



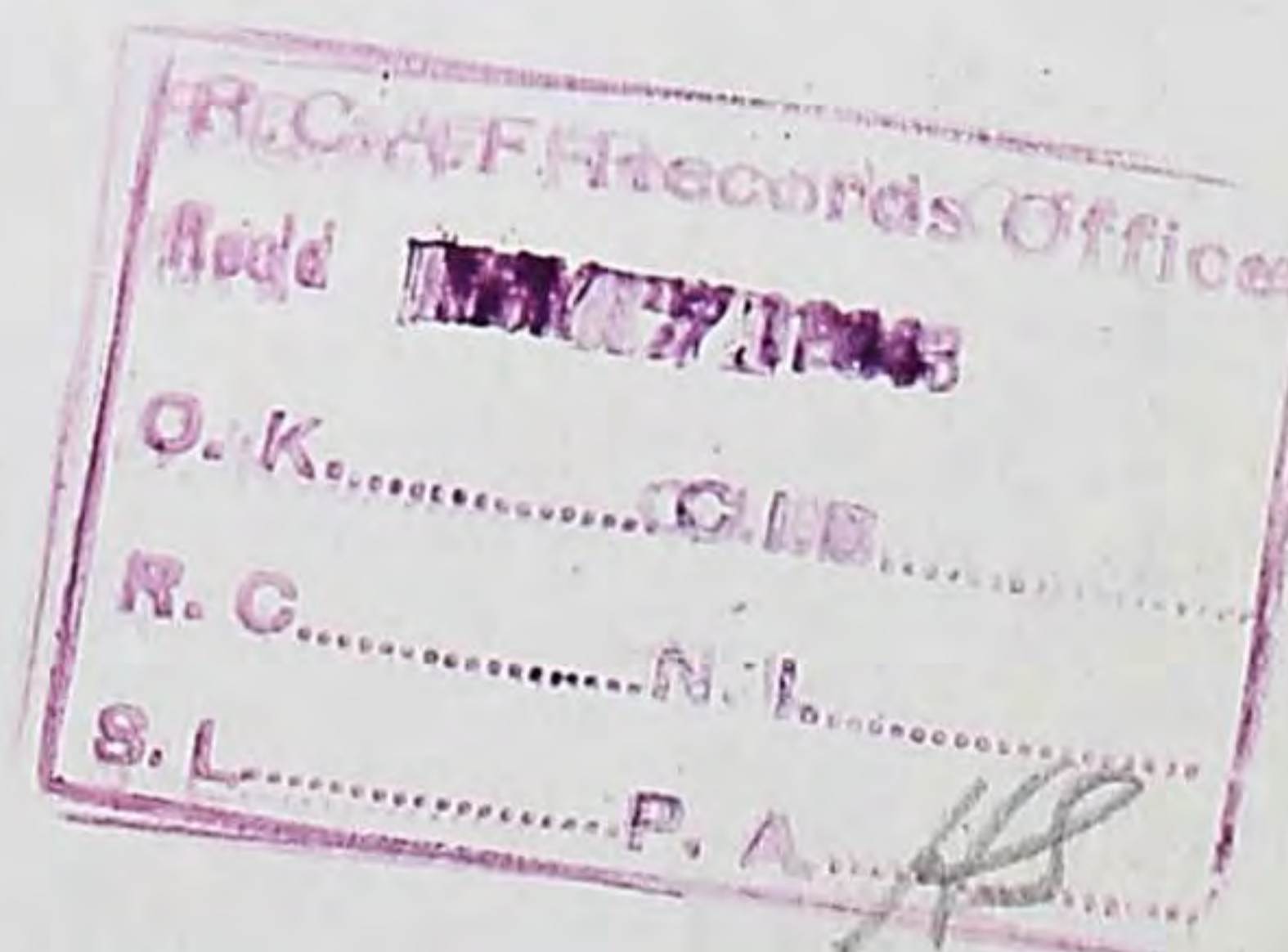

4. A prisoner of war statement by F/Sgt. McElroy states that Sgt. Fullum and Sgt. Moody were buried near Vilno? Holland. (We presume Venlo)

5. A further report from the International Red Cross Committee states that two unknown were buried in graves numbered 199-200 Deurne and records Sgt. Fullum, Sgt. Moody, Sgt. Margerison, F/Sgt. Reeves, F/Sgt. McElroy, F/O Weepers and Sgt. Brickenden as prisoners of war.

6. It would be appreciated if an investigation could be made concerning the fate and burial particulars for the three remaining members of the two crews - 1st/Lt Dowden, F/O Davies and Sgt. Snowden. Also, would you kindly confirm the burial particulars of Sgt. Moody and Sgt. Fullum.

1. No.115 Squadron reported that Lancaster aircraft, ND.745, with a crew of 7, failed to return from an operational attack on Dortmund. It left base at 22.59 hours on the 22nd. May, 1944, after which no further news was received. (enc. 3 and 7).
2. A telegram from the I.R.C.C. quoting German information, states that F/Sgt. Fullum was killed on the 23rd. May, 1944. (enc. 10).
3. An extract from official German totenliste No.225, confirms his death but states that he was killed on the 22nd. May, 1944, and buried in the Enemy Cemetery, Antwerpen Deurne, Grave No.199, on the 23rd. May, 1944. Deurne is a suburb of Antwerp, Belgium. In view of the time and date of take-off stated in paragraph one and the information contained in paragraph two, it is obvious that the date of death given in totenliste No.225, is incorrect and should be disregarded. (Encl. 14).
4. It is accordingly submitted that the death of CAN/R189530 F/SGT. W.J. FULLUM, be presumed, for official purposes, to have occurred on the 23rd. May, 1944.
5. The six remaining members of this crew were not R.C.A.F. personnel.

