1. Due to the fact that the members of the crew, except Sgt. Chabot, were members of the R.A.F. no information concerning them other than the original casualty signal was received here.

On receipt of Mrs. Chabot's letter of May 17th stating that the Red Cross had informed her that two members of the crew were prisoners of war, a signal was despatched to the Air Ministry on May 19th asking that this be confirmed.

The following answer was received May 21st:

"RE CAN R67034 SGT CHABOT (.) TWO MEMBERS OF SAME CREW REPORTED PRISONERS NAME OF 1256785 SGT T W PARKER AND 1375177 SGT E I COOPER (.) LETTER RECEIVED FROM SGT COOPER BY NIKIN IN WHICH HE STATES THAT HE AND PARKER WERE ONLY SURVIVORS (.) PLEASE PASS THIS INFORMATION TO N/KIN SGTS CHABOT KELLY STEPHENS AND WHITTAKER STILL REMAIN CLASSIFIED MISSIEG (.) ANY FURTHER INFORMATION RECEIVED WILL BE PASSED TO YOU".

A letter was written to Mrs. Chabot on May 23rd advising that the two members of the crew reported prisoners of war were believed to be the only survivors, but that in compliance with her request presumption of death action had not been taken.

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 18th instant.

I am extremely sorry that there has been such a long delay in the settlement of your son's Service estate. A suitcase containing a few of your son's personal belongings has been received from Overseas but, in view of the nature of the contents, it was thought inadvisable to forward them to you until it had been definitely ascertained that no further effects would be received. I enclose the original inventory of the effects which I would ask you to kindly return at your convenience. Kindly also advise whether it is your wish that the suitcase and contents be forwarded to you at the above address.

In view of the theatre of war in which your son lost his life, it may not have been possible to arrange for the return of his personal belongings but a cable was forwarded to Overseas Headquarters several weeks ago requesting that a complete report be submitted at an early date and in reply advice has been received by cable that British Air Ministry have received the pay documents from the Middle East and that they will be forwarded to this Branch as soon as possible. No mention however was made of your son's personal belongings and a further cable has been despatched for definite information. You may rest assured that I will communicate with you immediately further word has been received from Overseas Headquarters.

It is with reluctance that after so long an interval, I must refer to the loss of your son, Flight Sergeant Marc Roger Chabot, but due to the lack of any information concerning him since he was reported missing, it must be regretfully accepted and officially recorded that he does not have a "known" grave.

Due to the extreme hazards attending air operations there are, unhappily many thousands of British aircrew boys who do not have "known" graves and all will be commemorated on General Memorials that will be erected at a number of locations by the Imperial War Graves Commission (of which Canada is a member), each Memorial representative of a theatre of operations. One of these Memorials will be erected at Malta, and the name of your son will appear on that Memorial.

The attached verification form was received from the Commission with the request that it be forwarded on to you for completion and return direct to them.

I realize that this is an extremely distressing letter and that there is no manner of conveying such information to you that would not add to your heartaches. I am fully aware that nothing I may say will lessen your great sorrow, but I would like to express to you and the members of your family my deepest sympathy.



- LAC. Chabot is a clean cut and very willing airman, and has tried bery hard to do a good job in his flying, but I feel he was not cut out to be a pilot. His trouble has been his inability to retain and carry out what I taught him. On a number of flights he has shown his inability by being unable to adjust his throttle to the proper R.P.M. setting without erratic movement, also, after 7:30 he can't do a normal circuit and his altitude continually changes after reaching the 1000 foot level.
- He has closed the throttle using excessive control to the point of ground looping after taking off, and hasn't yet learned how to taxi the aircraft. Even after all this time he can't grasp when he should turnian when landing.
- 3. His speeds vary continually 10 to 20 miles per hour while gliding, climbing and in level flight.




