trustees shall have the fullest powers, without the authorization of any court or judge, or of any of the beneficiaries hereunder being required:

(a) To sell, hypothecate and alienate from time to time all or any part of the property of my estate, immoveable, as well as moveable, to receive the proceeds and consideration and grant discharge and main levée in respect thereof.

(b) To invest and re-invest all moneys of my estate in such securities and investments as my Executors and Trustees may deem advisable without being confined to those investments to which Executors and Trustees are restricted by law, more particularly those restrictions outlined by Article 981c of the Civil Code of the Province of Quebec, and to sell, alter and vary investments. It is my express wish, however, that in so investing and re-investing the moneys of my estate my Executors and Trus-

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tees confine themselves to securities and investments of established grade and merit and that they avoid such as are of a speculative nature.

(c) To retain in their then present form any and all of the property and securities which I may own at the time of my death so long as in their discretion it seems wise to retain them, and if at the time of my death I be interested in any business or undertaking, either solely or jointly with others, to continue such interest and to do all such things as to my said Executors and Trustees appear wise and necessary for such period after my death as in their opinion seems expedient.

(d) To employ and pay for such professional or other assistance as they may deem requisite in the discharge of their duties.

(e) In making any division of my estate to fix the shares and allot them after such valuations as they may deem sufficient to ensure equality. After having determined the value of the share of each beneficiary, my Executors and Trustees shall deliver to or set apart for each beneficiary his or her share as thus determined, either in cash or in securities of the trust, or partly in one and partly in the other, as my Executors and Trustees may deem proper, and the division and appointment thus made shall be binding upon all the beneficiaries without any action in partition or judicial authorization being required, even though some of the beneficiaries should be minors or otherwise incapable.

(f) To compromise and settle all claims in favour of or against my estate on such terms as they may deem expedient, to determine whether any moneys received

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or disbursed shall be on account of capital or of income or of both, and in what proportions, and all other questions of like character which may arise in the course of their administration, and their decision, whether expressly given or implied from their acts and proceedings, shall be final and binding upon all beneficiaries.

(g) To borrow money and to bind my estate to the repayment thereof and the interest thereon and the fulfilment of all the terms and conditions of the loan and to pledge, mortgage and hypothecate or otherwise affect the whole or any part of my estate, moveable or immoveable, to secure the repayment of the sum so borrowed and the interest thereon.

(h) To lend their own money to my estate and to charge interest thereon and to hold the assets of my estate as security for such loans.


(i) To determine at all times what shall constitute capital and what shall constitute revenue of my Estate and their decisions shall be final and binding upon all the beneficiaries under this my will.

SEVENTEENTH.

It shall not be necessary to appoint any curator to any substitution or alleged substitution under this my last will and testament.

EIGHTEENTH.

I hereby name, constitute and appoint my wife, Lorraine MacKimmie, my brother Wilbur James Hart and the Montreal Trust Company as Executors and Trustees of this my last will and testament and I hereby extend their powers as such beyond the year and day prescribed by law, until the complete execution of this my last will and testament, with seizin and possession of all my property, moveable and immoveable. Should my bro-



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ther Wilbur James Hart predecease me, I hereby name, constitute and appoint my brother Thornley William Hart as Executor and Trustee in his place and stead, and, in that case, I declare that this, my last will and testament, shall take effect in the same manner as if the name of Thornley William Hart had been originally inserted as Executor and Trustee throughout this will instead of the name of my brother Wilbur James Hart.

I hereby exempt my Executors and Trustees from the obligation of giving security for the administration of my estate in any jurisdiction where such security may be required by law. Furthermore I do hereby exempt my said Executors and Trustees from the obligation to make any formal inventory or appraisal of my estate other than they themselves may deem necessary or advisable.

In the event of any one of my Executors and Trustees herein named ceasing to act as such through refusal, death, incapacity or for any other reason whatsoever, I direct that such vacancy shall be filled by my remaining Executors and Trustees, who shall make such appointment by notarial deed.

NINETEENTH. I hereby will and direct that the Montreal Trust Company or any other corporate Executor and Trustee which may replace the said Company as an Executor and Trustee of this my will shall be paid a fair remuneration for its services according to the usual scale of charges made by recognized and reputable companies as Executors and Trustees under similar circumstances. However, it is not my will or intention that my other Executors and Trustees shall receive any such remuneration.