It is with deep regret that I have to confirm the news that your son, Sergeant Walter Joseph Fullum, is reported missing.

There is unfortunately very little definite information that I can give you at the moment. He went out on an operation flight on the night of the 22/23rd May, 1944 to attack an important target in enemy territory and, up to the time of writing, nothing further has been heard of his aircraft.

During your son's service with my squadron, he rapidly proved himself a very capable Air Gunner and had become a popular member of the Squadron.

I should like to assure you how greatly his comrades in the Royal Air Force admire the unselfish sacrifice your son has made so far from home, in the service of his country, and for the Cause of Freedom.

His personal effects have been carefully collected and forwarded to the Royal Air Force Depository and, in due course, you will receive a further communication concerning these from the Administration of Estates Ottawa.

In the event of any news coming to hand regarding your son, rest assured it will be communicated to you immediately. In the interim, please accept the most sincere sympathy of myself and all personnel of the squadron in your period of anxiety.

Confirming my telegram of recent date, I regret to inform you that advice has been received from the International Red Cross Society at Geneva concerning your son, Flight Sergeant Walter Joseph Fullum, previously reported missing on Active Service.

The report quotes German information which states that your son lost his life on May 23rd, 1944 but does not contain any further particulars. The International Red Cross Society is making every effort to obtain the location of your son's grave. However, I feel sure you will appreciate the difficulties attendant upon securing additional details.

Since this information originates from enemy sources it is necessary for the present to consider your son "missing believed killed" until confirmed by further evidence. However, in the absence of additional information, his death will be presumed after a lapse of six months from the date he was reported missing.

May I assure you and the members of your family of my deepest sympathy.

CASUALTY ENQUIRY No.344.

Reference your P.417455/44/P.417518/P.4.B.4. dated 24th May, 1945, the cemetery at Fort 3 Antwerp has been visited and the Enemy casualty card index recently discovered at the Successions Office of the Ministry of the Interior here in Brussels has been closely studied. The following are my conclusions in regard to the above enquiry.

Fort 3 Cemetery at Deurne, Antwerp contains in:-

		Body found
Grave 195	Sgt. SNOWDEN	22-5-44 so far marked "unknown"
196	P/O WARD	23-5-44 marked WARD
197	1st/Lt. DOWDEN	23-5-44 so far marked "Unknown"
198	F/O DAVIES	23-5-44 so far marked "Unknown"
199	Sgt. FULLUM	22.5.44 marked FULLUM
200	Sgt. MOODY	22.5.44 marked MOODY.

The graves of P/O. WARD, Sgt FULLUM and Sgt. MOODY Nos 196, 199 and 200 respectively are known and crosses inscribed accordingly. It was a matter of placing the graves of Sgt. SNOWDEN, 1st/Lt DOWDEN and F/O DAVIES. By process of elimination this has been accomplished by the following reasoning:-

1. Grave 193 and 194 belong to Sgts AINDE and YOUNG respectively (see Cemetery list of Fort 3 Antwerp) These 2 airmen are not connected with the crews under review.
2. Graves 196, 199 and 200 belong to P/O WARD, Sgt. FULLUM and Sgt MOODY respectively. These are already named.
3. Grave 201 is marked CASHELL. This name is not connected with the crew under review.
4. Graves 195, 197 and 198 are marked "Unknown" but it has been discovered from the German Card index that the bodies in these graves were found on 22 and 23 May, 1944 in the same parts of the country as other members of these 2 crews, i.e. in a district N.W. of Turnhout map Ref. Sheet 3/E00.

The final question is whether these graves could be attributed to any particular body of these 3. As Graves Registration have already exhumed all the unknown in this Cemetery with only 2 positive results, I am of the opinion that graves 195, 197 and 198 can be safely attributed to the bodies of SNOWDEN, DOWDEN and DAVIES respectively and Graves Registration here are being informed of the fact.

Dear Mr. Fullum:

It is with deep regret that I must confirm our recent telegram informing you that your son, Flight Sergeant Walter Joseph Fullum, is reported missing on Active Service.

Advice has been received from the Royal Canadian Air Force Casualties Officer, Overseas, that your son and the entire crew of his aircraft failed to return to their base after taking off to carry out bombing operations over Dortmund, Germany, on the night of May 22nd and the early morning of May 23rd, 1944.

The term "missing" is used only to indicate that his whereabouts is not immediately known and does not necessarily mean that your son has been killed or wounded. He may have landed in enemy territory and might be a Prisoner of War. Enquiries have been made through the International Red Cross Society and all other appropriate sources and I wish to assure you that any further information received will be communicated to you immediately.

Your son's name will not appear on the official casualty list for five weeks. You may, however, release to the Press or Radio the fact that he is reported missing, but not disclosing the date, place, or his unit.

Permit me to extend to you my heartfelt sympathy during this period of uncertainty and I join with you and the members of your family in the hope that better news will be forthcoming in the near future.


