5. Should you consider that any entry in the book is lacking or incorrect, or should you lose the book, you will report the matter to your immediate superior in Royal Air Force. Any change in name or address of person to be informed of casualties must be reported immediately to your Commanding Officer.
6. If an airman wishes to make a short Will (for specimens see p. 9) he should do so on p. 10. It must be signed by him in the presence of two witnesses, **both** of whom must sign it in **his** and in **one another's** presence; but if the Will is made by an airman on active service, or under orders for active service, it does not require any witnesses' signatures. The full names and addresses of the persons whom he desires to benefit, and the sum of money or property which he desires to leave them, must be clearly stated.

It is also desirable that he should name a person to act as executor.

Gentlemen,

The stand taken by you concerning my eldest son Frédéric has already been settled by your Montréal investigators and myself. The result of it all is that I became an invalid in June 1941, I was operated upon three times in October 1941 (within 5 days), I was forced to remain inactive up to July 12, 1943. I thus had to leave my eldest son Frédéric in charge of my personal business, so as to facilitate matters and avoid identifications, representations and expenses.

I am attending my personal business since July 12, 1943, but I have been dependent upon my son Wilfrid. On January 2, 1942, the latter told me that, because he had failed to have me registered at Ottawa as such so that I could be paid \$35.00 monthly plus \$20.00 (Separation allowance (sic) paid by Ottawa and part of pay assigned by Wilfrid), he had instructed Ottawa to pay me the equivalent amount, or \$55.00, by Government cheque addressed to Fred exclusively for my support, because I had to remain indefinitely in bed or in an invalid chair.

So, Fred, who works for Dewey and Alurey Ltd. at Ville Lasalle since 1933, was never a dependent of Wilfrid or others, but was acting in my name because I was totally incapable of attending any business under the circumstances.

I am a dependent since June 1941. I am still unable to make any revenue and, as a refugee, I have to find immediately a ~~ingding~~ lodging, some food and clothes and other prime requisites. I have also to move not later than May 1, 1945, because Fred is leaving his home here to find a less expensive one for his wife and baby, on account of his limited means. This is how matters stand.

In a word, I gave nine service-men to the Government of Canada. None of them have been able to have me registered at Ottawa so that I could draw \$35.00 a month plus \$20.00 on my boys' pay (that is \$55.00 which is paid by the Ottawa Government to dependents of all service-men but was never paid me). But my boys have had to provide for me just the same without Government help to which they were entitled.

Since their marriage in 1939, each of my boys, having a wife and home, etc., have been unable to help me and all I draw is a pension of \$22.50 a month from the Ottawa Government to keep living.

Please note also that my son Wilfrid appointed me as sole heir and executor of his estate, as registered in Ottawa by the R.C.A.F.


Dear Sir:

We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter
of the 22nd March.

We appreciate your situation and are anxious to
pay the gratuity in respect of your deceased son, Flight Sergeant
Wilfred Senez, as soon as possible. However, since records reveal
that you were receiving neither dependents' allowance nor assigned
pay, but your son, Frederic, was receiving an assignment of pay,
we shall require a statement from him that he was not dependent
upon his brother and does not wish to apply for the war service
gratuity on his brother's behalf, before we can proceed with your
claim.

While the requirements to establish entitlement
to the war service gratuity as a dependent of a deceased member of
the forces are limited to a certain extent, payment will nevertheless
be made to the deceased member's estate where it is found that no
person is eligible to receive these benefits as a dependent. For
that reason, we are anxious to settle the question of dependency
in order that there may not be an excessive delay in final payment.
For that reason, will you kindly request your son, Frederic, to write
to us, explaining his position.
