Dear Mr. Humberstone:

It is with regret that I refer to the loss of your son, Flying Officer George Arthur Humberstone, who lost his life on air operations against the enemy January 8th, 1945, but a report has been received from our Missing Research and Enquiry Service that the grave of your son and five members of his crew in the cemetery at Munsingen, Germany, has been moved to the permanent British Military Cemetery at Bad Tolz, Germany. The cemetery is known as the Bad Tolz (Durnbach) British Cemetery, and is located twenty-eight miles south southeast of Munich, Germany.

Most unfortunately, individual identification could not be secured, and your son; Flying Officer W.Y.J. Soper (Pilot); Flying Officer K.J. MacLean (Air Bomber); Flight Sergeant V.D. Elliott (Wireless Operator); Flight Sergeant J.G. McKay (Upper Gunner) - all R.C.A.F. - and Sergeant J.K. Walker (Flight Engineer) - R.A.F. - are resting in Collective Graves, registered in their names, and numbered 2 - 7, Row E, Plot 4. Flight Sergeant A.E. Wells (Rear Gunner) - R.C.A.F. - was found to be buried in the cemetery at Wittlingen, which is approximately four miles north of Munsingen. He too has been moved to the Bad Tolz British Cemetery, and is resting beside your son and his crew in Grave No. 1.

Moving the graves of your son and his crew to a British Military Cemetery is in accordance with the agreed policy of the Nations of the British Commonwealth that all British aircrew buried in Germany would be moved to British Military Cemeteries located in Germany, where the graves and cemetery will be reverently cared for and maintained in perpetuity by the Imperial War Graves Commission (of which Canada is a member). The cemetery will be beautified by landscaping, and the planting of trees, shrubs and flowers, and the Commission will also erect a permanent headstone at your son's resting place and will write to you before the stone is prepared.

I realize that this an extremely distressing letter, and that there is no manner in which such news can be conveyed to you that will not add to your heartaches, and I am fully aware that nothing I may say will lessen your great sorrow, but it is my earnest hope that you will be comforted with the knowledge that your son is resting with his comrades, and that his resting place will be permanently maintained, and I would like to take this opportunity of expressing to you and the members of your family my deepest sympathy in the loss of your gallant son.

