

2. At 2217 hours on the 28/June/44, the above mentioned aircraft, piloted by P/O. W. Fernyhough, took off from this aerodrome to carry out bombing operations over Metz, France. This aircraft was due to return to this aerodrome at 0457 hours on the 29/June/44, but unfortunately nothing further has been heard from any member of the crew since the time of take off.

3. All necessary action has been taken and next of kin residing in Great Britain have been advised.

D.P.S.

1. No.432 R.C.A.F. Squadron reported that Halifax aircraft, MZ.591, with a crew of 7, failed to return from an operational attack on Metz, France. It left base at 22.17 hours on the 28th. June, 1944, after which no further news was received. The aircraft was due to return to base at approximately 04.57 hours on the 29th. June, 1944. P/O. H.J. Kennedy, P/O. J.V. Musser, P/O. W. Fernyhough and P/O. R. McEwan were members of this crew.
2. A telegram from the I.R.C.C. quoting German information, states that one member of this crew, not R.C.A.F. personnel was taken Prisoner of War and P/O. Kennedy together with five unknown were killed on the 29th. June, 1944. Their burial particulars are not stated. As this completes the crew of seven, it is possible to assume that three of the five unknown are, P/O. Musser, P/O. Fernyhough and P/O. McEwan, however, action was not taken to reclassify them to "Missing Believed Killed in Action", awaiting further confirmatory evidence regarding the death and burial of the five unknown.
3. A further telegram from the I.R.C.C. quoting German information, states that P/O. Musser was killed on the 29th. June, 1944. His burial particulars are not stated. (see respective file).
4. In view of the evidence received and the lapse of time, it is accordingly submitted that the death of CAN/J85673 P/O. H.J. KENNEDY, CAN/J19898 P/O. J.V. MUSSER, CAN/J85610 P/O. W. FERNYHOUGH, and, CAN/J86800 P/O. R. MCEWAN, be presumed, for official purposes, to have occurred on the 29th. June, 1944.
5. The three remaining members of this crew were not R.C.A.F. personnel.




