Dear Mrs. Jarvis:

It is with regret that I again refer to the loss of your husband, Flight Sergeant Everett Franklin Jarvis, but you will wish to know of a communication received from the Missing Research and Enquiry Service.

Investigating Officers of this Service have ascertained that your husband's aircraft crashed approximately 2 miles South East of Baunbach which is 32 miles South East of Bonn, Germany. A communal grave was located in the top right hand corner of the village cemetery. Exhumation was carried out resulting in the identification of all members of the crew. They have since been re-interred in the Rheinberg British Military Cemetery, 11 miles North West of Duisburg. Your husband lies at rest in Plot 10, Row C, Grave No. 22.


This is one of the permanent British Military Cemeteries which has been located in Germany in accordance with the agreed policy of Canada, Australia, New Zealand and the United Kingdom, that all British aircrew buried in Germany would be moved to British Military Cemeteries located in Germany. This Cemetery will be turned over shortly to the Imperial War Graves Commission (of which Canada is a member) who are responsible for the reverent and perpetual care of the resting places of all our Fallen. The cemeteries will be beautified by landscaping and the planting of shrubs and flowers, and a headstone will be erected at each grave. Unhappily, there are great numbers of these headstones

to be erected and will quite naturally take considerable time. It is not necessary to write to the Imperial War Graves Commission as you will be contacted by them before the stone is prepared.

May I take this opportunity of extending my sincere sympathy.

Thank you for exhumation reports, concentration report and A.F.W. 3372 in respect of the concentration of this crew into Rheinberg British Cemetery.

Your findings regarding Sutton, Newman, Laferge, and McLean are accepted. In regard to Read, Jarvis and Richardson, reference to F.'S48 shows that Read was the tallest of the three and had dark brown hair. Exhumation report A.13 can therefore be accepted as relating to Read. Of the other two, Jarvis was a Flight Sergeant and Richardson a Sergeant. Report A.15 can therefore be accepted as relating to Jarvis and by elimination report A.18 refers to Richardson.

Please therefore raise an amended F.3372 to register each member of the crew individually, Sutton, Newman, Laferge and McLean in Plot X, Row C, Graves 19, 23, 24 and 25 respectively in Rheinberg British Cemetery, and Read, Jarvis and Richardson individually in graves 20, 21 and 22, as noted in 40 G.C.U. records. (Note: your exhumation reports do not record the actual graves into which these three bodies were re-interred.)

This case may then be closed.

RESULT OF INVESTIGATION AND FINDINGS:

As the result of a search in the Kreis of UNTERWESTERWALD, I obtained the following information.

At about 2200 hours on 1-4-44 a burning aircraft was seen to crash approx 3 Km. S/E of Baumbach.

The following morning a search party found the wreckage and seven badly burned and mutilated bodies. Two personal Identity Discs were found on the bodies and were held at the Burgomasters Office, one of these has disappeared. I took possession of the remaining Identity-Disc.

"CAN. R.110907. AIRMAN D.J. LABERGE R.C. R.C.A.F."

The disc is forwarded with this report.

Information taken by the Burgomaster from the Identity Disc now Missing states:

"Canadian Airman E.F. Jarois."

These seven bodies are buried in one large grave in the top right hand corner of Baumbach Cemetery. The grave is registered by 40 G.R.U.

Will Air Ministry kindly forward full details of this crew so that this enquiry may be completed.

MINUTE 1.

D.P.S.

1. No.622 Squadron reported that Lancaster aircraft ED.619, with a crew of 7, failed to return from an operational attack on Nurnburg. It left base at 22.20 hours on the 30th. March, 1944, after which no further news was received.
2. A telegram from the I.R.C.C. quoting German information, states that F/Sgt. Jarvis, and, W.O.2. Laberge, were killed on the 31st. March, 1944. There are no burial particulars stated.
3. In view of the evidence received and the lapse of time, it is accordingly submitted that the death of CAN/R110907 W.O.2. D.J. LABERGE, and, CAN/R177084 F/SGT. E.F. JARVIS, be presumed, for official purposes, to have occurred on the 31st. March, 1944.
4. The five remaining members of this crew were not R.C.A.F. personnel.

Dear Mr Jordan,

Before receiving this letter you will have been informed that your Son-in-Law Flight Sergeant Everett Jarvis failed to return from an operational flight on the night of 30/31st March, 1944.

He was the Mid Upper Gunner of an aircraft engaged on an important bombing mission over Germany, and after take off nothing further was heard, although this is quite usual as communication with the aircraft ceases after take off. It is quite possible that the aircraft was forced down, and if this is the case, there is some chance that they may be safe and a prisoner of war. In this event it may be two to three months before any certain information is obtained through the International Red Cross.

Your Son-in-Law was a member of one of our most experienced crews and had completed 12 successful operational sorties. He was admired by all who knew him and he will be very much missed by his many friends in the Squadron.

May I, on behalf of the whole Squadron express to you our most sincere sympathy, and hope that you will soon receive good news.