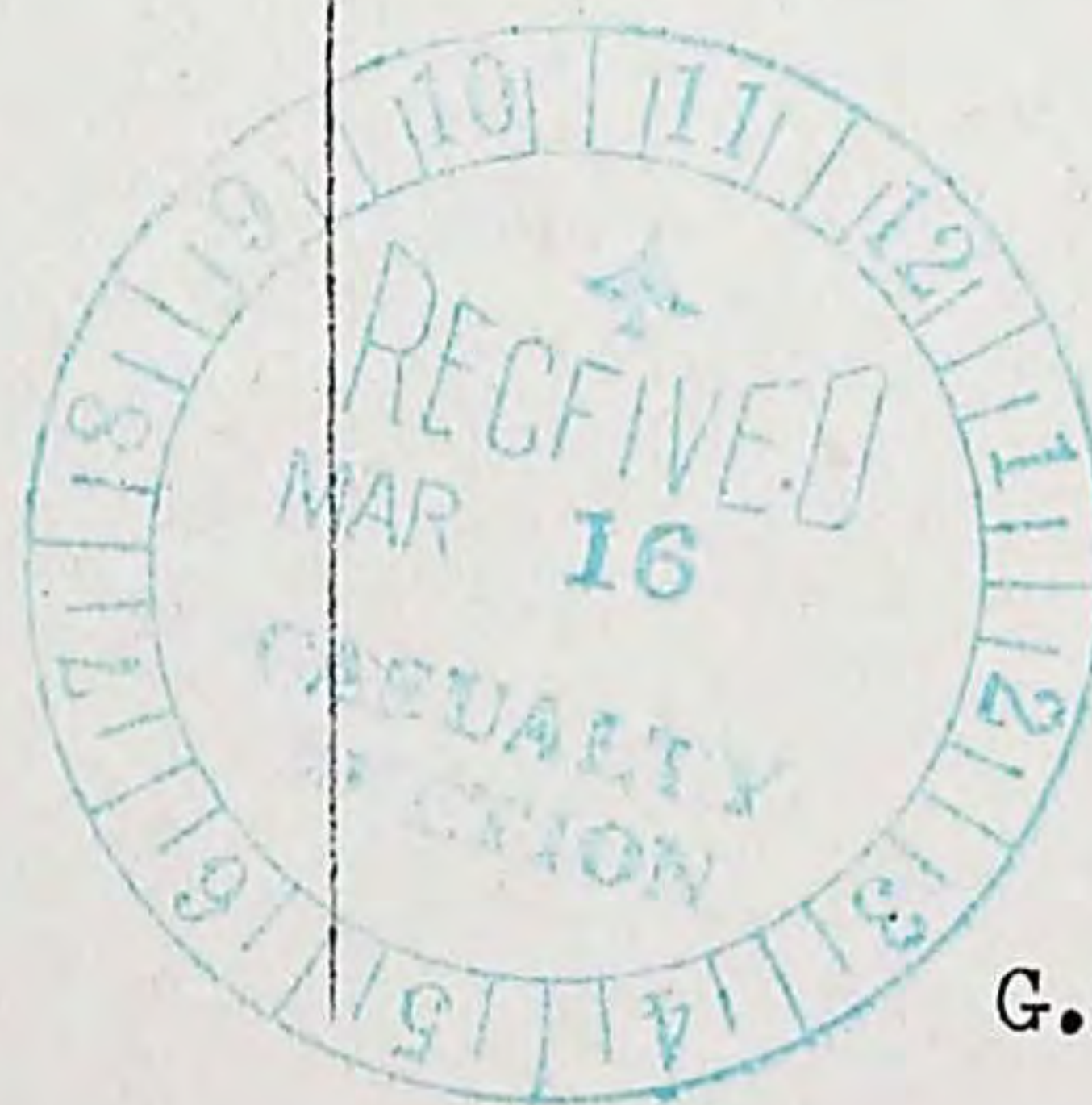

Dear Sir:

I would be very pleased if you could give me any information regarding the grave of my son, F/O George A. Humberstone. He, with other members of the crew, is buried in one grave at Munsingen, Germany. They are not buried in the cemetery as it is Roman Catholic.

The grave was visited about two years ago by Mr. Walker, brother of the English member of the crew, who found the grave in a neglected, overrun condition, without even a marker. Only by going to the official in charge was he able to locate the grave, after which he hired help and worked on the grave all day and saw that it was suitably marked.

