### First Witness

Capt H. Bardon, OC, 1 Cdn Assault Tp, CAC, having been duly sworn, states:-

"I am Capt H. Bardon, OC, 1 Cdn Assault Tp, CAC. On the completion of training on 11 Jul 44 at 2000 hrs Lieut A.R. Tulk, 2 i/c 1 Cdn Assault Tp, CAC, informed me that he wished to take his 5 cwt WD No M 4232738 and go to FROSINONE for the evening. I gave him permission and asked him if he was taking his driver-batman with him. His reply was, "No, I want to go alone". This was the last I saw of him. At 0100 hrs approximately, 12 Jul 44, two New Zealand offrs reported to me that they had run into one of my offrs. They reported that the offr had been knocked unconscious and they had sent him to a hospital in ROME. They did not know which one. They returned his 5 cwt and said they would come back later in the day and furnish fuller particulars of the accident. The names of the New Zealand offrs were Capt M.P. Donnelly and Lieut J. Shacklack of 20 New Zealand Armd Regt. These offrs did not return and it was not until 20 Jul 44 that I received their written statement and accident report form."

The accident report is produced and marked Exhibit "A" and the statements are produced and marked Exhibit "B".

"On 12 Jul 44 I made every effort to find Lieut Tulk, visiting or sending DRs to all local hospitals and those in and around ROME. I could find no trace of him. It was on 19 Jul 44 at 1 Cdn Armd Bde HQ that I received official notification from 2 Ech that Lieut A.R. Tulk had died on the night of 11 Jul 44 as the result of a traffic accident."

The message from 2 Ech is produced and marked Exhibit "C".

### Findings of the Court.

- 1. That Lt A.R. Tulk died as a result of injuries sustained when struck by a 3-ton Ford truck, W.D. No.L4725601 driven by 48149 Lt J.T. Shacklock, 20 N.Z. Armd Regt, 2 NZEF, on Route 6 about 4 miles north of Frosinone at 2330 hrs on 11 Jul 44.
- 2. That the truck was travelling between 20 and 25 miles per hour and that the headlight of the truck was lit.
- 3. That Lt A.R. Tulk was not on duty at the time of the accident.

# Opinion of O.C. 1 Cdn Assault Tp CAC

- 1. Lt A.R. Tulk met his death as a result of injuries received when struck by a W.D. vehicle.
- 2. He was not on duty but had leave from his lines.
- 3. No carelessness or negligence was exhibited by the driver who made every attempt to avoid the accident.
- 4. The circumstances which resulted in injuries to Lt A.R. Tulk were entirely accidental.
