At 6.10 a.m. of the 8th inst. I received a telephone call from Sgt. H.E. Bartlett requesting that I go to the Robinson Bldg. Queen St. Ottawa as a report had been received to the effect that one of the R.C.N.V.R. men had been killed. Cst. LeBlanc conveyed me by Police Car to the Robinson Bldg. where I arrived at 6.24 a.m.

Sub-Division

On entering I met Cst. A. Potvin, Ottawa City Police who stated "I was called here at about 4.00 a.m. from my Beat on Queen St. I found the body of George Gunter had been moved from the Freight elevator shaft. I examined him, he was dead and the body was cold. Dr. Shapiro, the coroner, was called. He said he told some person to call a Detective. I believe one of the men called the Guard Room of the R.C.M.F

Detachment

I went to the Basement of the Robinson Bldg. with Potvin, the body was examined, it was lying on the floor outside the Freight elevator Pit. The head of the young man was badly crushed. His Uniform Blouse was torn at the shoulder There was a large amount of blood in the Pit and on the floor of the Basement. Cst. Potvin then said he did not see that any good purpose could be served by keeping the body there, he then released it to George Scharf and M. Hayes, employees of Hulse and Playfair, undertakers 315 McLeod St.

P. C. R.

Cst. Potvin then stated he was gong to submit his report on the matter and left the Buidling.

- I questioned the Ratings of the R.C.N.V.R. who were on duty in the Building from 12.00 M.N. of the 7th to 8.00 A.N. of the 8th. I then decided it would be better if each of them wrote a statement regarding what had transpired during their tour of duty. Statements were obtained from A/Seaman A. Murray in charge of the watch from 12.00 M.D. of the 7th to 8.00 A.M. of the 8th ist., A/Seaman J.G. Charron, Seamen William Hazel, H.E. Barrett, Bob Cousineau and John Moorman.
- At about 7.30 A.M. Mr. Ralph Burnett came to the Robinson Bldg. and stated: "I am Superintendent of this Bldg." I then asked him if the Building was Government owned or rented. He stated"this Building is rented to the Government it is owned by Wilfred D'Amour, Alymer Road, Hull, P.Q." I reported this matter to the Officer i/c "A" Div. C.I.B. and in compliance with his instructions, I notified Chief Const. Downey, Ottawa City Police, Detective A. Cavan and T. Stoneman, then took charge of the case. I handed them over the statements mentioned in para. 5 of this report.
- The Otis Fenson Elevator Coy. was contacted by the Detectives and an expert was made to have the elevator examineffort

> HAVE THE ELEVATOR EXAMINED Cont'd It was found to be nut of order. Repairs were made and on the 10th inst., after inspected by the Hydro Electric the Shaft was inspected by Detective Cavan and Stoneman. Marks were found on the wall of the shaft and door of the 2nd floor which indicated that the body of Gunter had been dragged upwards, the Elevator door on the 2nd Floor was bulged outward at the bottom. It is the belief of the Detectives and Mr. Fisher, Elevator repairman that the body was forced against the door and rolled under the elevator then fell to the bottom of the pit. The elevator continued upwards to the 4th or 5th floor where it was when Seaman (Murphy) Murray made an examination of the Bldg between 3.40 and 3.55 a.m. of the 8th inst. Murray was unable to state definitely at which floor the elevator was as he looked up the Shaft from the ground floor.

- Questioning A/Seaman Murray regarding the finding of the body, he stated: "After completing my rounds at 3.55 A.M. I went to see if the Freight Elevator was at the First floor as I wanted to use it to relieve the Sentries at the rear of the Bldg. The elevator was not at the First floor so I looked up the shaft. It was apparently at the 4th floor. I pulled the cable to bring it down. When the Car was between the first and second floors a flash occurred. I went to the basement to see if any fire had occurred from the flash. I saw Seaman Gunter lying in the Elevator Pit. I called Seaman Barrett and Cousineau who were in the yard. They lifted Gunter from the shaft to the floor of the basement, While I went to get a police officer. I reported the accident to Cst. Potvin who was on Queen St. He immediately came to the Building. The Freight Elevator has been in use for some time by the sentries to convey them from the 1st floor to the basement so that they can take up their duties in the Yard."
- 9. On the 10th inst. a Court of enquiries was held at the Robinson Bldg. Commander Bidwell, R.C.N.V.R. presidedt Petty Officer CARVER notified me that it was the wishes of the presiding officer that I attend. I was not called on to give evidence. The enquiry was completed at 4.20 p.m.
- Before attending the Enquiry, Coroner Constable E.D. WALSH served me with a copy of a summons to a witness, calling on me to attend the Inquest to be held at the Ottawa City Police Station at 8.00 p.m. on 13-2-41.
- A further report will be submitted as to the finding of the Coroner when the inquest is held. 12x2x41.