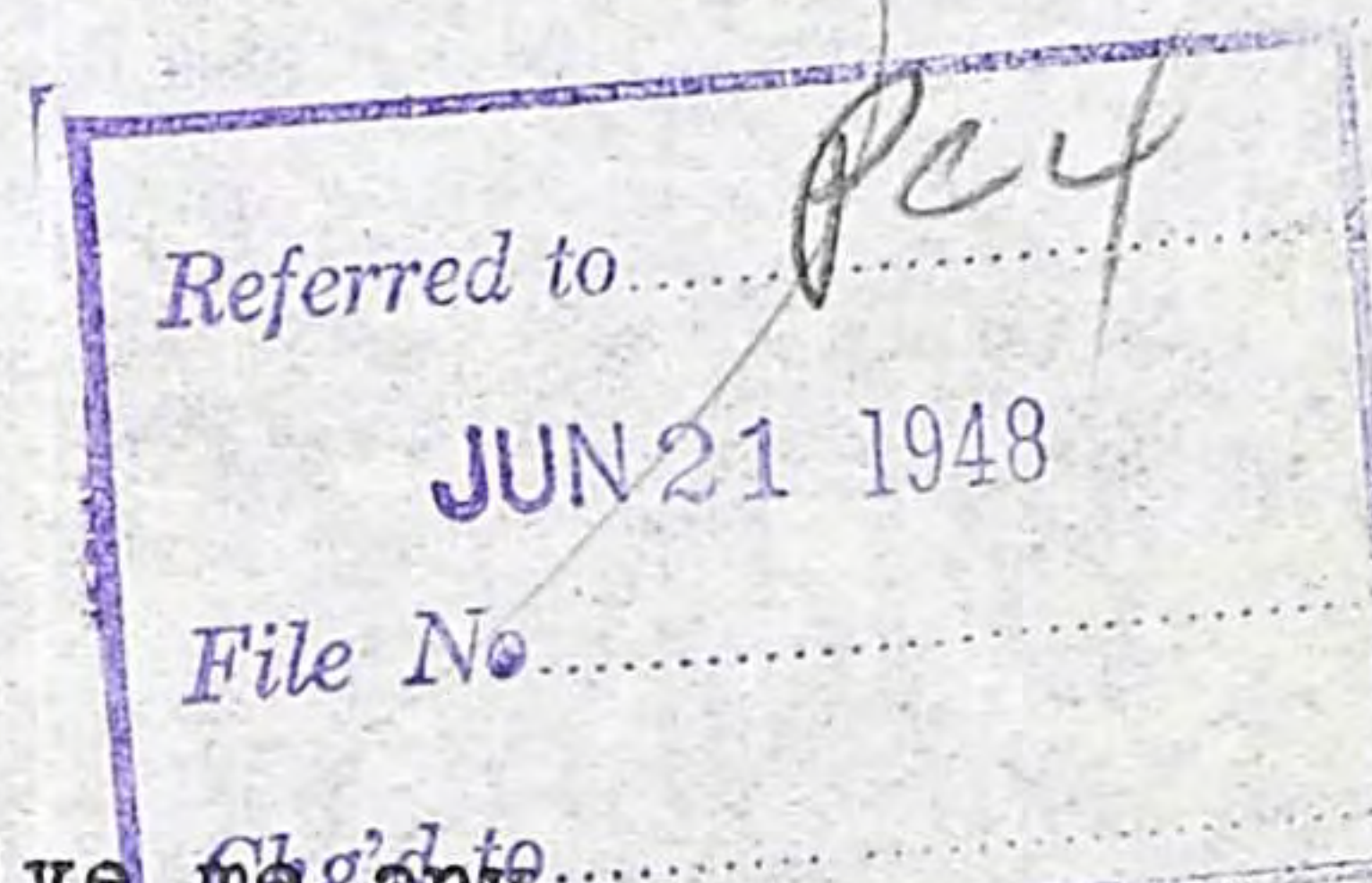
I have two pictures of the grave; one print as it was when Mr. Walker arrived and one when he left.

I have not written you for a time as I wanted to give you time to bring them out, or at least see that they are buried in consecrated ground and not lying at the side of the road.



Dear Mr. Humberstone,

May I be permitted to express my own and the Squadron's sincere sympathy with you in the sad news concerning your son, Flying Officer George Arthur Humberstone.

The aircraft of which he was the Navigator took off to attack Munich on the night of the 7th. January, 1944 and nothing further has been heard.

You may be aware that in quite a large percentage of cases aircrew reported missing are eventually reported prisoner of war and I hope that this may give you some comfort in your anxiety.

Your son was a most proficient Navigator and his loss is deeply regretted. I would like you to know how greatly we all honour the sacrifice he has made so far from his home country in the service of the United Nations.

His effects have been collected and will be sent to the R.A.F. Central Depository, where they will be held for a period of at least six months, or until such time as better news is received, before being forwarded to you through the Administrator of Estates, Ottawa.

In the meantime you may rest assured that should any news of your son be received you will be notified immediately.
