Bulletin No. 150

1. In the event of my being accepted for enlistment in the Royal Canadian Air Force, I hereby acknowledge that I have read, understand and agree to the following conditions of service:

(b) That if at any time I am found unsuitable for further training in the above category:

(1) I may be remustered to any other Aircrew category for which I may be found suitable,

(11) If found unsuitable for any Aircrew category I may be given the option of remustering for service in any ground duties for which I may be recommended by a Board of Officers, or, of taking my discharge, provided, however, that if, in the opinion of the Commanding Officer of the Station, failure on my part to qualify for flying duties was intentional, I may be denied the right to exercise the option of discharge.


